

JOY COMES IN THE MORNING

This has been a journey into the mind of the Creator. That's what we're doing. We're on a journey into the mind of our Creator.

Well, what I'd like to show you is how the church presents the gospel. How many of you have ever heard of Dante's Inferno? Anybody? Ok. Dante's Inferno is a creation of the Catholic Church. It was created to keep me and you in line. It was created to make you and I pay our tithe, to make us show up to church and catechisms. It was to make us show up and be good boys and girls.

The reason they had to create Dante's Inferno is because we didn't have a true understanding of why we should live holy. So therefore, if we don't know why, we just do it out of fear. I want to tell you—if it takes fear for you to serve Yahweh, you will never serve Yahweh ever. You may go to church, you may go through the ritual.

Let me show you the images that are displayed to the children in the Christian church. This is the first image that is shown in Christianity of what your life is going to be like in the inferno of hell. That's one image. Here are the angels on your left, and here's people begging those angels to get them out of this inferno.





The next image is the seven layers of hell. This is taught through all of Christianity that those who were pretty good in life, they'll go to the top layer. Those that were worse than them will go to the second layer. And by the way, if you don't believe any of this, just go to Wikipedia and type in Dante's Inferno. It will make you sick to your stomach that this is what the Christian church historically has believed.

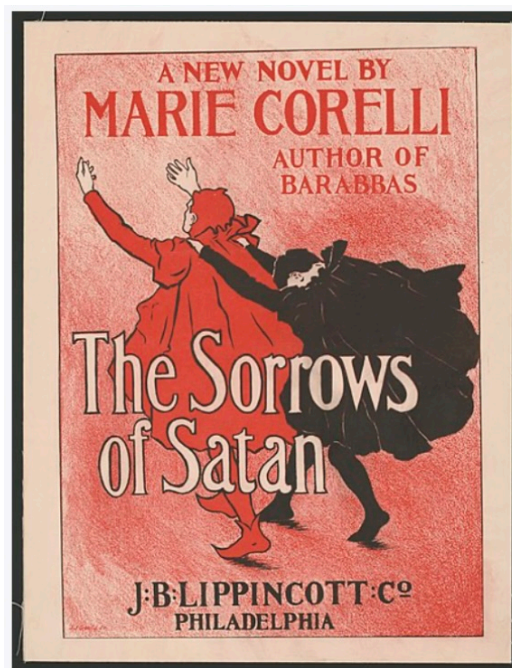
This is another image of Dante's Inferno. Make sure you show it to your children so they will always love God. That's what it takes to get you to love God are these images.

Now before you say... *oh my church never showed me those images*. Yes they did. I'm going to prove it in just a moment.





There's another image of Dante's Inferno. Do you see the seven layers of hell? Those of you who were not too bad, you go to the first layer. But look at those people underneath that first layer how they're screaming in tortuous pain. This is the God that you're supposed to love so much. This is what he's planned for his creation. I want you to look at it. I don't want you to look away. I want you to stare at these images.



Now, before I go to the next screen, I want you to see the images. *Brother Vaughn, no one's ever showed me these pictures.* Yes they have whether they painted this picture in their sermons with words or they showed it to you on the halls of their Catholic Churches. This is the God that you are supposed to think is so wonderful. This is what he has planned for all of his creation except for a few thousand.

So my question today is this: Who is the real torturer? You know, we immediately disparage Satan for what he has done to mankind. We say that Satan has destroyed our children with drugs. We say that Satan has destroyed their lives. He has ravaged men. And we talk about how bad Satan is for what he has done to mankind.

And yet, if eternal torment is true, then Jesus Christ will torture forever the whole human race. In one hour, in a hot searing hell, our Lord will inflict more pain and agony on each person than Satan ever inflicted on that person in their life time.

My question to you today is what kind of God do you serve? You may be serving a sadomasochist. Ladies and gentlemen, no wonder your children hate your God. No wonder the world thinks we're a bunch of psychopaths. This is what we offer. Either you get tortured by Satan or you get tortured by God. Take your pick. Joy comes in the morning—really? Amen? Ladies and gentlemen, we have bought in to lies. I want to continue now with this lesson.

