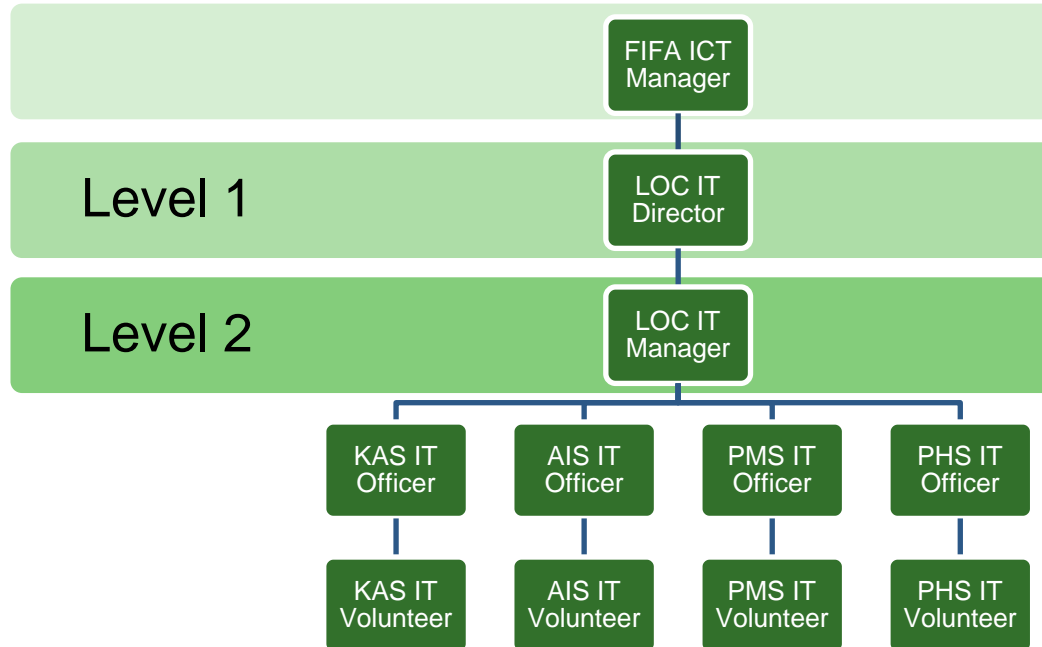

Official Draw Week / IT Services



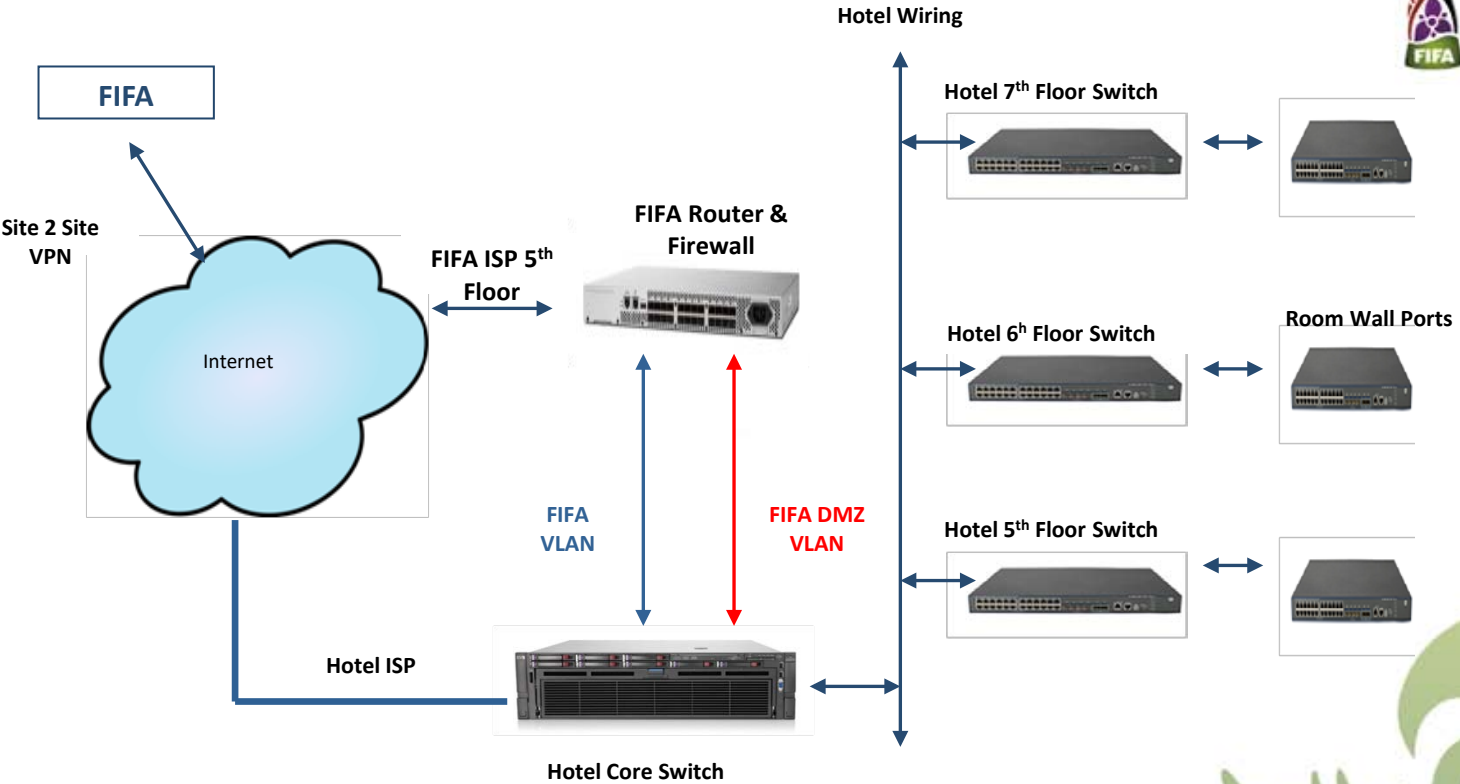
- **FIFA HQ / Amman Four Seasons**

Tournament Venues / IT Services

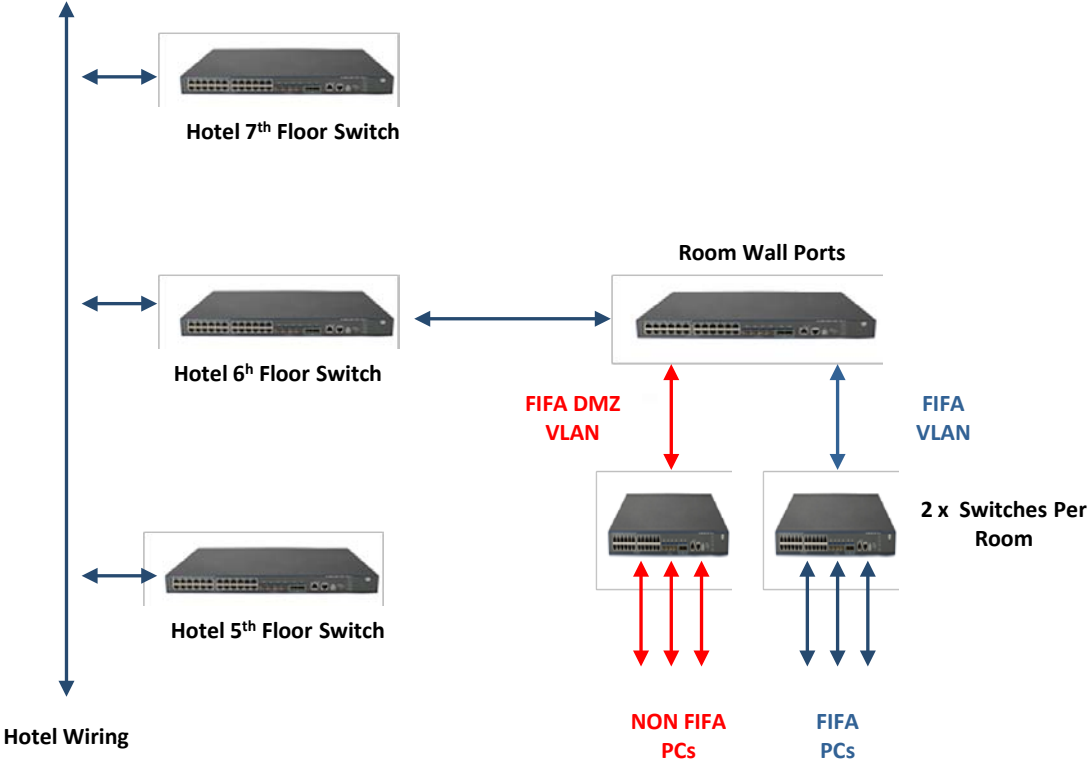


- **FIFA HQ / Amman Four Seasons**

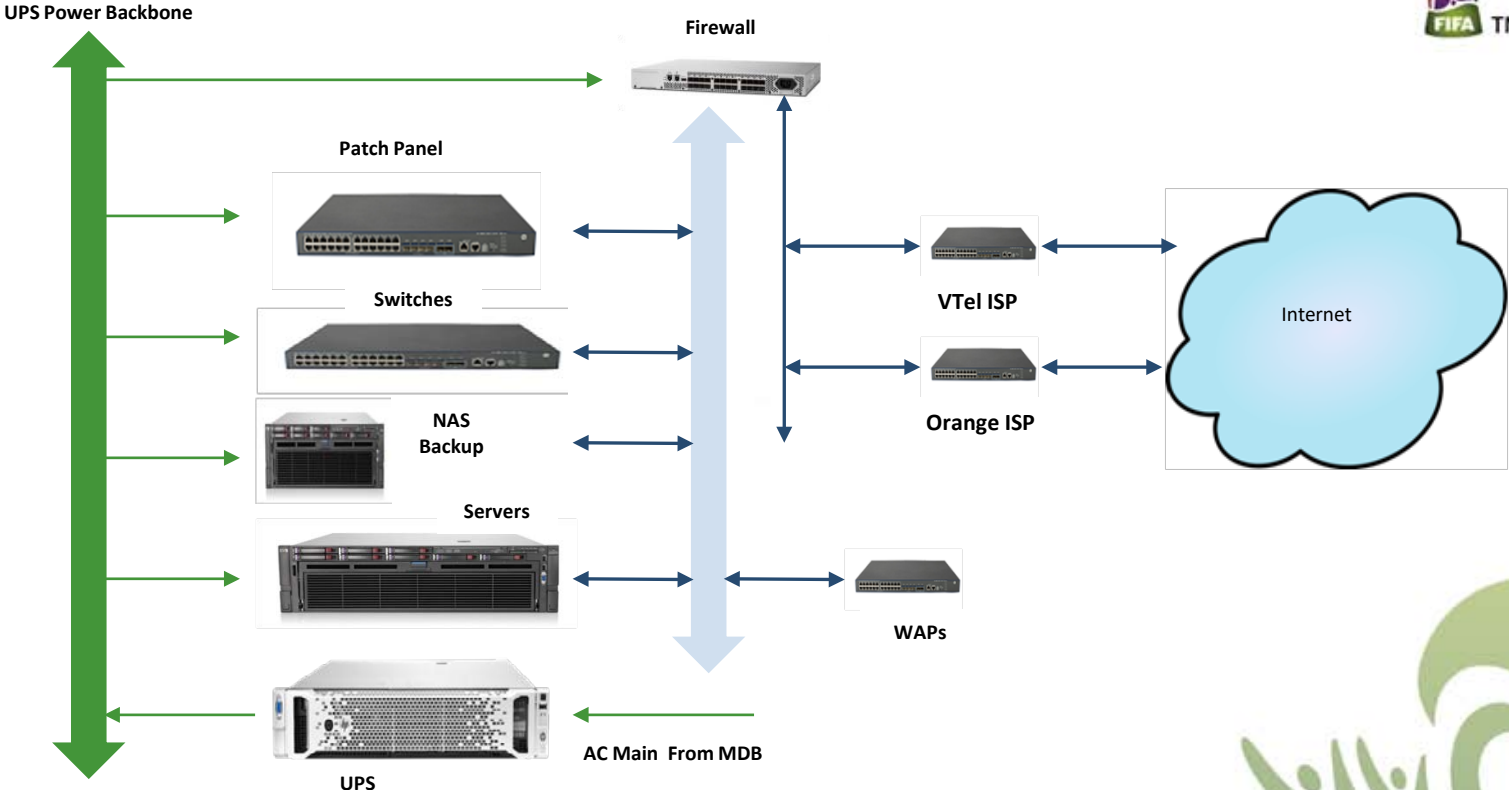

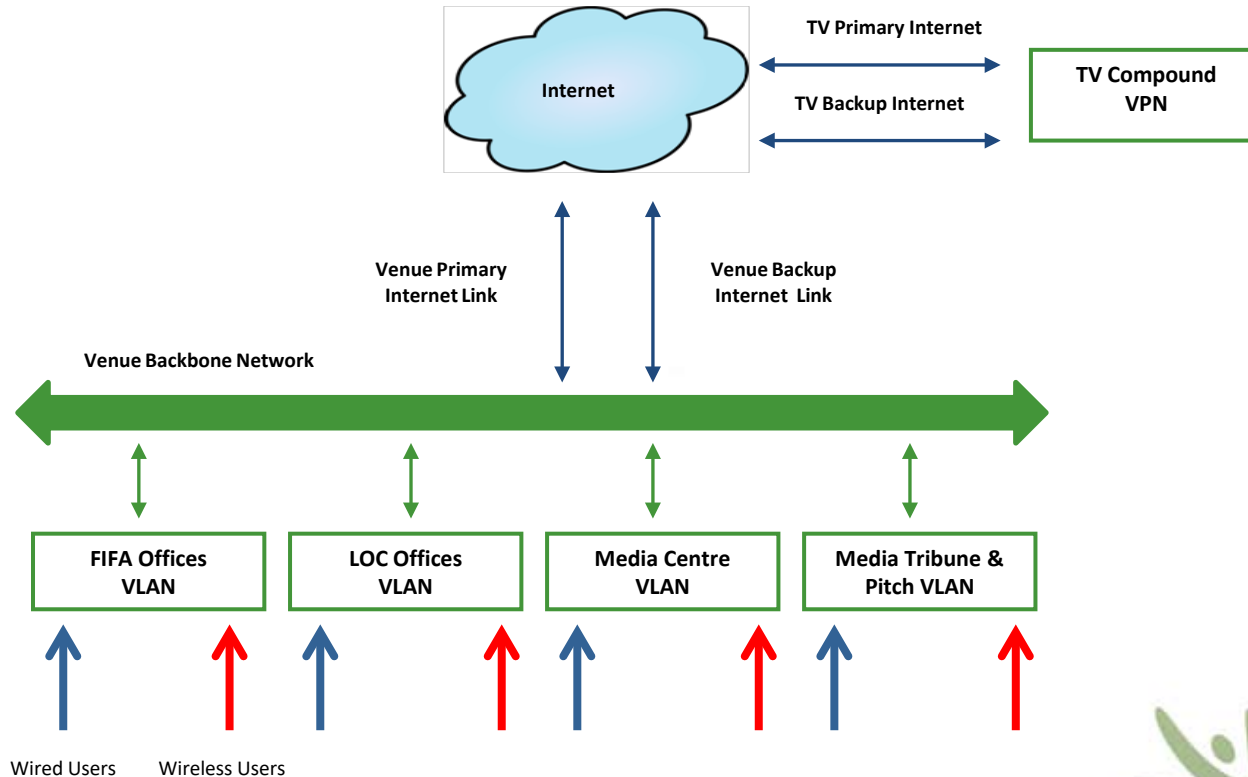

Venue IT Inspections



- **Up to Draw Week**

- One LOC IT inspection visit per venue per month

- One FIFA IT /LOC IT joint inspection for all venues May 2016

