Program Overview:

This program is designed to provide participants with a broad range of knowledge of the different areas in settlement. Participants will study a range of topics that include Canadian Law, Culture and Integration, Foundations of Settlement Workers, Case Management and Settlement Counselling, Introduction to Community Mental Health, and Safety and Life Skills for Newcomers among others.

Eligibility and Admissions Requirements:

Eligible students are unemployed individuals

- With a WorkBC case manager
- Who have established a claim for Employment Insurance (EI) benefits, or
- Who have had an EI benefit period that ended within the previous 60 months, or
- Who have earned more than \$2000 in insurable earnings and paid employee EI premiums on those earnings in at least 5 of the last 10 years, or
- Who are BCEA Persons with Disabilities or BCEA non-PWD clients

and

- Who have an Action Plan (AP) that identifies Settlement Practitioner as a reasonable step to achieve their occupational goal
- High School Graduate or Mature Student (19 years of age or more) and meet the College English Language Proficiency Assessment Test provided by WCC.
