True Coast wines are the South in a glass, flirting with Mediterranean breezes in the Limoux vineyards. Here, grapes get VIP treatment, turning into wines that taste like they've been sunbathing and enjoying the diverse local weather. Pop open a bottle and get a taste of this sunny paradise. Crafted by Bruno Lafon and his wine-whispering crew, True Coast is a toast to French wine culture, blending old-school vino wisdom with a twist of now.

PRESENTATION

This Cabernet Sauvignon is a real showstopper with a character as rich and complex as a spicy novel. It's got all the signature boldness you'd expect from this famous grape, but with some extra twists thanks to its diverse homes - from the cool, intriguing Limoux to the sun-kissed coastal vineyards near Béziers. Each sip tells a story of its journey from vine to wine.

LOCATION

Bruno's magic touch brings together grapes from across the region, each vineyard with its unique charm. Imagine soils that let the rain dance right through, mixed with generous sunshine - a haven for Cabernet Sauvignon, Bordeaux's pride and joy. It's a delightful blend boldness and Bruno's Burgundian finesse, making this wine a true masterpiece that feels perfectly at home in his winery.

VINIFICATION

Bruno's sticking to the classic ways of winemaking, but with a cool twist. Think temperaturecontrolled fermentation for just the right vibe. The grapes hang out on their skins for a good long while, soaking up every bit of flavor. Then, they age gracefully in concrete vessels, giving them a chance to really come into their own before hitting the bottle. And yep, no oak in sight - it's all about keeping it pure and authentic.

TASTING
