GENERAL REGULATIONS

(For the conduct of competitions at QCAS affiliated Queensland Agricultural Shows)

Subject to the Rules, By-Laws and Regulations of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Associations Inc. and the Fraser Coast Agriculture Show Society Inc., the following General Regulations shall apply.

GENERAL REGULATIONS AND ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRIES

- 1 Judging will be performed by a Judge or panel of Judges appointed by the Fraser Coast Agriculture Show Society Inc.
- The attention of Exhibitors is drawn to the fact that entries are accepted subject to the Rules, By-Laws and Regulations of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies Inc. and the Fraser Coast Agriculture Show Society Inc. in addition to the Special Regulations which appear in this schedule. Copies of the Rules and By-Laws may be obtained upon application to the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies or the Fraser Coast Agriculture Show Society Inc.
- 3 No refunds will be made after close of entry.
- 4 THE FRASER COAST AGRICULTURE SHOW SOCIETY INC IS OPERATING UNDER THE QUEENSLAND AGRICULTURAL SHOWS & SHOWGROUNDS COVD SAFE PLAN. You must adhere to COVID safe key principles that apply to Fraser Coast Showgrounds and the Fraser Coast Show 2021.

NOTICE TO INTENDING EXHIBITORS

- 5 Entries for the upcoming Fraser Coast Agriculture Show can be made as described for each section in this schedule. Entries submitted other than on the correct form will be returned to the Exhibitor and, unless all requirements are complied with, and the forms returned to the Fraser Coast Agriculture Show office by completion of business on the closing date, as shown in this Schedule, they will not be considered.
- 6 Notwithstanding the provisions of General Regulation 6, late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Section Chief Steward.
- 7 Entries are accepted subject to the Rules, By-Laws and Regulations of the Association, in addition to any Special Regulations, which appear in the Associations Schedule. All completed Entry Forms remain the property of the Fraser Coast Agriculture Show Society Inc. and are to be returned to the Fraser Coast Agriculture Show Society Inc. office after the Show for further office procedures as required.
- 8 Exhibitors whose entries have not been accepted shall be advised accordingly and entry fees refunded.
- 9 The exhibitor irrevocably consents to the Association publishing or reproducing in any manner whatsoever any particulars or information in relation to their exhibits; the publication or reproduction may be in a printed form or visual image through electronic means and/or on the internet.

PRIVACY STATEMENT

The information provided by Exhibitors is used by the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Associations Inc. and the Fraser Coast Agriculture Show Society Inc. to organise, process and conduct competitions at the Fraser Coast Agriculture Show. By entering such competitions, you consent to your personal information being used for this purpose including this information being made available to sponsors, breed Associations, the media, the public, promotional purposes, archival purposes, published in publications and could be made available to other third parties for the purpose of promoting the Queensland Agricultural Show Movement, or as otherwise required by law. Exhibitors have a right of access to and alteration of personal information concerning themselves in terms of the Privacy Act. This may be done by contacting the QCAS Chief Executive Officer or by writing to the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies Inc.

WORKPLACE HEALTH AND SAFETY

- All Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies Inc. affiliated Associations Showground's are designated workplaces within the meaning of the Workplace Health and Safety Act 2011 and exhibitors / competitors are required to ensure that they and all persons under their direction or control, including their contractors or subcontractors, comply with all requirements of the Act. The Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Associations Inc. holds each exhibitor responsible to discharge its obligations to provide and maintain a safe place and system of work during occupation by the exhibitor/competitor of any area of the affiliated Agricultural Associations Showground's.
- 12 Each exhibitor/competitor will assess the risk to themselves, staff, volunteers, family, other exhibitors, Agricultural Society staff, show visitors, children and any person foreseeably affected by the presentation of their exhibit.
- Risks identified by exhibitors/competitors will be eliminated or controlled by the exhibitor/competitor and particular attention will be paid to ensuring public safety and safety of other exhibitors/competitors.
- 14 Exhibits will only be held and handled by competent persons whose experience is known to the Exhibitor/Competitor.
- 15 A "No Smoking Policy" will be strictly adhered to by exhibitors/competitors. Smoking areas are marked in "ORANGE MARKINGS/FLAGS" which are located near the Cane & Cattleman's Bar & Witches Hat Bar. No food or drink is allowed in the smoking area. The exhibitors/competitors are advised that the use of Primus stoves, any heating or lighting appliances of a like character, or any naked light, is strictly prohibited in pavilions.
- Any exhibitors/competitors intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showground's will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with residual current protection and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected by a licensed electrical contractor and currently tagged. The use of double adaptors is prohibited and all power boards must also be tested and tagged.
- All exhibitors/competitors will comply with the requirements of the Act and its Regulations and Standards in every other respect. This is essential for the safety of all exhibitors/competitors and the general public. The Act imposes very severe penalties in the event of noncompliance with its provisions. Any exhibitors/competitors who do not comply will not be allowed to exhibit at Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Associations Inc. affiliated Shows.

