N.C. now has a "Everybody Works Campaign". It was launched to increase awareness of the untapped pool of talent found in the N.C. disability community. On the website: www.nccdd.org, there are three options to choose from: one is for employers looking to hire people with disabilities, one for people with disabilities looking for employment, and one for information about the campaign. 1 out of 3 employers report that people with disabilities stay longer, people with disabilities are rated equally or more productive than coworkers, and people with disabilities achieve equal or better job performance ratings. The hope is that this program will help both people looking for employment and the businesses that need good employees.
