Lesson One

The Gospel In The Stars... begins with a girl

Long, long ago, before books and writing and scrolls—Yahweh wrote a story in the sky. He used stars like words, and He called it the Mazzaroth. It’s the very first Bible—made of light! And do you know where that story begins?

With a girl.

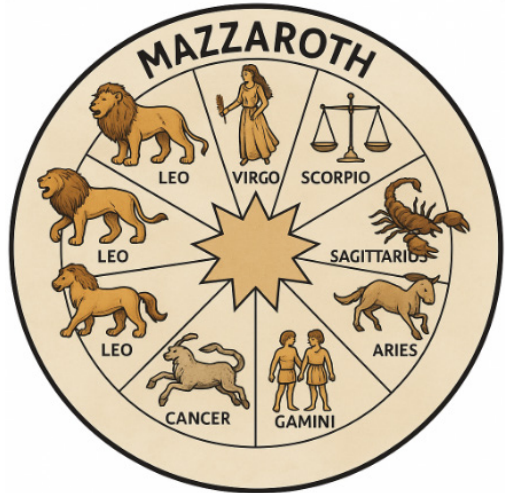
HER NAME IS VIRGO. That word means “virgin” or “young maiden.” In the stars, Virgo is holding a seed in her hand. A seed is tiny, but it’s full of promise. One day, that seed would grow into a Savior.

Yahweh made a promise: A woman would give birth to someone special. Someone who would crush evil and bring us back to Yahweh’s family (Genesis 3:15). This is where the whole Gospel begins. Not in a manger—but in the stars!



Let's take a peek at the Mazzaroth wheel. Do you see the girl (Virgo) at the beginning?

That's where the Bible story begins. Now look at the end of the circle. Who is there? A lion! That's Leo. The Bible ends with a Lion-King. So from the Virgin to the Lion, Yahweh tells His whole plan. It's written in the sky!



What did Virgo tell the ancient people?

Before Yahweh gave us paper Bibles, everyone could look up and see His plan. Even the wise men followed the stars to find the baby Yahshua (Jesus).

Virgo tells us: The Savior would be born of a young woman.



A "seed" would come from her that would save the world.

Yahweh always keeps His promises.

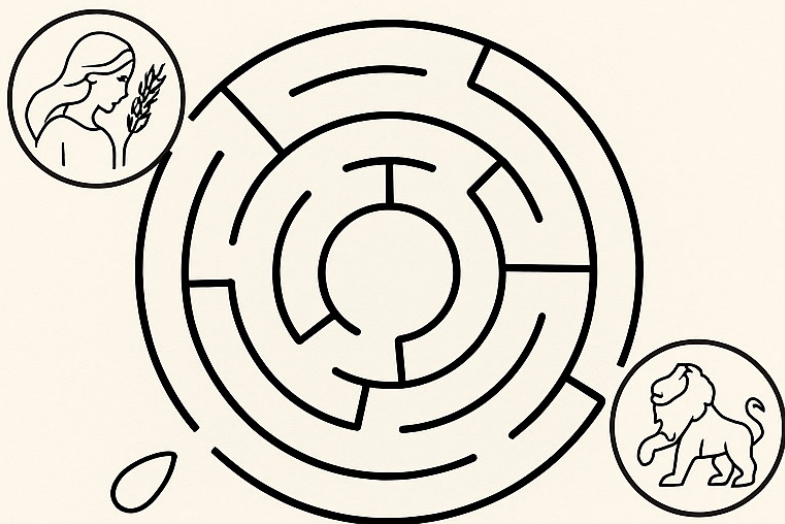
Everyone hold an imaginary seed and say: "I believe in the promise!"
