DEADLINE TO SUBMIT ORATION FORM IS NO LATER THAN 5:00 P.M. Friday, August 29, 2025.



RULES

TIME LIMITATIONS

I. Primary Division (Ages 5-7)

The contestant must deliver their prepared oration in no fewer than two minutes.

II. INTERMEDIATE DIVISION (Ages 8-10)

The contestant must deliver their prepared oration in no fewer than two minutes.

III. JUNIOR DIVISION (Ages 11-13)

The contestant must deliver their prepared oration in no fewer than two minutes and no more than five minutes.

IV. SENIOR DIVISION (Ages 14-16)

The contestant must deliver their prepared oration in no fewer than two minutes and no more than five minutes.

V. SENIOR DIVISION (Ages 17-18)

The contestant must deliver their prepared oration in no fewer than two minutes and no more than five minutes.

Note: Timekeeper will indicate wrap-up time one minute before time expires.

RULES FOR THE 2025 STATEWIDE ALABAMA STATE CONFERENCE OF THE NAACP DELLA M. BRYANT ORATORICAL CONTEST

Eligibility

Participants must be a resident of Alabama, attend an Alabama School, and range in age from 5–18. Age categories are listed below.

Regulations

The official in charge of the contest will conduct a drawing to determine the order in which each contestant will appear. The chairperson will introduce the contestant. Each contestant will prepare their oration based on their theme according to their age. The contestant must deliver their prepared oration in no fewer than two minutes and no more than five minutes.

Age Groups

Ages 5-7 Ages 8-10 Ages 11-13 Ages 14-16 Ages 17-18

Attire

ATTIRE – All contestants must dress as follows:

- A. Boys –Dress slacks/pants, white shirts, and dark ties. Jackets are optional.
- B. Girls –Dress skirts, and white shirts, blouses, tops or turtlenecks.

JUDGING CRITERIA

Ages 11-18

- Aplomb poise, self-confidence, audience appeal
- Voice Quality audibility, articulations, inflection of voice, moderation of pitch
- Creativity and Relevant Content poetic and/or musical interpretation welcome
- Accuracy of Content
- Composition punctuation, spelling, grammar

JUDGING CRITERIA

Ages 5-10

- Aplomb poise, self-confidence, audience appeal
- Voice Quality audibility, articulations, inflection of voice, moderation of pitch
- Observance of Time Limit contestants should not go over nor under time limit
- Relevant Content poetic and/or musical interpretation welcome
- Composition punctuation, spelling, grammar,

Maximum awarded points in each area are 20 points for a maximum of 100 total points.
