- The odds of an accident goes up 23 times when texting and driving

In simple terms, distracted driving is multi-tasking behind the wheel. Here are some ways to avoid distracted driving

- Use a hands-free device. It gives a boost in safety, but does not eliminate all distractions
- Set essential controls before you back out of your parking spot, queue up the playlist, set climate controls and program any destinations into your GPS
- If you get lost, find a safe place to pull off the road to make changes to your GPS
- Suspend phone conversations in heavy traffic or bad weather even if your on a hands-free device
- On long drives, take breaks to rest your eyes
