## 2 Roads

Today we will explore 2 different roads.  
In opening I want to read a poem  
written by the American poet, Robert Frost—  
called "The Road Not Taken".

Two roads diverged in a yellow wood.  
And sorry I could not travel both—  
And being one traveler, long I stood  
And looked down one as far as I could  
To where it bent in the undergrowth;  
Then took the other, as just as fair,  
And having perhaps the better claim  
Because it was grassy and wanted wear

Though as for that, the passing there  
Had worn them really about the same

And both that morning equally lay  
And no leaves had trodden black

Oh, I kept the first for another day—  
Yet knowing how way leads on to way  
I doubted if I should ever come back  
I shall be telling this with a sigh  
Somewhere ages and ages hence—  
Two roads diverged in a wood, and I—  
I took the one less traveled by—  
And that has made all the difference.

Jesus tells us about 2 roads in  
Matthew 7:13-14 that refers to the two  
paths in life where we all must  
make a choice

Matthew 7:13-14

ENTER through the narrow gate - For wide  
is the gate and broad is the road that leads  
to destruction and many enter through it  
But small is the gate and narrow the  
road that leads to life, and only  
a few find it.

The Wide road represents the path of sin,  
destruction and eternal separation from God.

— Many take this road as it is easy  
and appealing to the flesh.

People tend to take the Path of  
least resistance

— This path leads to Spiritual death  
and Separation from God

The Narrow road represents the path of  
Righteousness, Salvation and eternal life  
with God.

Few people take this road as it can be  
difficult and requires Surrender and  
obedience to God

The Narrow road leads to Spiritual  
life and a deepening relationship with God.

Let us for a moment take a close  
look at the two roads in our minds

The Wide road is very inviting -  
We are drawn to it like a moth  
to a flame - Bright lights - loud music  
- lots of company - good food and drink



We see beautiful houses but they are built on sand. We see luxury cars - the latest fashion. There are no rules - No roadmaps. Everyone is bent on pleasure -

Their Motto is "Eat, Drink and be Merry for Tomorrow Never Comes"

We see undisciplined children, families torn apart. There are church buildings but many are teaching a false doctrine. Politicians are crooked and our country is divided. Unborn babies are destroyed because they interfere with the parent's life style. Men and women are unhappy - No peace - No real purpose in life. And the saddest thing of all - they don't realize their destination

Now let us look at the Narrow Road -  
At the entrance to that road is a gate.  
That gate is Jesus Christ

- #1 John 10:7-10
- #2 X John 14:6-7
- 3 X John 3:5
- 4 X Acts 4:12

He (Jesus) is Not A way - He is  
the one and only way.

No one, regardless of wealth, reputation, achievement, special knowledge or personal holiness can come to God the Father except through Jesus Christ.

AT the end of the Narrow Road  
we can repeat what Paul said in  
2 Timothy 4:7

I have fought the good fight,  
I have finished the race,  
I have kept the Faith.

Now there is in store for me the  
crown of Righteousness, which the  
Lord, the righteous judge, will  
award to me on that day - and not  
only to me, but also to all who  
have longed for His appearing

There are 4,000 to 6,000 active religions world wide - Many believe that different religions are just different roads to Heaven. But Jesus says there is only one road that leads to Life - meaning eternal life with God.

The gate that enters the Narrow Road is so narrow that you can only enter one person at a time. And you must leave behind a lot of baggage such as Greed, Selfishness, Pride, Unforgiveness, hatred, lying, Cheating

When you begin the Narrow road, Jesus will hand you a cross

Read 5

\* Matthew 16:24

You look down that road and it looks rough - covered with thorns - rocky - dark and all uphill and there are very few travelers - You say "Lord, I love you - I want to serve you but I'm afraid. And there is a Roaring Lion ready to devour me"

Jesus answers - You are not alone - I will never leave you nor forsake you I am giving you a Roadmap - called the Holy Bible - Trust me - Hold my Hand Along the way will be times of Refreshing - you will lie down in green pastures - I will lead you beside still waters. And when you walk through the Valley of the Shadow of Death - I will be with you -

Look back at the Wide Road for just a moment - At every mile there is a Sign - A way of escape - a chance to Change your mind -

That sign says Repent - Without Repentance we will not walk the Narrow Way