PRIZES AND GST

- 19 The Australian Taxation Office has deemed that GST is payable on prizes if an Exhibitor is registered for GST and enters an Exhibit as part of a business enterprise.
- 20 The information an Exhibitor provides on the Application for Entry determines whether GST is applicable.
- 21 Any prize stated in this Schedule does not include GST.
- 22 GST will not apply:
 - (a) If an Exhibitor enters an Exhibit as a hobby or private recreational pursuit; or
 - (b) If an Exhibitor enters an Exhibit as part of a business enterprise, the Exhibitor has an ABN, but the Exhibitor is NOT REGISTERED for GST.
 - (c) If an Exhibitor enters an Exhibit as part of a business enterprise, the Exhibitor is not entitled to an ABN as the business or enterprise is not operating in Australia.
- 23 GST will apply if an Exhibitor enters an Exhibit as part of a business enterprise, the Exhibitor has an ABN, and the Exhibitor is REGISTERED for GST.
- Where GST applies, the Association will pay the prize money quoted in this Schedule plus 10% GST. The Association will issue a recipient created tax invoice. *WARNING:* The Exhibitor must complete the Exhibitor's Declaration on the Application for Entry. The Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Associations Inc. recommends that the Exhibitor seeks professional advice before completing the Exhibitor Declaration

SECTION CONDITIONS:

(These conditions to be read in conjunction with the QCAS Special & General Horse Regulations.) A Horse Participant, Release and Acknowledgement Form, and a Biosecurity Animal Health Declaration /Movement Record is available on the website. These MUST BE PRINTED AND FILLED OUT COMPLETELY AND HANDED IN AT CENTRE RING. If these forms are not received together, no participation in events can be allowed.

Entry tickets **must** be handed to the Steward prior to the event commencing. **Clearly print showing rider's name and horse's name**. This information is vital to the accuracy of publication by the ring announcer and newspaper. Pick up your entry ticket into each class at **Centre Ring**.

- 1. **Stables:** Stables Must be **pre-booked online** at **frasercoastagshow.com**. The stable fees/rates are \$7 per night per stable/yard. Bond \$23 per stable, 5 horses or more Bond \$15 per stable. Stables will be available from Monday 17th May 2021 to Sunday 23rd May 2021. Open yards will be available to Showjump horses which carry the same fee and Bond as the Stables. Booking confirmation **MUST** be brought to the Horse Gate before entering Stables.
- 2. **Camping:** Camping sites are available for the duration of the Show period. Camping is \$11 per night per site, or \$66 for 7 nights. Sites can be prebooked on **frasercoastagshow.com**, then HORSES TO HORSEPOWER 2021 and confirmation presented at Horse Gate to receive your Camping Pass.
- 3. **Gate Entry Passes: (Discounted Fees)**: 1 day Adult: (17 yrs and over) \$12.00, Children: (5-16 yrs) \$5 Family Pass: (2 adults & 4 children) \$30.00, 2 days Adult: \$18.00, Children: \$8, Family Pass (2 adults & 4 children) \$40.00. Gate entry will be available for pre-purchase online at www.frasercoastagshow.com or can be purchased at the Gate via EFTPOS upon arrival.
- 4. **Prize Money** to be collected from the Show Office **Thurs 20**th & **Fri 21**st **May 2021** between 10am and 6.00pm. The Show Office will close at **6.00pm sharp**. No prize money payment will be given at Centre Ring.
- 5. The Society's Honorary Vet is Walker Street Veterinary Services. If you require the services of the Vet, please contact the Show Office.
- 6. ALL RIDERS MUST WEAR AN APPOVED SAFETY HELMET AS107 IN ALL EVENTS.
- 7. District Events are open to horses and riders who are residents in the cities of Maryborough, Hervey Bay and the Shire of the Fraser Coast Regional Council and have been so for a minimum of three (3) months.
- 8. The age of the horse shall be calculated from the first day of August. Every horse foaled before August in any year shall be deemed to be one (1) year old on that date.
- 9. No ring shall be required to wait for a competitor who may be competing in another ring.
- 10. If in the opinion of the Judge any horse or pony has been entered in the wrong class; the Judge shall have the authority/power to classify the horse/pony in the correct class.
- 11. A Maiden is a horse who has not won a first (1st) prize in a similar event at an affiliated show.
- 12. A Novice horse is one that has not won an Open Championship at any Agricultural Show.
- 13. Stallions are not permitted in hack classes, except in classes as listed (Breed Classes only). No persons under the age of 18 years are to handle stallions on the grounds or in the show ring.
- 14. Pony Hack must not exceed 14hh.
- 15. Pony Hack classes ne 12.2hh for riders under 17 years, 12.2hh and above can be ridden by anyone.
- 16. A Galloway Hack shall be 14hh not to exceeding 15hh.
- 17. Horses entered in Hunter classes are not eligible for Open Hack classes.
- 18. All horses must have a current height certificate acceptable to the Fraser Coast Agriculture Show Society.
- 19. A Judge or Steward may direct any person or horse from competition for bad conduct of one of both.
- 20. The Steward rather than the Judge shall sign performance cards during the continuance of the Show.
- 21. Correct attire including hard hats and riding boots must be worn for all events (however, jeans are permitted in novelty events).
- 22. The Fraser Coast Agriculture Show Society undertakes the rental of the Fraser Coast Showground's & Equestrian Park from the Fraser Coast Regional Council for the duration of the show period. The Society undertakes to rent the site and/or buildings in its present condition.
- 23. All electrical leads are required to be tagged and tested before coming onto the showground's indicating testing with-in the previous 12 months.
- 24. Entrant's attention is drawn to the QCAS SPECIAL HORSE REGULATIONS and the BIOSECURITY FOR FRASER COAST AG SHOW INFORMATION LEAFLET.
- 25. It is expected that competitors attend the Grand Parade otherwise prize money may be forfeited.
- 26. Social Distancing must be practised at all times, on and off your horse.
- 27. Competitors are to remain on the track until the Steward calls the class. At the end of each class competitors will exit the arena promptly. Competitors are not to congregate in Centre Ring.
