CPC PW'S ANNUAL SCHOOL KIT CAMPAIGN 2026:

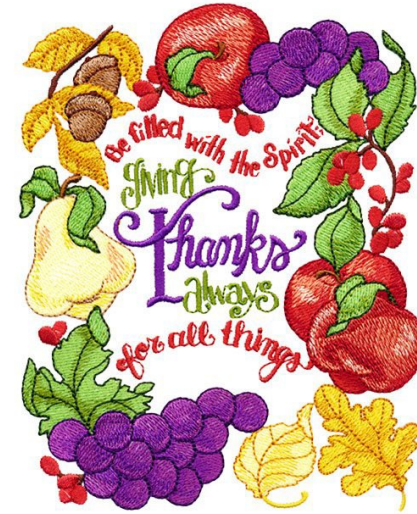
