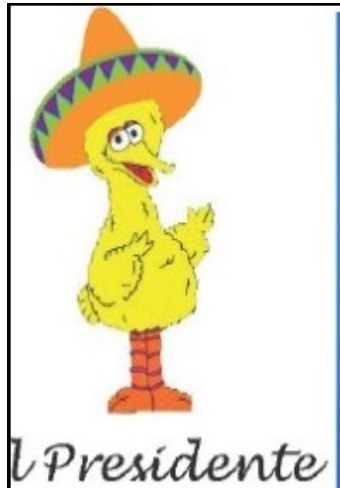

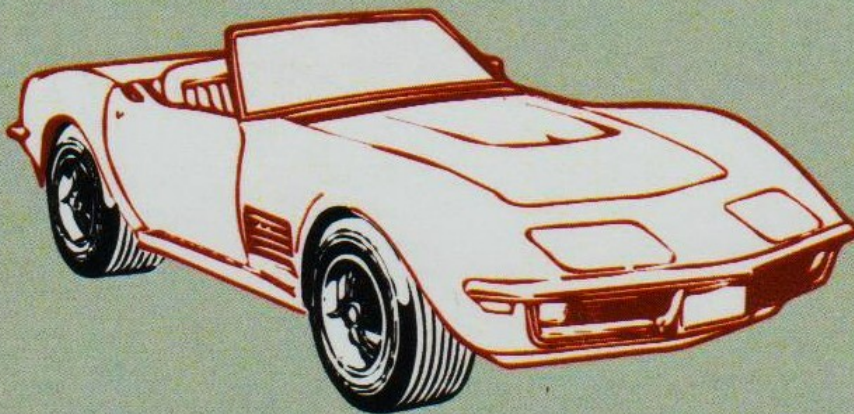

FORD THUNDERBIRD

Dearborn's personal-luxury liner remains affordable

If you had told Ford executives in 1966 that the new Bronco would someday become a white-hot collector vehicle while the luxurious Thunderbird languished in the shadows, you probably would have been laughed out of Dearborn. And yet, that's exactly what's happened.

As owners of fourth-generation Thunderbirds are probably aware, average values paid at auction have slumped 40 percent over the past five years and are continuing to trend downward, according to data from classic.com. While that's not welcome news to anyone looking to sell one, it may cause some buyers to take a second look at Ford's personal luxury coupe.

The fourth-generation Thunderbird was launched for the 1964 model year. Although it was only marginally longer and wider than the 1963 car, it had a much more massive appearance with heavily sculpted flanks and a more squared-off profile. It was offered as a convertible, a hard-top coupe, and a Landau, with a padded vinyl roof decorated with simulated landau bars.

The fourth-gen Thunderbird's styling underwent one significant update, in 1966, when the grille and taillights were altered. That year, the Landau was replaced by the Town Landau, which featured blind quarter panels for a more elegant look.

Other than body style, there wasn't much to choose among Thunderbirds; all were powered by a 390-cu.in. V8 coupled to a three-speed automatic and came with power steering and power brakes as standard equipment. Front disc brakes were adopted for 1965, while in 1966 the standard V8's output was raised from 300 hp to 315 hp. A 345-hp, 428-cu.in. "Q-code" V8 became optional that same year.

"Motor Trend" magazine summed up the new Ford Thunderbird as "a heavy, luxurious prestige four-seater that gives its owner a soft, smooth ride and every imaginable creature comfort." Reviewers noted that the car was more suited to the boulevard than the race track—but then again, this was before luxury cars were expected to be setting jaw-dropping numbers at

the Nürburgring and on the skid pad.

During its three-year production run, more than 236,000 fourth-generation Thunderbirds rolled out of Ford's Wixom, Michigan, assembly plant, which was shared with Lincoln. Of those, about nine in ten were either coupes or Landaus.

In spite of that, convertibles are not at all rare on the collector-car market. Over the past six months, classic.com recorded the sale of 36 1964-'66 Thunderbirds; of those, 15, or a little more than 40 percent, were convertibles. Collectors valued the convertibles highest, with an average sale price of nearly \$27,000, while there was little difference among the prices of the 21 coupes, Landaus and Town Landaus sold during that period, which brought an average of \$13,000.

While some buyers may be willing to pay more for the 428, it's worth noting that the most valuable fourth-generation Thunderbird sold at auction, according to classic.com, was a 390-powered 1964 convertible that traded hands for

\$126,500 at Barrett-Jackson's no-reserve 2025 Palm Beach auction. That nicely restored car was finished in the attention-grabbing shade of Florentine Green, and was equipped with wire wheels, a luggage rack, and a continental kit.

As of this writing, there are 46 fourth-generation Thunderbirds for sale on the Hemmings Marketplace. Asking prices range from a low of \$6,500 for a one-owner 1964 convertible described as a running and driving project car to a high of \$69,000 for a meticulously restored 1966 convertible. Among Hemmings' sold listings, the highest prices paid for open and closed cars have been \$42,105 for a 1966 convertible with the 428, and \$23,100 for a 1964 Landau in Florentine Green.

