Beginning December 24, 2025, the U.S. Postal Service will no longer apply postmarks at local mailboxes or post offices. Instead, postmarks will be added later at regional processing centers, sometimes several days after mail is dropped off.

Because of this change, a postmark may not reliably reflect when a scholarship application was mailed, which could affect whether a mailed applications qualifies for consideration.

If you plan to apply for The Charlotte Chorale's R. Bruce and Caroline MacGregor Memorial Scholarship by USPS, we recommend taking one of the following steps:

- Take your envelope directly to a USPS counter and
 - purchase postage with a Postage Validation Imprint (PVI), or
 - request a manual (local) postmark, or
 - send the mailing via Certified or Registered Mail, or request a Certificate of Mailing

Please note that simply placing an application in a mailbox or using a self-service kiosk may not provide accurate documentation of a mailing date.
