It's official, June 20 marked the beginning of summer! Good business ahead for ice cream vendors, especially in the hot, dusty, kid filled barrios where we work! However, for one ice cream vendor things have not been looking too good for the summer ahead...

Don Jesús has been pushing his cart up and down the steep and potholed roads in his area and beyond for many years. A familiar face in his neighborhoods, Don Jesús is respected and appreciated for what he does. As a faithful Christian man, Don Jesús is known not only for providing cool *edible* refreshments on hot summer days, but also for his listening ear to those who may be needing *spiritual* refreshment as well. Don Jesús takes

time to ask his customers how they are doing with a genuine interest in what's going on in their lives. For him to spend 30 minutes or more with someone who needs to share their troubles, is not uncommon. He often prays for them and also invites them to his church. Although it may cost him time/businesswise on occasions, Don Jesús says he knows God will always bless him regardless.

This month it came to our attention, (through his wife Susana, who is in our sewing class), that Don Jesús was not out and about working as usual. At 61 years old, the physical effort of constantly pushing his cart uphill has taken its toll. He has 3 hernias, one of which is large and beginning to obstruct his intestines. He cannot push his cart anymore and he needs surgery, soon!

Although he's been on the waiting list at General Hospital for years, he (like many others), fears having surgery there and with the extra backlog, shortage

of staff etc. due to COVID, it doesn't look like "soon" would be a likely scenario anyway. So, after praying, and persuading Don Jesús to see Dr

So, after praying, and persuading Don Jesús to see Dr Santos, (V&O "go-to" doctor), who has been extremely helpful, God has made it possible for Don Jesús to have the surgery next week. Providing all his preliminary tests come back ok, he is scheduled for Monday! Of course, it won't be cheap, at least by Don Jesús standards, \$2400 is an insurmountable amount for a family like his, especially with his lost income now. However, the family is pitching in to help as best they can, along with his church family and neighbors. And although our medical account is primarily used for kids and teens, we believe God is leading us to help Don Jesús in this situation also. So, the amount remaining after the community collection is finished, will be funded by V&O and thankfully, because of many of you, sufficient funds are available to help!

For many of us here on the supporting side of the ministry, it's incomprehensible to think that a fairly common

surgery would be so far out of reach and could mean life or death because of a few thousand dollars. Yet for the poor, this happens all too often! Don Jesús and Susana's gratitude to God and His people has been clearly
