The January 9, 2018, meeting of the West Sangamon Public Library Board of Trustees was called to order at 6:58 p.m. by Vice-President Orr. Roll call was taken with six trustees in attendance, one trustee late, and Library Director Benanti present.

Minutes of Previous Meeting:

The November 7, 2017, minutes were read and approved.

Treasurer's Report:

The treasurer's report was distributed and read. As of this date, there are \$2,630.17 in the checking account and \$83,425.60 in the savings/money market. June Atkinson made a motion that the report be approved and Allicent Smith seconded. The report was approved by a roll call vote.

President Barth arrived and continued the meeting.

President's Report:

Reviews were made of the By-Laws, Sexual Harassment Policy, and Local Government Travel Expense Control Act with the following actions being takensqew23.

By-Laws: several areas needed to be updated. Linda Orr and June Atkinson will review the document and make recommendations.

Sexual Harassment Policy: the policy was adopted as presented.

Local Government Travel Expense Control Act: updates will be presented at a later meeting.

Director's Report:

The need for a Code of Conduct for library patrons and visitors was discussed. The following Code of Conduct was suggested:

- 1. No disturbances are allowed in this library.
- 2. Library staff determines if a disturbance is happening.
- 3. If you cause a disturbance, you will be asked to leave.

A motion was made by Martha Darling and seconded by Allicent Smith that these points be posted in the library as a Code of Conduct. The motion passed.

Committee Reports:
