

It is famous for its medieval bridge, which is a symbol of the town's past and one of its most recognizable landmarks. I.7 SUPERVISION

Passports

Everyone traveling in our group must have a valid passport from their country of citizenship. United States passport applications are available at U.S. post offices, clerical courts, local passport offices, and some D.M.V. offices. Application for a new passport must be made in person. The following documents are necessary:

Obtaining a new passport is a seven-step process:

- 1. **Complete the passport application** form DS-11. Passport applications can be acquired at the D.M.V. (Note: Do not sign the application until the clerk instructs you to do so.)
- 2. **Present proof of U.S. Citizenship**. You may prove citizenship by presenting one of the following:
 - ➤ Previous U.S. passport
 - > Naturalization certificate
 - > Birth certificate
 - Certificate of citizenship

Present proof of identity. You may verify your identity with the following documents:

- > Previous U.S. passport
- > Naturalization certificate
- Driver's license
- Military identification

Please note: Your Social Security card does not verify your identity.

- 3. **Provide two passport photos**. It is highly advised that passport photos be taken by a professional agency. You can also try an online service to save time and money http://www.epassportphoto.com/
- 4. **Pay the applicable fee**. Total fees are \$97 for applicants 16 years of age or older and \$82 for applicants under 16 years of age.
- 5. Provide your Social Security number.
