2024 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Sampson-Webber (Gleaners) Distributed 1,031 non-perishable food packages to 773 families.
- Thanksgiving Boxes Delivered to 205 home-bound seniors through partnership with Tabernacle Missionary Baptist Church drivers.
- Diaper & Incontinence Program –
 Served 443 families through partnership with Metro. Detroit Diaper Bank.
- Angel Tree Program Hosted party for 90 children of incarcerated parents and distributed donated Christmas gifts.
- S.W. Community Court Provided community service and counseling to **16** individuals.
- Ministered to **5,872** Macomb Prison Inmates for Sunday Services.

• Shadow Step, first faith-based inhouse Mentorship Program at Macomb Correctional Facility had 16 Mentor graduates and 9 Mentee graduates. The other 7 Mentee graduates will graduate early 2025.
