**JUDGMENT**

The above-captioned case came for jury trial on June 22, 2026 – June 24, 2026, before District Judge Carl J. Barbier.

Considering the answers of the jury to the interrogatories propounded by the Court at the trial of this matter; and further considering the direction of the Court as to entry of judgment, accordingly,


IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that there be judgment in favor of Plaintiffs Tanya Carpenter and High Road Productions, LLC, and against Defendants Tangipahoa Parish and Robby Miller, individually and in his capacity as Parish President, jointly and *in solido*, in the amount of [REDACTED], together with judicial interest from date of judgment until paid, and for all taxable court costs.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that there be judgment in favor of Plaintiffs Tanya Carpenter and High Road Productions, LLC, and against Defendant Robby Miller, individually and in his capacity as Parish President, in the amount of [REDACTED], together with judicial interest from date of judgment until paid, and for all taxable court costs.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiffs shall submit their motion for reasonable attorney's fees and expenses pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 54(d)(2) not later than

twenty-one (21) days after the entry of judgment. Defendants shall file their response thereto no later than fourteen (14) days after Plaintiffs' filing.
