Nomination Guidelines

Please read before applying or nominating a homeowner.

Every 10 remodels completed = 1 homeowner helped.

Our quarterly goal is to complete 10 paid kitchen or bathroom remodels so Keystone Impact can sponsor one meaningful home improvement project for a homeowner in need.

How to Apply or Nominate Someone

- All nominations must be submitted through the official Keystone Impact form only.
- Please include the homeowner story, basic project need, photos if requested, and correct contact information.
- Submitting a nomination does not guarantee approval, selection, or a free remodel.
- Keystone Impact will contact selected applicants or nominees if more information is needed.

Important Communication Rules

To keep the program fair and organized, all communication must go through the official application process. Please do not call the office, walk in without an appointment, show up to job sites, send repeated messages, or contact staff through personal social media accounts regarding a Keystone Impact nomination.

Any applicant, nominee, or representative who continues to contact Keystone outside the official process may be automatically removed from consideration.

What Keystone Impact May Help With

- Bathroom safety improvements
- Cabinet repairs or practical kitchen improvements
- Flooring or repair issues that affect safety or function
- Accessibility improvements for seniors or disabled homeowners
- Other small home improvement needs based on available funding and scope

What Keystone Impact Does Not Guarantee

- A full remodel, luxury upgrade, specific dollar amount, or immediate approval
- Emergency repair service or same day response
- Approval based on repeated calls, emotional pressure, office visits, or social media contact
- Selection on a first come, first served basis

Selection Process

- Applications and nominations are reviewed based on need, safety, impact, project size, homeowner circumstances, available funding, and Keystone schedule.
- If a project is selected, Keystone will contact the applicant or nominee directly. If you are not contacted, the project has not been selected at this time.
- Keystone may request photos, proof of homeownership or permission, project details, and additional information before making a final decision.

Please respect the process.
