




#### CD Notes:

Raymond James Acct will be estimated each month until the CD matures after 6-months or 1-year.

It is a 3.2% Callable CD so the owner could choose at 6 months to pay off the interest and we would then purchase another CD.

If the CD remains after 1-year the entire interest will be paid out (\$4,800). Then we can reassess a plan for that money.

We would also have the option of selling the CD at any point, but if it isn't at maturity it would likely be worth less than what we paid for it.