- Detailed report compiled by FIFA IT for follow up

- **Up to Opening Ceremony & Matches**

- One LOC IT visit per venue per month (Jun 2016 - Sept 2016)

- Continuously updated the report compiled by FIFA IT Manager

- Final FIFA IT / LOC IT joint inspection for all venues Sept 2016

- Ad Hoc FIFA IT / LOC IT joint visits to venues as needed Sept 2016

Three (3) Recommendations

Observations

Recommendation (1)

FIFA Event ICT Document



- **Update** FIFA Event ICT 2016 document currently in draft version
- **Upgrade** some of the specifications
- **Include** missing functions (Referees HQ, Doping Room, GC Office CATV)
- **Include** IT infrastructure requirements for TV , CATV systems
- **Cross Reference** with office charts from early stages
- **Clearly Identify** any specialist communications equipment likely to be used

Recommendation (2)

Wifi Usage



- Limit usage to one device per accredited media
- Minimize password leakage
- Change passwords on each match day
- Avoid using same password across venues
- Implement a Login portal to manage usage at each venue

Recommendation (3)

Cross-Cutting IT Services



- **Implement** Data Centre concept for redundancy & availability
- **Include** venue power requirements within IT
- **Include** TV compound power requirements within IT
- **Reduce** Last minute IT requirements

Observations For Future Events



- **Consider** Venue Management concept in order to:
 - Centralize** IT delivery and follow up per venue
 - Reduce** technical workload on non technical departments
- **Involve** your LOC IT from very early stages of planning
