Forty Fort Cemetery Association Cemetery Gravesite Policies

The following items are not allowed

- Glass
- Coffee cans or cans of any type
- Paper mâché containers
- Edging
- Mulch

The following will be removed:

- Faded or damaged flowers
- Decorations that are not current with the season
- Arrangements or baskets considered unsightly by the cemetery management

Fake flowers are strongly discouraged and will be removed once they are faded.

Boarders are not permitted, as is mulch and edging.

After an interment and for a period of up to six months, temporary containers may be used if memorials have not yet been installed. Floral tributes are permitted at the time of internment, and will be removed three days after the service.

Permanent plantings which exceed the allowed space of 4 inches must have approval by the Forty Fort Cemetery Association.

Wreaths on stands are permitted only from November 1 until March 1.

Holiday potted plants and baskets are permitted two days before and one week after the following holidays: Easter, Mother's Day, Memorial Day, Father's Day. Those items not removed within the time frame will be removed by cemetery personnel.

Small American Flags are placed on veterans' graves on week prior to Memorial Day and replaced after one year. These flags are placed by veterans' groups and are provided by the county.

Family members are welcomed and encouraged to tend to their plots under condition the above guidelines are observed.
