The remainder of the day enjoy the hotel facilities which include indoor and outdoor pools or take a short walk to the beach and enjoy the Mediterranean Sea.

April 14th This morning you will travel to the Great city of Barcelona. You will visit the most famous soccer stadium in Spain Nou Camp Stadium where you will see the dressing rooms, the spectacular field and & beautiful museum with all the trophies won by the most important team in Catalonia.

This afternoon we will discover Barcelona, while walking along the Ramblas to the Boqueria and then to the medieval Barri Gothic, the original Gothic Quarter, where narrow streets and squares date back to the Middle Ages Visit the 13th-century "La Seu" cathedral.





Next, take in views of the Mediterranean Sea and the Barcelona Coast on the way to the Olympic Village (Vila Olimpica), home to athletes during the 1992 summer Olympics, and the Port Olympic then we will see Gaudi's La Sagrada Familia Cathedral.



April 15th Today we travel to Visit

Tossa De Mar beautifully restored and overlooking its sheltered horseshoe bay, Tossa de Mar is undoubtedly one of the prettiest resort towns on the entire coast. The Vila Vella (Old Town) - more than 800 years old and declared a National Historic Monument – walk through its perfectly preserved cobbled streets and stone and whitewashed houses. Protected by its 12th century wall and seven towers, the Old Town is a maze of artists' galleries, cafés and is smothered in dazzling flowers for much of the year. Evening match with local Spanish club.



April 16th This morning we will visit - the sacred mountain of Montserrat. The Benedictine monastery resembles a gigantic fortress which offers you some of the most spectacular mountain views of Catalunya. You will be able to listen to the World famous Montserrat Choir boys sing during your visit.



April 17th This morning we will travel to the Dali Museum in Figueres. After the museum visit the trip continues to Girona the ancient

town several thousand years old in [Catalonia](#). We will walk through Girona's historical city center and visit the old Jewish quarter, which is one of the best preserved in Europe, Saint Felix church, the Cathedral with its Tapestry of Creation and walk the paths around the old Roman city walls with its fantastic views of the city below. The tour will also include a visit to 13th Century Arabian Baths and Archaeological Museum. This evening your team will visit another Spanish Soccer Complex to play your last game vs. a local Spanish Team.

April 18th This morning we will journey to the town of Besalú, a wonderful medieval town in the comarca of Garrotxa, in Catalonia. The town features arcaded streets and squares, a 12th-century [Romanesque](#) bridge over the [Fluvià](#) river and also a restored [mikveh](#), a ritual Jewish bath dating from the eleventh or twelfth century and the church of Sant Pere which was consecrated in 1003.

This evening we will have dinner and see a flamenco show at *Castell Medieval "Comte de Valltordera"* in Tordera.
