_____ **Spring Clean-Up** (Normally includes cleanup of all winter damage, and removal of leaves/sticks and debris accumulated over winter months trimming back perennials etc not trimmed back in the fall.

_____ **Routine Maintenance** (Weeding beds and small amount of pruning as needed.) For all our mowing clients. We can provide this on a biweekly basis with our mowing service visit

_____ **Shrub Trimming** (Shearing or hand pruning of all shrubs as needed throughout the season

- () Early Spring-often in coordination with mulching
- () Late Summer/Early fall- for most shrubs, evergreens etc
- () Early winter- all perennials

- _____ **Lawn Aerating/Over Seeding.** We recommend a fall aeration and overseeding as the grass gets a better root system. We also recommend topdressing.

- (Aerating (spring) Overseeding/aerating (spring)
- Aerating (fall) Overseeding/aerating (fall)
- Topdress (Topdressing the lawn areas with a compost mixture by spreading a thin layer over the lawn. It acts as a soil builder and a natural fertilizer.

_____ **Leaves** (Removal of leaves from all bed areas.)

- Gutters cleaned
- Once when all leaves are down.
- 2-4 times throughout the fall season while doing normal mowing service
- blow out beds areas with each cleanup.