Whatever the reason for the sinking values—a generational shift among collectors, changing tastes, or something else entirely—the fourth-generation T-Bird represents a lot of car for the money. If you've ever been interested in owning one, now may be the time to take the plunge. ☘

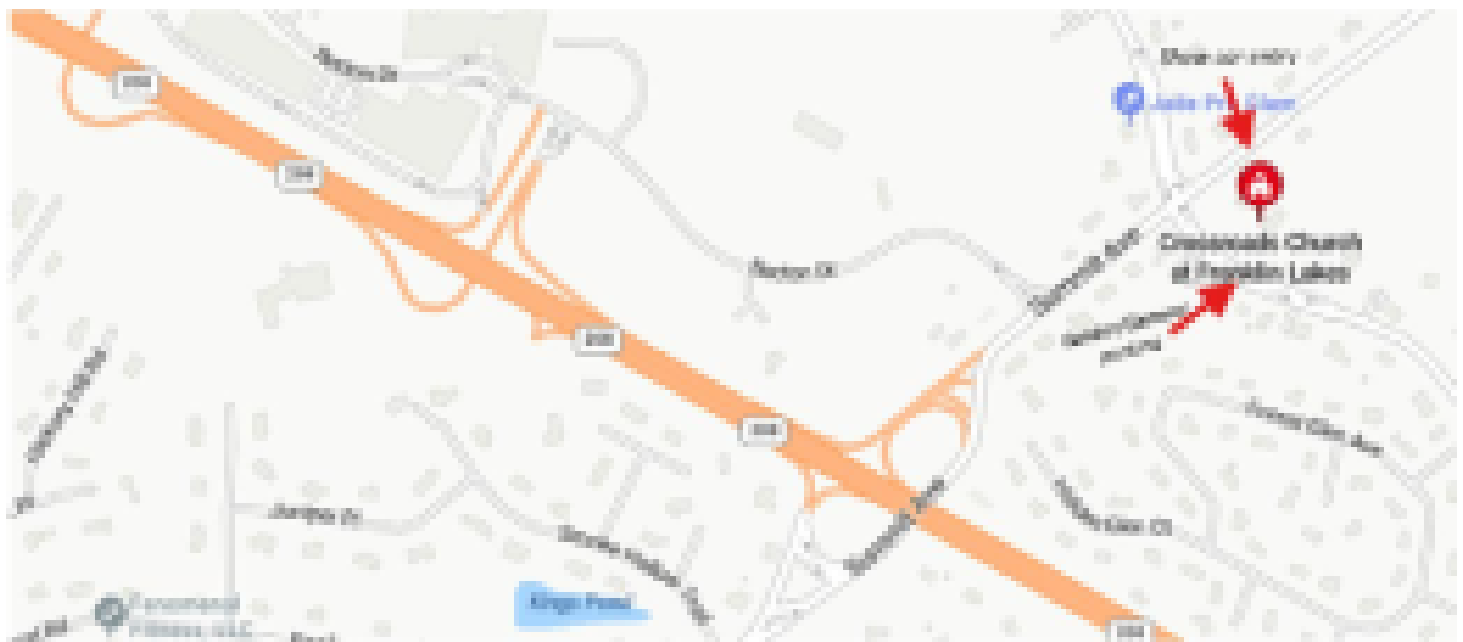

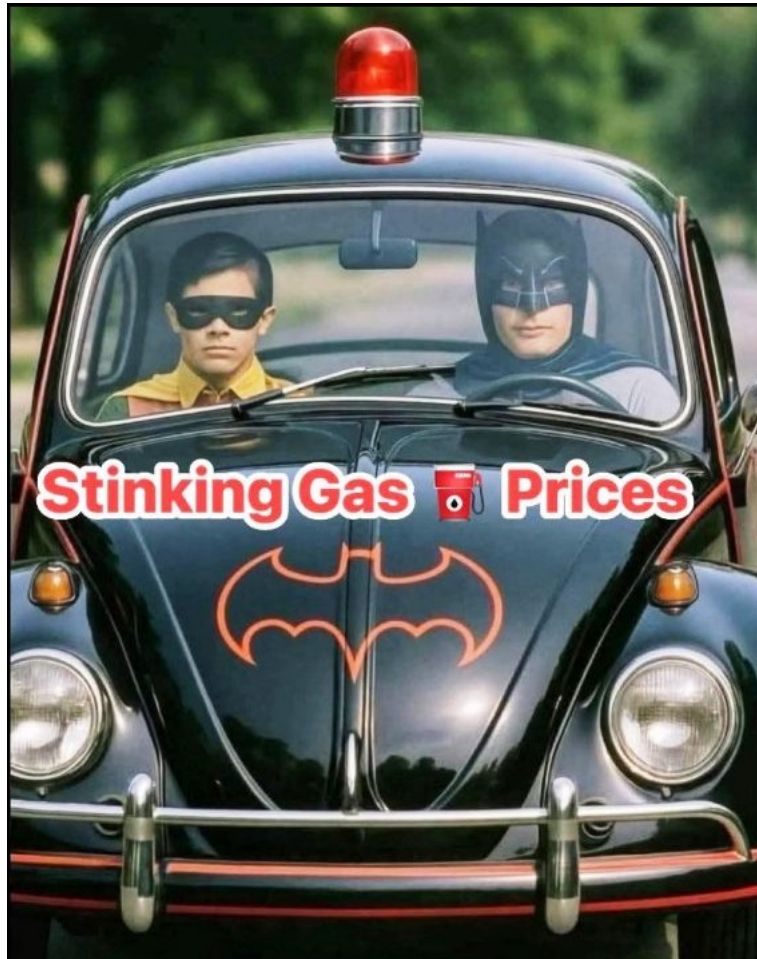
