The Dive Club currently holds monthly meetings on the first Tuesday of each month at the Tap Room in Bay Shore.



WRECK DIVING 2023 SCHEDULE

The following equipment is <u>required</u> for all wreck dives with The Dive Club:

- Secondary Air Source:doubles or pony bottle
- Wreck reel
- Lift bag OR Surface Marker Buoy
- Cutting tool
- Whistle or other sound device
- Strobe

Divers should be comfortable with the use of this gear.

To book a spot on the Sidekick Dive Boat, each diver must have certification for the planned depth of the wreck. **Deep Diving certification** is required for wrecks over 100ft.

To book a spot on the Sea Hawk or Sea Turtle, AOW certification is required.



WRECK DIVING REPORT JUNE 2023

The first wreck dive of the season was on May 28th on the Halftime dive boat out of Hampton Bays. The trip was amazing with warm, sunny weather and calm seas. It was a great way for the 6 Club members on board to start the season.

We traveled to the wreck of the Panther which is a 110 ft tug that sank on August 24, 1893. It sits in 55 ft of water. There are 2 pieces of the wreck that rise 5-15 ft off the sand. They are covered with fish. There was even an eel spotted hiding in the wreckage. The water temperature was 54 degrees and the visibility was 15 ft.

It was nice to start the season with a shallow, inshore dive. While we were looking out over the water during the surface interval I said to the group, "The only thing that could make this day better is if 2 dolphins surfaced right now".

Well, would you believe as soon as I said it, 2 dolphins did just that. And for the next hour of our surface interval we all watched as about 30 dolphins swam, surfaced and jumped all around the boat. I would not have believed it if I didn't see it. It was a magical day on the water on the Halftime with Captain Ralph Towlen and the crew Wally. It deserves a nice write up in to logbooks.


