Michael Biscardi bought this 55 Thunderbird in October 2024. He had always wanted one and was very particular about what color and type he wanted. It had to be Teal with all the power options that were available that year. He found this one for sale in Indianapolis and it had it all. At the time he was on temporary duty for the New York Air National Guard in Wichita Falls, TX. After a virtual walk-around with the sales manager at Grand Rapids Auto of Indianapolis, he sent them a check and had it shipped to Auto Restorations of Long Island in Upton.

The undercarriage needed the most attention as rust had accumulated over years of sitting in a garage. It needed new bushings, tie rods shocks, and a battery, to name a few. There was also an oil leak, which is common in most old cars. "The body maintained most of its structural integrity over the years with some minor blemishes, but once she gets a fresh coat of paint, she'll be almost be ready for show."

Upon his return from training, Biscardi quickly joined the Long Island Thunderbird club. He is the third owner of this 70 year old American classic.




