Did you know?

Hurricane Dorian may impact North Carolina this week. It is important to be prepared, especially if you are in the eastern part of the state. A hurricane preparedness kit may include the following:

- Water: stored in a plastic container, not glass. Have at least a 3 day supply
- Food: non-perishable items, also at least a 3 day supply
- A first aid kit
- Non-prescription medications such as aspirin or non-aspirin pain medication
- Tools: tape, utility knife, etc.
- Supplies such as rain gear, disinfectant, toiletries
- Personal records and documents kept in a waterproof and portable container
- All Prescription Medications
- A phone charger
- Several days' worth of clothing

Stay informed and follow instructions given by local law enforcement and government officials.
