**Closing Date:** Entries close at the Event Secretary’s address on **Wednesday August 19, 2020**, 6:00 PM or when the numerical limit (**90 dogs**) is reached, whichever is first.

**Refunds:**

Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the Club (**aka: Covid-19 virus**), it is impossible to open or complete the Event, **full refund** of entry fees will be made or un-cashed checks returned (or shredded). Upon inspection, entry fees for bitches in season (and lame or unfit dogs) will be refunded for runs not able to be completed.

**CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

All entries must be accompanied with a check to be valid. Entries received by phone, text, or email will not be accepted. Incomplete entries or forms without signature at bottom will not be accepted.

FastCAT events are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration. Dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form. Breed should be marked “All American Dog”.

Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog’s physical strength. Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The Inspection Committee has the authority to disallow any dog’s

entry into an Event. Bitches in season, lame and unfit dogs will be excused with entry refunded for runs not able to be completed

### **PRIZES**

**Qualifying Scores** - Ribbons are awarded to each dog receiving a qualifying score.

**New Title** – Rosettes awarded to each dog receiving a new title. Title awards are self-reported. **Please keep track of your points.**

### **Basic Information about Fast Coursing Ability Tests (FastCAT)**

Fast CAT is a timed straight 100-yard dash for dogs. It is meant to be a fun and healthy activity of interest to any dog owner. Dogs are run singularly.

#### **FastCAT Handicap, Points and Titles**

The dog’s time to complete the course is measured and converted to miles per hour [mph]. A handicap is applied to the dog’s mph to determine the number of points awarded. The handicap is based upon the dog’s height at the withers.

#### **Handicaps:**

- 18” or greater = no handicap. The points equal the mph of the run
- 12” to less than 18” = handicap of 1.5. The points equal the mph multiplied by 1.5
- Under 12” = handicap of 2. The points equal the mph multiplied by 2.

#### **Titles and Points Towards Titles:**

Titles are suffix titles earned at designated milestones:

BCAT Title - 150 points

DCAT Title - 500 points

\*FCAT Title - 1000 points

\*A FCAT number e.g. FCAT1 is awarded for each additional 500 points.

***Note: The speed of the top twenty fastest dogs is published on the AKC website (by breed) shortly after the event results are submitted to AKC.***

### **SCHEDULE (Quick Check)**

1. A handlers’ meeting will be held **30** minutes prior to run start time of each event.
2. All dogs will be inspected beginning at **8:00am** for AM runs (**12:00pm for PM runs**) for soundness and measured (if deemed necessary) prior to

running on that event date. All bitches will be checked for being in season once during the event day.

3. AM and PM run start times are **9:00am** and **1:00 pm**.

**Field Hours:** **8:00 am** to the conclusion of both events scheduled for the day of the tests.

**Check-in/inspection:** **8:00am** and throughout the day. Dogs must be checked in and inspected for soundness (and for bitches in season) only **once** prior to running in one or more AM or PM run blocks. In addition, the dog’s handicap must be verified at the time of inspection. A wicket will be available. The Field Committee reserves the right to wicket any entrant for size on the start date of a weekend event and that size will determine the handicap for the events on that weekend.

**Handlers Meeting:** **8:30am** for AM runs and at **12:30pm** for PM runs.

**Lunch:** A 60-minute lunch break (12:00pm to 1:00pm) will be scheduled at the discretion of the Event Committee. Visit local eateries (**you will be sent a list of area favorites**) or you can order EatStreet, Door Dash, Uber Eats deliveries to the event location any time during the day. Check the delivery service website for Fond du Lac eateries and see how they were rated (and how many reviews) before you order. **We will have a Posted Delivery Drop Off Point for you to meet up with the delivery driver.**

**Event Run Schedule:** AM runs will start at **9:00 am** each day. In the event of inclement weather or other conditions (or for timely completion of the event), the Event Committee may elect to start the events earlier than posted. In any case, all entrants present during the posted times will be allowed to run. **Afternoon events will start at 1:00 pm.**

Event workers will be scheduled to run first (if desired) so they can get to their assigned work stations for the rest of the event.

