Von & On Ministries wishes you, your family and loved ones a Merry Christmas and Prosperous New Year! Firstly we give thanks to God, for without Him none of this would be possible! Likewise we are also grateful to Him for your lives, for the times we spend with you as "family" and for your trust.

If we go back a few years to our childhoods many of us can recall how we believed that if we behaved well and did not do bad things for the whole year, we would eventually receive a gift.

Through this letter we want to share with you two pieces of news... one of them is bad, and the other super good ...

The "BAD NEWS" is ... We are all sinners and we all do bad/evil things. (Genesis 6:5)

The "GOOD NEWS" is ... Despite our sins, God has given us the best, in fact the VERY BEST gift that could ever be given. He has given us His Son, so that through Him we can have forgiveness, salvation and eternal life. (John 3:16)

CHRISTMAS AT THE REHAB



About a year ago, our team paid a visit to a young father, who after some persuasion admitted himself into a drug rehab center. He's since completed his stay there, now lives with his family again and is back at work. Our initial visit though, opened up ministry opportunities to others at the rehab which has been growing since. A pastor and several other christian men now visit regularly to teach, encourage and pray with them. We at V&O continues to support this with monthly visits, bibles and meals. There are about 200 residents at the rehab, most are recovering from addictions, others suffer from mental illness. The ages range from early teens to mid 60s.
