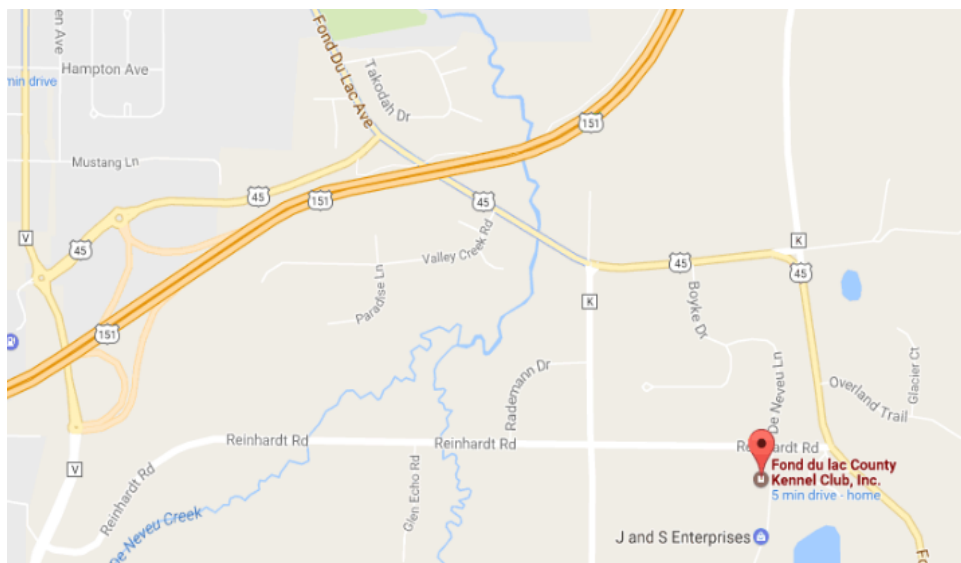

SITE INFORMATION: The trial will be outdoors on a flat grassy area. The Standard and JWW ring sizes are 100'x100' and are fully fenced. There is very little shade and tenting will be allowed. The building will be open for limited indoor crating. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or in the designated warm-up area.

GENERAL INFORMATION FOR ALL EXHIBITORS

Entry fees for bitches that come into season will receive a full refund. Dogs that are injured after the closing date will be refunded by mail, minus \$5.00 per day AKC fee. A veterinarian's certificate must be presented to the trial secretary prior to the start of judging for all refunds. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the judge or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$30.00 service charge for any returned checks. No post dated checks will be accepted.

Catalog: Please mark your entry form if you wish to pre-pay for a catalog, \$7.00. A limited number of catalogs will be available for purchase the day of the trial.

The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for the **behavior** of his or her self, dog(s) and children. Any exhibitor whose self, dogs or children create unnecessary disturbance may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the site. In such case, no fees will be refunded. The Fond du Lac County Kennel Club, its agents, members, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

Exhibitors should follow their **veterinarians'** recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate **vaccinations**.

Camping & RV's are allowed for no charge on extreme southeast clubhouse grounds parking area. There are no hookups available. Please notify Trial Secretary if this is your intention, we need to limit RV's to 4.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER: This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS). Not eligible are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

PLEASE BE RESPONSIBLE EXHIBITORS Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the club grounds clean. Please pick up after your dogs. **ANYONE WITNESSED NOT PICKING UP AFTER HIS/HER DOGS WILL BE EXCUSED FROM THE TRIAL WITH NO MONIES REFUNDED.**

The Safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

THERE WILL BE NO OBSTACLE FAMILIARIZATION: OBSTACLES WILL CONFORM to current requirements of the AKC regulations. Weave poles are 24" on center. Electronic timing will be used at this trial. All contacts are rubberized.

WARM-UP AREA: A warm-up area, consisting of one regulation agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors.

JUMP HEIGHT POLICY: When filling out an entry form, please check the appropriate jump height box so that the trial secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs to be Measured List*.

It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division and titling class. Dogs may jump in higher height class in regular classes, dogs must jump in proper height class in preferred classes.

PRIZES AND AWARDS: Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to those dogs receiving qualifying scores. Rosettes will be awarded to First through Fourth place in each height division in all Novice and Open classes. Ribbons will be awarded to First through Fourth place in each height division in all Ex/Master and FAST classes. Ribbons will be awarded to First place and all qualifiers in Time 2 Beat classes. Only qualifying scores are eligible for rosettes and prizes. Title sashes will be awarded to all new titles. A metal QQ key ring will be awarded to those dogs qualifying in Ex/Master Standard and Ex/Mas JWW on the same day. Any dog fulfilling the requirements for their MACH/PACH title will be awarded a "jump bar", title sash, and trophy.

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

CLASS CHANGES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2020

FOR EXHIBITION ONLY (FEO)

As of Jan 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the Entry form. The handler will declare the day of the trial.

Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO at the start line.

Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.

Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of trial level changes are not allowed.

Toys are allowed in the ring.

Toys must be non-audible

Toys may not leave the handler's hand

Toys that roll freely cannot be used

Food/Treats are not allowed in the ring.

FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and/or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.

A judge must monitor the entire run. A judge can stop a run at any time. The judge and ring crew must remain in the ring during an FEO run.

FIX AND GO ON (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, clubs holding agility trials will be required to offer Fix and Go On for all classes.

Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered, rather it occurs during the course of the run.

MULTIPLE JUMP HEIGHTS WITHIN THE SAME TRIAL DAY

As of January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend.

Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master Std/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a Mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same Trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.