#### **Scheduling of Runs / New Concurrent Procedure / Note to Handlers:**

AKC is strongly recommending that all FastCAT events be scheduled to avoid crowds at the event site because of the **Covid-19 virus**. In response to that recommendation, we are going to schedule dogs to run both runs for each day either in the AM or PM. In this scenario, if you have one dog entered and you are scheduled in the AM to do both runs, your two runs will be scheduled over two of the six 15 dog AM blocks between 9am and Noon. If you have entered two dogs (with volunteer dogs running early), we should have enough AM spots to run an entrant’s second dog. Entrants that have completed their two runs on their one or two dog entry should have no reason to remain at the event site. If you choose to do so, the rules for “social distancing” will apply in the fenced-in run area and the parking lot. The PM portion will be run the same

way as the AM. AM entrants running a third and fourth dog will run along with PM entrant dogs. **NOTE: AM and PM spots will be assigned considering driving time to the event and the number of dogs entered by a single entrant. Longer distance entrants will be put in the PM for the Friday events and in the AM for the Sunday events. A request for a special run position in an event must accompany the entry form and will not be considered after entries are closed.**

We will be running six 30-minute (15 dog) blocks in both the AM and the PM so the time between runs for any given dog should be no less than 30-minutes. An entrant with a second dog in either the AM or PM will have to be aware of the run spots in the block for the two dogs so both dog and entrant are ready to go.

### **COURSE AND EQUIPMENT**

**Field Conditions:** The course is reasonably flat, level, and mowed. The actual running area is approximately 140 yards long x 5 yards wide with a combination of movable chain link fence sections and plastic-type barrier. The release line is ten feet behind the starting line. The course is 100 yards long with electronic start and finish line timers and up to a 40-yard run-out area. Handlers cannot walk/run the course with their dogs during the actual test.

**The Lure:** The lure is propelled by a CONTINUOUS LOOP LURE SYSTEM whereby the lure, consisting of a plastic bag lure attached to a braided line is dragged along the ground in front of the dog by a motor driven drive wheel. At the end of the run, the lure is returned to the starting line on the continuous loop outside of the run area by the same motor driven drive wheel and placed at the starting position prior to the next run. Only one line is in the run area during each run. Safety is always the number one consideration in running this event.

**Timing:** Timing will be by electronic timers with a second set of backup electronic timers on site. The time to complete the 100-yard dash is recorded to the nearest 1/100<sup>th</sup> of a second. The time starts when any part of the dog breaks the electronic beam at the start line and stops when any part of the dog breaks the beam at the finish line. In the unlikely event that manual (stopwatch) timing would be needed, a starter's will signal the start when the dog's nose crosses the starting line. The time will be recorded by two time-keepers, each operating a stopwatch individually, and will end when the dog's nose crosses the finish line. The time will be the average of the two manually recorded times.

### **Collars**

Dogs may wear any collar except a choker collar, a prong collar or an electronic training collar. Be aware that there is a chance that tags hanging from the collar would become entangled on something during the run. Clips or rubber bands may be used to hold the dog's hair. The owner assumes

responsibility for the safety of the dog with regard to the dog's collar and paraphernalia on the dog.

### **The Running Process**

The Paddock Master will coordinate the running of the dogs according to his/her best discretion. Dogs are scheduled according to the preliminary running schedule provided by the Event Secretary. Each entrant will receive a running order AM or PM block via email prior to the event. The schedule will also be posted in the inspection/paddock areas. Dogs will be called to "the line", "on deck" and "in the hole" positions. Dogs that are not present "in the hole" will be moved to the end of the running order in that block. Any dog not present by the time that the AM or PM event ends will be considered absent.

**The Start:** The Huntmaster directs the start of the test and is in control of the course and is in charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. He/she shall ensure that the handler understands safe release and retrieval procedures, that the lure is properly positioned, that the dog is properly positioned at the proper set back from the start, that the lure operator, timers and starting line signal person are ready and when all is in order, shall signal the lure operator to start the lure. Typically, the signal to release your dog is "***tallyho***".

**NOTE:** "Holders" will be available at the start line if you have no one to release your dog. Holders will be alternated and sanitize their hands between dogs.

**Operation of the Lure:** The Lure Operator's job is to: 1) ensure a safe run by operating the lure correctly; and, 2) to help get the best score for your dog.

If your dog is new to the sport, that may mean operating the lure just in front of the dog to maintain his/her attention to get the dog going. (NOTE: Dogs not finishing a run will not get a score.) Tell the Huntmaster your dog is a new dog to the sport.

If your dog is experienced and fast runner, simply advise the Huntmaster about your "fast dog". He/she will tell the lure operator to run the lure well ahead of the dog to achieve the fastest time. We want you to have a good score.

