Honoured with an **OBE by Queen Elizabeth II** for championing diversity, she is ranked among the *Top 100 Most Influential Black, Asian and Minority Ethnic Leaders*. Dr. Hothi is **Chief Strategy Officer at GoldenPoint Global Fund**, bridging investments across Riyadh, the US, UK, and India, and has advised 300+ organizations on leadership, culture, and governance. She also serves on global nonprofit and ESG boards, driving purposeful and inclusive change.

Dr. Kamel Hothi OBE has been a trailblazer in the banking industry for over four decades, breaking multiple glass ceilings on her journey from becoming the UK's first Asian bank manager to senior leadership as Director, Strategist, and Architect of industry-wide initiatives that reshaped financial services. Recognized among the UK's *Top 100 Most Influential Black, Asian and Minority Ethnic Leaders*, she was awarded the **Order of the British Empire (OBE)** by Her Late Majesty Queen Elizabeth II in 2017 for championing diversity and inclusion across banking.

Today, Dr. Hothi is the **Chief Strategy Officer at GoldenPoint Global Fund**, bridging investments across Riyadh, the United States, the UK, and India. She has advised over 300 organizations on leadership, cultural transformation, and governance, alongside managing her own family property business.
