Deciding it was time to settle down he began his teaching career as a physical education instructor in the Rochester City School District. He is married and has two children.

Saturday, March 26th

Departure from Greece, NY to Toronto International Airport for your flight to Barcelona, Spain.

Sunday, March 27th This morning, you will arrive at the El Prat International Airport in Barcelona. Waiting for you will be a Sport Tour International representative who will take care of all your arrangements for the remainder of your European tour. We will transfer your team by private charter bus to your Superior Class Hotel in Lloret de Mar. The remainder of the day enjoy the hotel facilities, which include indoor and outdoor pools or take a short walk to the beach and enjoy the Mediterranean Sea.

Monday, March 28th This morning, you will travel to the Great city of Barcelona. You will visit the most famous soccer stadium in Spain Nou Camp Stadium were you will see the dressing rooms, the spectacular field and beautiful museum with all the trophies won by the most important team in Catalonia.

This afternoon we will discover Barcelona, while walking along the Ramblas to the Boqueria and then to the



medieval Barri Gothic, the original Gothic Quarter, where narrow streets and squares date

back to the Middle Ages. Visit the 13th-century "La Seu" cathedral.


Next, take in views of the Mediterranean Sea and the Barcelona Coast on the way to the Olympic Village (Vila Olimpica), home to athletes during the 1992 summer Olympics, and the Port Olympic then we will see Gaudi's La Sagrada Familia Cathedral.

In the evening, your bus will depart to a local soccer club for your first game vs. a Local Spanish Club team.



Tuesday, March 29th Today, we travel to Visit Tossa De Mar beautifully restored and overlooking its sheltered horseshoe bay, Tossa de Mar is undoubtedly one of the prettiest resort towns on the entire coast. The Vila Vella (Old Town) - more than 800 years old and declared a National Historic Monument – walk through its perfectly preserved cobbled streets and stone and whitewashed houses. Protected by its 12th century wall and seven towers, the Old Town is a maze of artists' galleries, cafés and is smothered in dazzling flowers for much of the year. Evening match with local Spanish club.





Wednesday, March 30th This morning we will visit - the sacred mountain of Montserrat. The Benedictine monastery resembles a gigantic fortress, which offers you some of the most spectacular mountain views of Catalunya. You will be able to listen to the World famous Montserrat Choir boys sing during your visit.

Thursday, March 31st This morning, we will travel to the Dali Museum in Figueres. After the museum visit, the trip continues to Girona the ancient town several thousand years old in <u>Catalonia</u>. We will walk through Girona's

historical city center and visit the old Jewish quarter, which is one of the best, preserved in Europe, Saint Felix church, the Cathedral with its Tapestry of Creation and walk the paths around the old Roman city walls with its fantastic views of the city below. The tour will also include a visit to 13th Century Arabian Baths and Archaeological Museum. This evening your team will visit another Spanish Soccer Complex to play your last game vs. a local Spanish Team.

Friday, April 1st This morning, we will journey to the town of Besalú, a wonderful medieval town in the comarca of Garrotxa, in Catalonia. The town features arcaded streets and squares, a 12th-century <u>Romanesque</u> bridge over the <u>Fluvià</u> river and also a restored <u>mikveh</u>, a ritual Jewish bath dating from the eleventh or twelfth century and the church of Sant Pere, which was consecrated in 1003.

This evening we will have dinner and see a flamenco show at *Castell Medieval* "*Comte de Valltordera*" in Tordera.

In these conditions, EuroSports Network ("ESN") stands for the Eurosports Network Inc. agents and representatives in Europe and the U.S.A.

1. Application

An application will be binding after the confirmation of acceptance of EuroSports Network (ESN). Upon confirmation of acceptance; all arrangements are under proviso of availability.

ESN withholds the right to substitute at any moment the housing accommodation, and/or to alternate the program for circumstances, which are beyond control. The substitute housing accommodation, and/or the alternate program, should meet the same criteria as established in the confirmation of acceptance.

- Tour payments US\$ 400.00 deposit (non-refundable) per person upon Booking. The remaining amount will be paid according to the schedule as mentioned on page I.10. ESN reserves the right to void the booking in case of serious delay of payment. In this case, ESN will refund the received payments minus the cancellation fees. (See 4)
- 3. Rate of exchange

The tour costs are based figuring the exchange rate of US \$ towards the Euro in August 2015. The tour costs may fluctuate based on changes in the exchange rate. Eventual surcharges must be paid together with the final payment.

4. Cancellation

All cancellations must be received in writing. The day that the notification is received by ESN is the effective cancellation date. The cancellation charges are US \$ 400.00 per person plus eventual additional costs incurred by ESN with respect to its obligations to its purveyors such as, but not limited to: airlines, bus companies, housing accommodations and sports clubs.

5. Passport

All participants must be able to present a valid passport. The fee for the passport is not included in the tour costs.

6. Exclusion from participation

ESN withholds the right to exclude any participant from further participation due to serious behavior. There will be no refund for the unused portion of the tour. Serious or unacceptable behavior includes, but is not limited to violation of regulations of the tour management, housing accommodations and transportation companies. If any participant is found to be responsible for any damage while on the tour, he/she will be required to pay immediately for such damages.

7. Sport program

ESN acts as an intermediary and will prepare the desired sport program with great care. Neither ESN nor the hosting sports club accepts any responsibility for the omission or partial omission of the sport program due to circumstances beyond control, such as, but not limited to, bad weather conditions.

PASSPORTS

Everyone traveling in our group must have a valid passport from their country of citizenship. United States passport applications are available at U.S. post offices, clerical courts, local passport offices, and some DMV offices. Application for a new passport must be done in person. Obtaining a new passport is a seven-step process:

- 1. **Complete the passport application** form DS-11. Passport applications can be acquired at the DMV. (Note: Do not sign the application until the clerk instructs you to do so.)
- 2. **Present proof of U.S. Citizenship**. You may prove citizenship by presenting one of the following:
 - Previous U.S. passport
 - Naturalization certificate
 - > Birth certificate
 - Certificate of citizenship

Present proof of identity. You may prove your identity with the following documents:

- Previous U.S. passport
- Naturalization certificate
- Driver's license
- Military identification

Please note: Your Social Security card does not prove your identity.

- 3. **Provide two passport photos**. It is highly advised that passport photos be taken by a professional agency. You can also try an online service to save time and money <u>http://www.epassportphoto.com/</u>
- 4. **Pay the applicable fee**. Total fees are \$97 for applicants 16 years of age or older and \$82 for applicants under 16 years of age.
- 5. Provide your Social Security number.
