HUD Point-in-Time Count for Lubbock County
Conducted on January 28, 2021

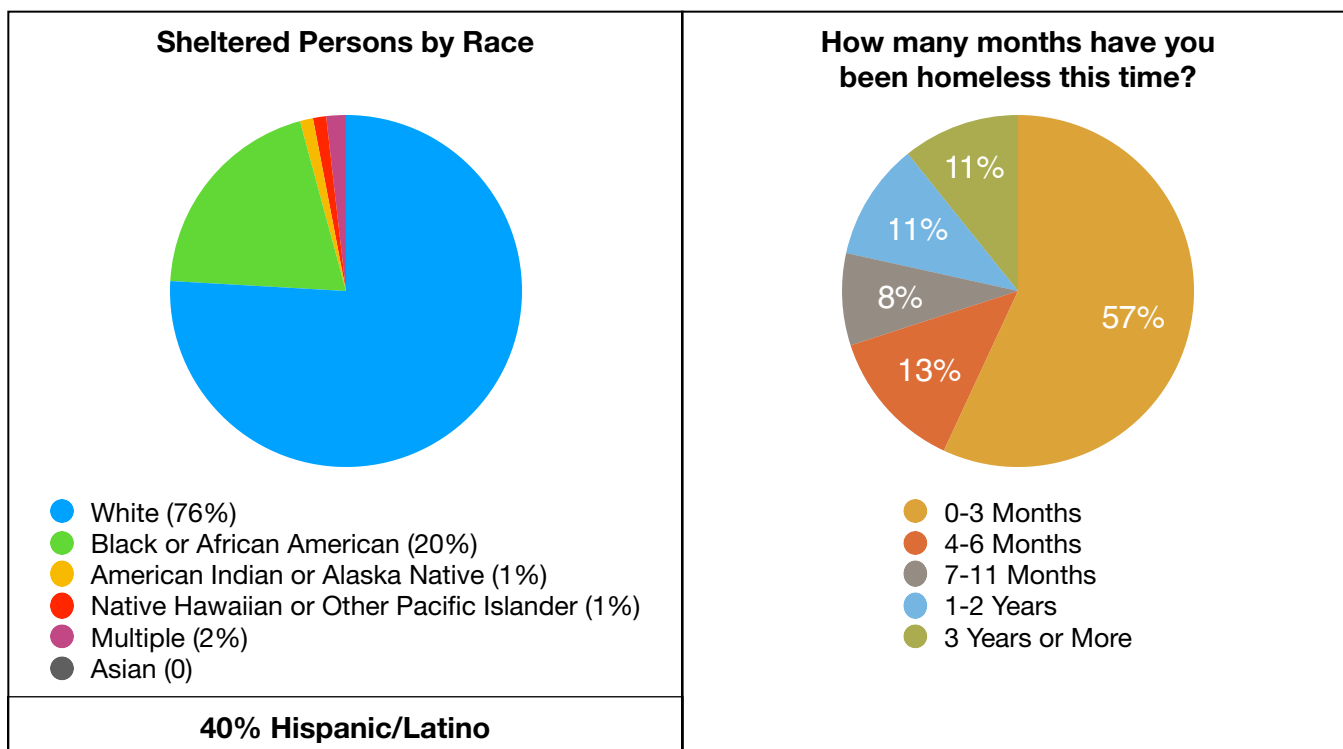
The Point-in-Time (PIT) count is an annual count of people in sheltered and unsheltered locations on a single night in January. In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the 2021 PIT conducted an **observation count for all people in unsheltered locations, while people in sheltered locations were counted as in normal years**. An observation count is a head count that reports limited information on the person being counted. While information regarding sheltered populations should be comparable to previous years, combined (sheltered + unsheltered) and unsheltered information should be used with caution and in conjunction with more comprehensive data sets such as previous year's PIT data, HMIS homelessness outreach data, etc.
