The Organizers

Mike Balducci -The Founder of EuroSports Network - Rochester, NY

Mike Balducci was the head soccer coach at Greece Arcadia and Greece Athena High School. During his years in Greece, his teams won 12 league titles. Coach Balducci compiled a record of 274-52-43, winning seven Section V titles, four trips to the state finals with two state championships. And with his roots originating in Italy, Mike Balducci knows the ins and outs of Europe and European soccer. The All-County Soccer Team program started in 1987. Each year Mike has sent many young athletes to Europe, in close cooperation with the European Soccer federations and Dream Team Italy.

Tour Director and Head Coach – Rochester, NY Nino Pilato

Coach Pilato is the head coach at McQuaid Jesuit High School in Rochester, NY. Over the past 3 seasons at McQuaid he has compiled a record of 48-4-2, with a Section V and NY State Championship in 2017. The previous 17 years he was the Girls' Varsity Head Coach Odyssey Academy in Greece, having Won Sectional Titles 8 times, in 2003, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2010, 2011, 2012 and 2014. His teams have made four trips to the State Finals, winning it all in 2012. His dedication to his player's overall development has been rewarded his being selected as coach of the year in Monroe County Division III 6 times, Section V Class AA, CC once, CCC once and Class B 3 times and Section V All-Greater Rochester Coach of the Year in 2005, 2012 and 2017. He was a four-year college starter and an All-American sweeper at Canisius College. After his college career ended he played four years of professional soccer both in Europe and the USA. Deciding it was time to settle down he began his teaching career as a physical education instructor in the Rochester City School District. He is married and has two children.

This morning, we will journey to the town of Besalú, a beautiful medieval town in the comarca of Garrotxa, in Catalonia. The town features arcaded streets and squares, a 12th-century [Romanesque](#) bridge over the [Fluvià](#) river and also a restored [mikveh](#), a Jewish ritual bath dating from the eleventh or twelfth century and the church of Sant Pere, which was consecrated in 1003.

Tuesday, April 16th



9.00 Departure to Barcelona.

10:30 Camp Nou Experience You will visit the most famous soccer stadium in Spain Nou Camp Stadium where you will see the dressing rooms, the spectacular field and a beautiful museum with all the trophies won by the most important team in Catalonia.

This afternoon we will discover Barcelona while walking along the Ramblas to the Boqueria and then to the medieval Barri Gothic, the original Gothic Quarter, where narrow streets and squares date back to the Middle Ages. Visit the 13th-century "La Seu" cathedral. Next, take in views of the Mediterranean Sea and the Barcelona Coast on the way to the Olympic Village, home to athletes during the 1992 summer Olympics, and the Port Olympic then we will see Gaudi's La Sagrada Familia Cathedral.

The Vila Vella (Old Town) - more than 800 years old and declared a National Historic Monument – walk through its perfectly preserved cobbled streets and stone and whitewashed houses. Protected by its 12th-century wall and seven towers, the Old Town is a maze of artists' galleries, cafés and is smothered in dazzling flowers for much of the year.

This morning, we will travel to Girona the ancient town several thousand years old in [Catalonia](#). We will walk through Girona's historic city center and visit the old Jewish quarter, which is one of the best, preserved in Europe, Saint Felix church, the Cathedral with its Tapestry of Creation and walk the paths around the old Roman city walls with its fantastic views of the city below. The tour will also include a visit to 13th Century Arabian Baths and Archaeological Museum.

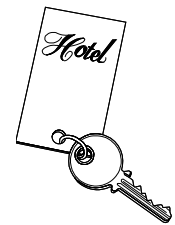

EUROSPORTS NETWORK TOUR CONDITIONS

In these conditions, EuroSports Network ("ESN") stands for the EuroSports Network Inc. agents and representatives in Europe and the U.S.A.

1. Application

An application will be binding after the confirmation of acceptance of EuroSports Network (ESN). Upon confirmation of acceptance; all arrangements are under the proviso of availability.

ESN withholds the right to substitute at any moment the housing accommodation, and/or to alternate the program for circumstances, which are beyond control. The substitute housing accommodation, and/or the alternate program, should meet the same criteria as established in the confirmation of acceptance.

2. Tour payments

US\$ 500.00 deposit (non-refundable) per person upon Booking.

The remaining amount will be paid according to the schedule as mentioned on page I.10. ESN reserves the right to void the booking in case of serious delay of payment. In this case, ESN will refund the received payments minus the cancellation fees. (See 4)

3. Rate of exchange

The tour costs are based figuring the exchange rate of US \$ towards the Euro in August 2017. The tour costs may fluctuate based on changes in the exchange rate. Eventual surcharges must be paid together with the final payment.

4. Cancellation

All cancellations must be received in writing. The day that the notification is received by ESN is the effective cancellation date. The cancellation charges are US \$ 500.00 per person plus eventual additional costs incurred by ESN with respect to its obligations to its purveyors such as, but not limited to: airlines, bus companies, housing accommodations and sports clubs.

5. Passport

All participants must be able to present a valid passport. The fee for the passport is not included in the tour costs.

6. Exclusion from participation

ESN withholds the right to exclude any participant from further participation due to serious behavior. There will be no refund for the unused portion of the tour. Serious or unacceptable behavior includes, but is not limited to violation of regulations of the tour management, housing accommodations, and transportation companies. If any participant is found to be responsible for any damage while on the tour, he/she will be required to pay immediately for such damages.

ESN acts as an intermediary and will prepare the desired sports program with great care. Neither ESN nor the hosting sports club accepts any responsibility for the omission or partial omission of the sports program due to circumstances beyond control, such as, but not limited to, severe weather conditions.

- a) Any person or company retained for the benefit of the participant, including, but not limited to: housing accommodation, transportation companies, and tour guides.
- b) Acts of God; acts of public enemy, arrest or process; quarantine restrictions, riots or civil commotions; strikes; lockouts or labor stoppages; war hazards or dangers incident to the state of war; local rules or regulations of any airplane, automobile, motor coach, ship, train or other vehicles;
- d) Improper or insufficient passports or other documents;
- e) Participation in sport activities.

PASSPORTS

Everyone traveling in our group must have a valid passport from their country of citizenship. United States passport applications are available at U.S. post offices, clerical courts, local passport offices, and some DMV offices. Application for a new passport must be done in person. The following documents are necessary:

Obtaining a new passport is a seven-step process:

1. **Complete the passport application** form DS-11. Passport applications can be acquired at the DMV. (Note: Do not sign the application until the clerk instructs you to do so.)
2. **Present proof of U.S. Citizenship.** You may prove citizenship by presenting one of the following:
 - Previous U.S. passport
 - Naturalization certificate
 - Birth certificate
 - Certificate of citizenship

Present proof of identity. You may prove your identity with the following documents:

- Previous U.S. passport
- Naturalization certificate
- Driver's license
- Military identification

Please note: Your Social Security card does not prove your identity.

3. **Provide two passport photos.** It is highly advised that passport photos be taken by a professional agency. You can also try an online service to save time and money <http://www.epassportphoto.com/>
4. **Pay the applicable fee.** Total fees are \$97 for applicants 16 years of age or older and \$82 for applicants under 16 years of age.
5. Provide your Social Security number.