**The Finish and Retrieval of the Dog:** The principal delay in coursing events is the time it takes to retrieve dogs at the end of the runs. Please have someone familiar with the dog at the finish line prior to the time you get into the "in the hole" position in the running order. If you are having trouble retrieving your dog, please notify the Huntmaster that your dog is a "flight risk". We will attempt to assist in shortening the retrieval time with the use of an appropriate barrier.

### Waiver of Liability

Neither the Field Committees nor the Club will be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog on the event grounds, whether as a result of an accident or any other cause. It is clearly understood that every dog entered in the test is under the care, custody and control of its handler during the entire time the dog is on the premises. All owners/agents/exhibitors and other persons attending these tests hereby waive any claim against the club or its agents for any losses, damages, or injuries affecting self, dog, children, or personal property.

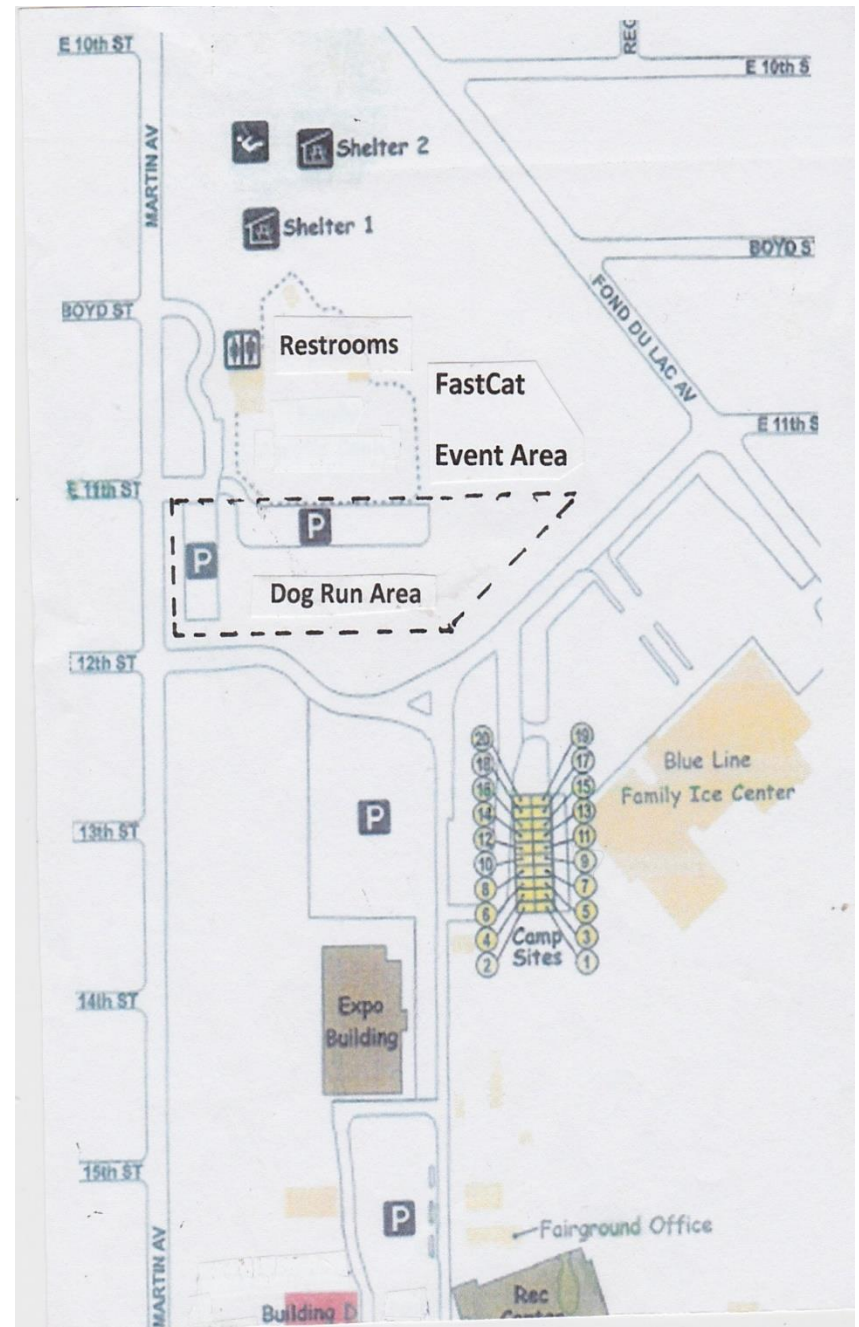
