4. Fundraising Overview

- o Key Points:
 - Fundraising Goal: The program aims to raise \$151,000 to cover operational expenses such as field maintenance, equipment, and uniforms.
 - **Direct Donations**: Parents were encouraged to use the Give Butter platform for collecting donations. The goal is to raise \$45,000 from direct donations.
 - Family Contributions: Families are asked to contribute \$1,000 per player, either in installments or as a lump sum. Participation from all families is highly encouraged.
 - Cornhole Tournament & Silent Auction: Scheduled for Sunday, November 17, 2024, from 10:00 AM to 2:30 PM at Lucky Luke's. Parents are encouraged to collect items for the silent auction and participate by registering teams.
 - **Sponsorships**: Businesses can purchase advertising space at the field, with packages ranging from \$250 to \$5,000. This provides an additional avenue for fundraising.
