Now Carries Feasts of Persia Packaged Foods*

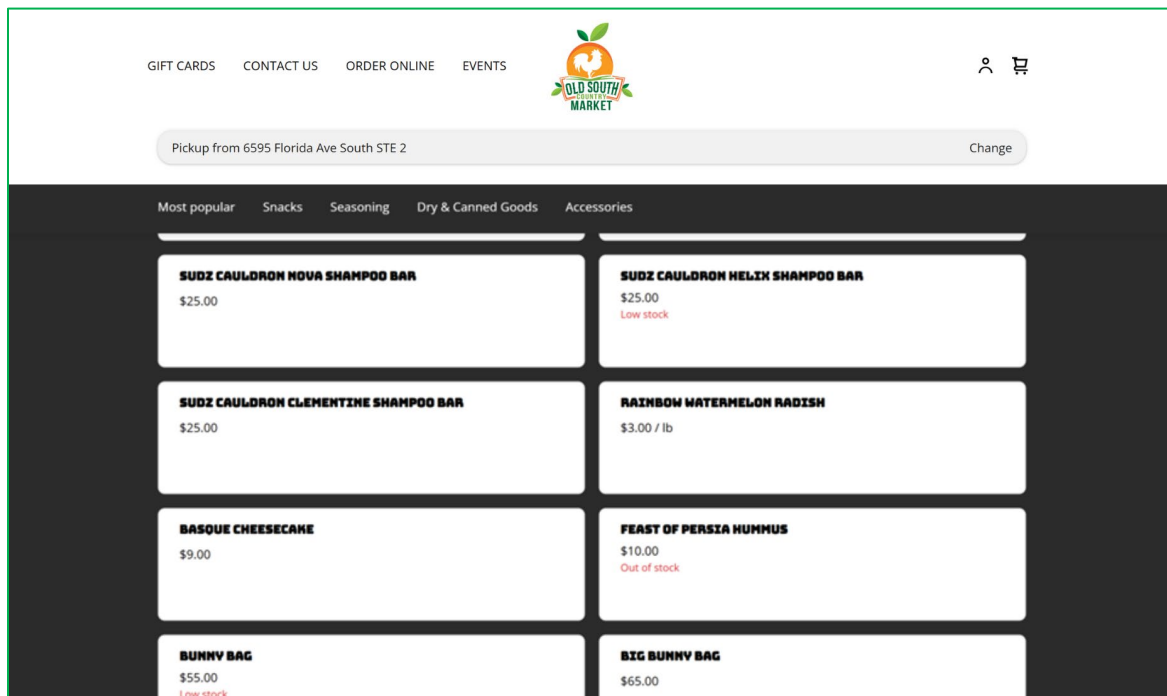

We would love to order 10 to begin with while we figure out what else we can add.” On April 12th, three short days after the introduction and tasting, FOP’s popular Hummus was on OSCM’s shelf for sale.



Since then, the Hummus has flown off the shelves being restocked twice already and needing more again, with Beef Kabobs, Lentil Soup (Adasi), and Falafel – all fully-cooked and ready-to-heat – and FOP’s house recipe Tahini Sauce added to the lineup. The local community embraced the opportunity to support FOP, OSCM, and several other small, local, family businesses such as My Tiny Greens, Spurzile’s Gourmet, and The Apothic Fox with a limo ride to the indoor market from Garcia’s Events and Limos.
