- Online Entries for 2023 Schedules must now be entered and paid online, (Online Entries go to www.frasercoastshow.com/schedules then to Stud Cattle online entries, click on button. An email confirmation will be sent to you.
- 2. ENTRIES close Wednesday 17th May 2023.
- 3. ENTRY FEES are \$11.00 (inc. GST) per entry for all Classes. The entry fee includes all bedding material (pine sawdust) supplied by the Fraser Coast Agriculture Show Society.
- 4. PRIZE MONEY The FCASS will pay cash in an envelope when handing out the sash/ribbon at the time of judging.
- 5. Animal Health Declaration Forms MUST be handed to the Steward on arrival.
- 6. The age of the cattle to be the actual age on 1 May 2023, date of birth is to be shown on entry form.
- 7. All cattle are to be on Maryborough Showgrounds by 8.00am Thursday 25 May 2023. Judging commences 10.00am Thursday 25 May 2023.
- 8. All cattle to be registered in the Herd Book or Calf Register of the respective Breed Society (proof of registration to be supplied on request if required).
- Exhibitors are to state on their entry form, the number of Classes in which they intend to compete and full particulars of each animal i.e. Name in full, Date of Birth, Breed, Herd Book Number, Stud Name, NLIS number and Address.
- 10. All cattle are to be the bona fide property of the exhibitor at least three (3) months prior to Friday 19th May 2023.
- 11. The responsibility for the accuracy of description and pedigree, and for the eligibility of each animal, rests solely with the exhibitor.
- 12. Any animal, which in the opinion of the Stewards, is not in a fit state to be exhibited, may be rejected by them and banned from competing in this Section.
- It is preferred by the Committee that all handlers presenting cattle to the Judges in the show ring wear a white dust coat or a breed approved uniform.
- 14. All cattle to remain on the Showgrounds until 4.00pm Friday 26 May 2023.
- 15. The Stewards have full control of the parade of cattle for judging and the right to limit the number of

- entries in a particular class. All reasonable care will be taken, but the Stewards and/or Show Society will not be responsible for any loss or injury to exhibits under control of the Stewards.
- 16. All animals must be free from ticks and dehorned or polled.
- 17. No dispute will be considered whilst the event is in progress.
- 18. Protests to be lodged in writing within thirty (30) minutes after the Class in dispute is completed and must be handed to the Show Office accompanied by a fee of \$50.
