

Entries close 6:00 pm Fri, June 28, 2019, at which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered, or substituted; except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of AKC Dog Show Rules. Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms, including Agreement & Rules on reverse side.

Express mail must be sent "no signature required".

A maximum of ten entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes/transactions with more than the ten dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender. FdLCKC will not offer a "wait list".

Confirmation of receipt of your entry will be emailed if a valid address is on your entry. For US mail confirmation, please include a self-addressed stamped post card. After closing, email confirmations along with the judging schedule will be sent electronically, or if email is not available, hard copies will be sent via US mail.

FAX or ONLINE entries will **not** be accepted.



SITE INFORMATION: The trial will be outdoors on a flat grassy area. The Standard and JWW ring sizes are 100'x100' and are fully fenced. There is very little shade and tenting will be allowed. The building is **air conditioned**, and will be open for indoor crating. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or in the designated warm-up area.

GENERAL INFORMATION FOR ALL EXHIBITORS

Entry fees for bitches that come into season will receive a full **refund**. Dogs that are injured after the closing date will be refunded by mail, minus \$3.00 per day AKC fee. A veterinarian's certificate must be presented to the trial secretary prior to the start of judging for all refunds. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the judge or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$30.00 service charge for any returned checks. No post dated checks will be accepted.

CATALOG: Please mark your entry form if you wish to pre-pay for a catalog, \$7.00. A limited number of catalogs will be available for purchase the day of the trial.

The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for the **behavior** of his or her self, dog(s) and children. Any exhibitor whose self, dogs or children create unnecessary disturbance may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the site. In such case, no fees will be refunded. The Fond du Lac County Kennel Club, its agents, members, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

Exhibitors should follow their **veterinarians'** recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate **vaccinations**.

Camping & RV's are allowed for no charge on extreme southeast clubhouse grounds parking area. Please notify Trial Secretary if this is your intention.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER: This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS). Not eligible are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

PLEASE BE RESPONSIBLE EXHIBITORS Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the club grounds clean. Please pick up after your dogs. **ANYONE WITNESSED NOT PICKING UP AFTER HIS/HER DOGS WILL BE EXCUSED FROM THE TRIAL WITH NO MONIES REFUNDED.**

The Safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

THERE WILL BE NO OBSTACLE FAMILIARIZATION: OBSTACLES WILL CONFORM to current requirements of the AKC regulations. Weave poles are 24" on center. Electronic timing and electronic table counter may be used at this trial. All contacts are rubberized.

WARM-UP AREA: A warm-up area, consisting of one regulation agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors.

JUMP HEIGHT POLICY: When filling out an entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the trial secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs to be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 2, Section 4

HEIGHT DIVISIONS: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division and titling class. **REGULAR CLASSES:** Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper jump height. **PREFERRED CLASSES:** Handlers may run their dog in their proper eligible height

PRIZES AND AWARDS: Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to those dogs receiving qualifying scores. Rosettes will be awarded to First through Fourth place in each height division in all Novice and Open & FAST classes. Ribbons will be awarded to First through Fourth place in each height division in all Ex/Master classes. Ribbons will be awarded to First place and all qualifiers in Time2Beat classes. Only qualifying scores are eligible for rosettes and prizes. Title sashes will be awarded to all new titles. A metal QQ key ring will be awarded to those dogs qualifying in Master Standard and Master JWW on the same day. Any dog fulfilling the requirements for their MACH/PACH title will be awarded a "jump bar", title sash, and trophy.

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
