divisions ('not for better but for worse') } common meal
Lords supper
some hungry
some gluttons

2nd verse problem? not discerning or considering the Lords ^{body} ~~oneness~~ unity $\Rightarrow$ body. 'Not considering one another's feelings'
harmony

1st Cor. 3:1-3 Carnal - of the flesh - not spiritual
(divisions among us) Thinking like men - Our battle not
