Information for artists

The Health Foundation of East Central Saskatchewan is hosting Rhythm 'n Ribs Championship BBQ and Music Festival June 24-26, 2022 at the Yorkton Exhibition Grounds.

- The stage performances will consist of:
 - Friday June 24 - five sets performed by three bands:
 - One band performing a 60-minute set from 5.30 pm to 6.30 pm;
 - One band performing two 45-minute sets from 7 pm to 8.45 pm;
 - One closing band performing two 45-minute sets from 9.15 pm to 11 pm.
 - Friday June 24 – Cabaret:
 - One band performing from 10 pm to 2 am
 - Saturday June 25 - nine 45-minute sets performed by five bands:
 - One band performing a 60-minute set from 1 pm to 2 pm;
 - Three bands performing two 45-minute sets each from 2.30 pm to 4.15 pm, 4.45 pm to 6.30 pm and 7 pm to 8.45 pm;
 - One closing band performing two 45-minute sets from 9.15 pm to 11 pm.
 - Saturday June 25 – Cabaret:
 - One band performing from 10 pm to 2 am
 - Sunday June 26 - six 45-minute sets performed by three bands:
 - Two bands performing two 45-minute sets each from 1.30 pm to 3.15 pm and 3.45 pm to 5.30 pm;
 - One closing band performing two 45-minute sets from 5.30 pm to 7.45 pm.
- Artists need to show up and play on time. Setup time is half hour before the performance time slot.
- Artists may sell their own merchandise.
- Submissions will be adjudicated by industry peers on EPK, availability, and the information provided on the application form.
- Please note that the application form must be accompanied by a performer/band biography and a photo (JPG, PDF or PNG) or a full resume to be used by Rhythm n' Ribs for promotional purposes. Include a statement why you look forward to participating in Rhythm 'n Ribs 2022.
- If selected, artists will be expected to promote this event through their own social media channels.

If you are interested in participating, please fill in the submission form.

- Submissions close May 24, 2022 with the final list to be sent out upon completion of adjudication.
- We have a limited number of performance spots, so get your submissions in ASAP.

Provide at least two dates you are available so we can accommodate you as best as possible. First submissions received will get preference of dates.

If you are selected and can't make your date, you will be responsible to find a replacement.
