

CIA: MISSION PUERTO RICO

When: Leaving MSP Airport early on June 19th. Returning June 24th.

Who: CIA/Senior High Youth (those have completed 8th Grade by June

19th, through 12th Grades).

What: We'll be participating in a program run by Youthworks, a mission

trip organization. You can check them out at youthworks.com

Cost: Maximum of approximately \$1049.00. *see below FAQ about cost

being less.

Transportation to/from San Juan, PR. (Approximately \$500).

• \$449 for Youthworks Program which includes service projects, lodging, & meals (lodging will be in churches or schools).

• \$100 for ground transportation in Puerto Rico.

Register: Our registration is two steps.

FAQ

Puerto Rico? That's huge and big and I'm afraid for my young person!

Take comfort in knowing that Pastor Lyle is pretty well versed in travel and places. It's a very safe place to go. If it were not safe for us, Youthworks, a very large and experienced provider of mission trip experiences would not have a program there!

Puerto Rico? Where is that?

Puerto Rico is a US Territory in the Caribbean, about 1,000 miles from Florida. Since it's a US Territory, your young person does not need a passport.

Chaperones?

Absolutely. Generally our goal is coverage is 6 to 1, both male and female chaperones. We already have 4 scheduled/committed (2 males, 2 females)

How do we pay for it?

We bill/invoice as we accumulate costs. We ask all costs be paid two weeks before we leave. \$1049 is approximate. It will likely be much, much less.

What? It won't cost the whole \$1049?

Nope. We've got some irons in the fire that will very significantly take down the cost...

- Funds from our St. Stephen Endowment
- Pre-existing credits with Youthworks for our last cancelled trip.
- We have a bunch of United Airlines flight credits.
- Current airfares to Puerto Rico are running \$360ish.
- Fundraising.
- Other tricks up our sleeve!

Fundraising?

Absolutely. We have quite a bit of fundraising. Announcements about fundraising opportunities will go on regularly and will be announced via mass email & text.

I have a friend that doesn't belong to St. Stephen. Can they come along? Absolutely. We love friends from other churches... or even if they don't have a church! And we won't even strong-arm them/their family to join St. Stephen (we want their church to be successful too).

What? There's a firm deadline? I thought St. Stephen didn't work that way! You're right! Typically St. Stephen does not work that way! But Puerto Rico is far enough away and there's quite a bit of moving parts going on related to registration & travel, that in order to plan we are going to keep firm on the deadline of 11/18 this time.

What about cell phones?

Let's see... sending your youth to a U.S. Territory where the majority language spoken isn't English... We think we'll keep your cell phone on your young person so you can contact them at anytime as that would be the good and prudent thing to do.
