

From the Pastor's Desk...



This photo of the sign above is what you see on my office door. There are a few specific reasons why it hangs there. First, Yoda is my spirit guide & leadership guru. That little green dude from Star Wars has gotten me out of a few jams in life. Second, the quote on this sign is one of my

favorites. It's deep and rich. "Try" is often a weak & wasted word - it's a way to remove responsibility from our plate, usually when we should own it. One of the things I say is "clarity is next to godliness." Try isn't a clear word.

Now, there's a pretty big reason why often in our world, people are not clear. When people are clear, they run the risk of ruining, threatening, or ending relationships. When teachers are clear, they end up running the risk students will fail, and parents won't like them. When bosses are clear, will like us. they end up running the risk of rebellion and mutiny in the workplace and making their job unstable. When politicians are clear, they run the risk they'll never get elected or re-elected. When pastors are clear, they run the risk of getting crucified. After

all, it didn't work out so well for Jesus at first.

Our world is fuzzy. And some forces in the world want it that way. Perhaps 2020-21 this fuzziness is the difficulty. Our world got even fuzzier. And the reason our world is so fuzzy? Well, it's simple. Teachers, bosses, coworkers, politicians, doctors, truck-drivers, electricians, pastors, well, everyone... all of us have an innate desire for other people to like us. In the short run, a fuzzy lack of being clear ends up with better odds people will like us

Well, while we're all fuzzy and use words like "I'll try," I think it's a good thing Jesus didn't really roll that way. After all, in Matthew 5:37 he did say "Let your yes be yes and your no be no." It's the same thing. And if
