Our sponsors this year as in the past was Steve Siben of Siben & Siben and a new guy on the block, my next store neighbor Rob Lupinacci of White Wolf Cesspool. This year to save some bucks we judged for ourselves. The judging was soft to make life easier for all concerned. There were five judges. Pat McNulty who belongs to LITC and the Mustang Club, John Olesuk also from the Mustang Club from us was John Bianco also one of our own and from TONY was Stan Matusvwicz, and John Cattonar. The three judges received specialty awards which was a plaque with all the graphics.

A footnote to the show: we have seen some quality vehicles through the 18 years of this show but this year the quality was outstanding. It was really tough picking the two Best in Show and Top 50 awards.
