

For the previous 17 years, he was the Girls' Varsity Head Coach at Odyssey Academy in Greece, having Won Sectional Titles 8 times, in 2003, 2005, 2007, 2008, 2010, 2011, 2012 and 2014. His teams have made four trips to the State Finals, winning it all in 2012. His dedication to his player's overall development has been rewarded by his being selected as coach of the year in Monroe County Division III 6 times, Section V Class AA, CC once, CCC once and Class B 3 times, and Section V All-Greater Rochester Coach of the Year in 2005, 2012 and 2017. He was a four-year college starter and an All-American sweeper at Canisius College. After his college career ended he played four years of professional soccer both in Europe and the USA. Deciding it was time to settle down he began his teaching career as a physical education instructor in the Rochester City School District. He is married and has two children.

# **EuroSports Network Select Section V Soccer Tour to Barcelona, Spain**

### Day 1 – SUNDAY, March 31st 2024

Departure from Greece, NY to **JFK International Airport.** We will have a direct flight on American Airlines Flight # AA0066 departing at 6:45 PM.

## Day 2 - Monday, April 01st 2024

We will arrive at Barcelona's *El Prat Intl*. airport at 6:45 AM. You will be greeted by your bilingual tour manager. This morning we will transfer to the city center of Barcelona for a view of the city by bus. We will see the city of Barcelona at the top of Mountjuic. Next, take in views of the Mediterranean Sea and the Barcelona Coast on the way to the Olympic Village (Vila Olimpica), home to athletes during the 1992 Summer Olympics, and the Port Olympics. Then we will stop and see Casa Batlò on the way and La Pedrera which have been created by the famous Architect Gaudì.

After our tour, we will transfer to our 4\* Hotel Aquamarina in Santa Susanna on the Costa Brava. We will check in and have dinner.

## Day 3 – Tuesday, April 02<sup>nd</sup> 2024

Breakfast at the hotel and transfer to *Girona* for a **guided visit** to the ancient town in Catalonia. After lunch transfer to **Lloret de Mar to play your friendly game** #1 vs. local boys and girls club teams. At the end of the games return to the Hotel Aquamarina in Santa Susanna for dinner and overnight



## Day 4 – Wednesday, April 03<sup>rd</sup> 2024

Breakfast at the hotel and early departure at 7.45 to *Barcelona*. At 9.00 a.m. continue the discovery of Barcelona with the **visit of the Barrio Gotico**, We will walk along the Ramblas to the Boqueria and then to the medieval Barri Gothic, the original Gothic Quarter, where narrow streets and squares date back to the Middle Ages. Visit the 13<sup>th</sup>-century "La Seu" cathedral. Then we will **visit to the Sagrada Familia.** After our tour, we will transfer to a local sports center to play your **friendly game** #2 vs. local boys and girls club teams. We will have dinner at the club with the **local club teams**. After dinner, we will return to the Hotel Aquamarina in Santa Susanna.

## Day 5 - Thursday, April 04th 2024

Breakfast at the hotel and then we will travel to **Besalù** a wonderful medieval town in the comarca of Garrotxa in Catalonia. The town features arcaded streets and squares a 12<sup>th</sup>-century Romanesque bridge over the Fluvià River and also a restored mikveh, a ritual Jewish bath dating



from the eleventh or twelfth century, and the church of Sant Pere, which was consecrated in 1003. Guided visit of the town. In the afternoon return to Santa Susanna and stop on the way in **Banyoles** for a free visit to the enchanting city.

This evening we will have dinner at La Masia – Tordera and Flamenco Show. After dinner, we will return to the Hotel Aquamarina.



## *Day 6 – Friday, April 05th 2024*

Following breakfast, transfer to Barcelona.

In the morning enjoy a visit to Park Guell and time for last shopping in Barcelona. In the afternoon we will transfer to a local sports center to play your friendly game #3 vs. local boys and girls club teams. After the games return to Santa Susanna: for dinner and overnight at the hotel

## Day 7 - Saturday, April 06th 2024

This morning we will have Breakfast at the hotel and then travel to *Figueres* for a visit to the **Dali Museum**. After our visit, we will travel to the fishing village of Cadaques a magnificent remote fishing village situated in the **Cap de Creus peninsula on the famous Spanish Costa Brava**, recognized by the narrow cobblestone streets with their charming whitewashed houses overlooking incredible views of the Mediterranean Sea. Later in the afternoon, we will transfer to the **Isle of Medes** where we will have a boat tour around the island. After our tour return to the hotel Aquamarina in Santa Susanna for dinner.



## **Passports**

Everyone traveling in our group must have a valid passport from their country of citizenship. United States passport applications are available at U.S. post offices, clerical courts, local passport offices, and some D.M.V. offices. Application for a new passport must be made in person. The following documents are necessary:

## **Obtaining a new passport is a seven-step process:**

- 1. **Complete the passport application** form DS-11. Passport applications can be acquired at the D.M.V. (Note: Do not sign the application until the clerk instructs you to do so.)
- 2. **Present proof of U.S. Citizenship**. You may prove citizenship by presenting one of the following:
  - ➤ Previous U.S. passport
  - > Naturalization certificate
  - ➤ Birth certificate
  - Certificate of citizenship

**Present proof of identity**. You may verify your identity with the following documents:

- Previous U.S. passport
- > Naturalization certificate
- Driver's license
- ➤ Military identification

Please note: Your Social Security card does not verify your identity.

- 3. **Provide two passport photos**. It is highly advised that passport photos be taken by a professional agency. You can also try an online service to save time and money <a href="http://www.epassportphoto.com/">http://www.epassportphoto.com/</a>
- 4. **Pay the applicable fee**. Total fees are \$97 for applicants 16 years of age or older and \$82 for applicants under 16 years of age.
- 5. Provide your Social Security number.
