



- **64** Oh that thou wouldest rend the heavens, that thou wouldest come down, that the mountains might flow down at thy presence,

- ⁹ Be not wroth very sore, O LORD, neither remember iniquity for ever: behold, see, we beseech thee, we are all thy people.
