SCENT WORK TRIALS –

BEST PRACTICES

September 25, 26, 2021

As the Fond du Lac County Kennel Club members prepare our grounds and ourselves to begin the process of hosting a scent work trial during this uncertain time of COVID 19, we would like to list some “best practices” that will be adhered to. We are doing our very best to provide our exhibitors, volunteers/workers, and our judges with an AKC sanctioned event that is safe and enjoyable. Please wear a face mask if physical distancing becomes difficult. Please be proactive and bring your own hand sanitizer and face masks. As information is continuously changing, these guidelines may be adjusted, if necessary.

Crating and Building Use:

There will be absolutely no crating indoors or use of the building by exhibitors.

Please be prepared to crate in your vehicle. Please be cognizant of social distancing while at your vehicles.

Access to the building for Restrooms only. Masks must be worn when in the building.

Grounds: There will be bottles of disinfectant stationed at each gate and throughout the grounds for sanitation use. If you have skin sensitivities, please plan accordingly and wear gloves if necessary. Disinfectant will be used to maintain safety of our grounds, equipment, exhibitors and members. E-Z ups will be allowed in the parking area. Please be aware of social distancing while on the grounds.

Trial Logistics: Masks: The CDC recommends that masks are worn when in close proximity to others. Please be sure to adhere to the CDC recommendations. We will require exhibitors to mask during their walk-through. Exhibitors will not be required to wear a mask during their search. Please be cognizant of social distancing and wear a face mask if physical distancing is difficult.

Check-in: The gate sheets will be posted on an easel outside the search area. Only the gate steward may check your dog in. If necessary, form a line with proper social distancing in order to check your dog(s) in for their run(s). Please do not touch the easel or the marking pen.

Results/Posting sheets: Results will be posted on the classroom windows on the north side of the building. Please be aware of social distancing while checking results. Please wear a face mask if physical distancing will be difficult.

Entry/Exit Gates: The gates (chain link) will be sprayed throughout the day with 24 hour disinfectant. The gate steward will operate the entry gate. When lining up to go into the ring for your search, please remember to social distance from other exhibitors.

Ribbons/Rosettes: Ribbons will be available at the front of the building as soon as they are available after your group has completed searching. Ribbons will be self-serve. Please be present to pick up your ribbon or have someone secure it for you. Please be cognizant of social distancing while waiting for ribbons and rosettes. Please wear a face mask if physical distancing will be difficult. The secretary will not distribute ribbons from inside the building. No ribbons will be mailed at the conclusion of the trial week-end.

If your dog has earned a new title, and a rosette, please contact a club volunteer and it will be made up for you. Congratulations!

Food: Unfortunately, no food will be served at the trial. Please plan accordingly.