If this torture lasts throughout eternity, then each unsaved person will suffer more than all the suffering of all the people that has ever lived on planet earth. Who is the real torturer? This God of love you claim to serve? Who's the real torturer?

Let's look at something else. Satan himself, Pharaoh, Nero, and Hitler were among the most horrible people on planet earth. When we talk about those people, we think of them as vile and evil. Talk about Hitler, what do we think? Evil. And yet Hitler did not torture people. He killed them. Hitler did not torture the Jews, he put them in a gas chamber and did what? He ended their suffering. Now he caused their suffering, but he also ended their suffering.

The God you serve will never end their suffering. That would make him worse than all of them put together. That would make your God worse than Pharaoh. That makes him worse than Stalin. And yet you want to convince the world what a great God you serve.

The doctrine of eternal torture makes Jesus, Yahshua, a million times more vicious and vindictive than all three of these put together. You see, these brutal

murderers killed their victims. Death brought sweet relief in a moment of time. That's why, brothers and sisters, I render to you the truth. And I'm going to bring it right from your Bible.

Romans 6:23

For the wages of sin is death.

The wages of sin is what? Death. The church says the wages of sin is torture. The Bible says that the wages of sin is what? Death. Who came up with this eternal torture doctrine? Try to find it for me in the Torah. Sister, find for me where in the Torah is this? It's got to be a pattern.

Yahweh is a God of rhythm and rhyme and patterns. Brothers and sisters, you've got to go back to Torah. If you can't find a doctrine in the Torah, you've got a problem. Now I'll tell you what you will find in the Torah sister. You will find judgment. You will find discipline. And you will find stoning to death. But you will not find torture, especially eternal torture.

Everyone of you, including me, believes it. This is how deceived the church has been. We are living under the voice of Elijah. Yahweh is saying...hey, stop, wait a minute. Tell the people who I am and don't lie about me. We have made God the people's enemy. Joy comes in the morning saints. And that joy is coming. I promise you that joy is coming in the morning. I have no doubt about it. Praise Yahweh. Let's continue. I want to show you what the church says starting from this slide here.

The CHURCH must do better – we must teach of the JOY that COMES IN THE MORNING.



- This pagan and Romish doctrine of eternal torture does NOT glorify YAHWEH or YAHSHUA!

One of the theologians of the Church of England (Jeremy Taylor) speaks of the fate of the wicked in the following terms: "In hell every sense and organ shall be assailed forever with its own appropriate and most exquisite sufferings. We are amazed at the inhumanity of Phalaris who roasted men in his brazen bull, but THAT WAS A JOY IN COMPARISON 28 WITH HELL."

This picture on the left of the previous page, is pagan and Roman doctrine of eternal torture. And it doesn't glorify Yahweh or Yahshua. I want to bring you back to the early days of the Catholic Church, and the Church of England. Here's one of their theologians by the name of Jeremy Taylor. He speaks of the fate of the wicked in the following terms:

"In hell every sense and organ will be assailed forever with it's own appropriate and most exquisite suffering. We are amazed at the inhumanity of Phalaris who roasted men in a brazen bull, but that was joy in comparison with hell."

That's the sermons of the early church. That was to make you good girls and boys. The church preaches nothing about that wonderful joy that's coming in the morning. They're too busy preaching about hell. But the best is yet to come. That's our message here at First Harvest Ministries.

Now I want to clear something up from the very beginning. *Pastor Vaughn, are you saying that you don't believe in hell?* I never said that. Ok? You better listen to me close today! Don't leave this lesson saying what I didn't say. I believe in hell, but I believe in the Bible version of hell according Matthew 25:41. I'm going to go through this over the next several weeks. I'm going to teach hell to you in such a way that no one can make you doubt what hell is and what it's not.

Matthew 25:41

Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels.

Now this is a scripture that confuses a lot of people. I'm going to teach you today what that everlasting fire is. But what I want you to notice is the last line. Who was this fire of hell prepared for? The devil and his angels. Do you know why? Because they do not get the mercy of death. They cannot die. The angels are created as what? Eternal creatures.

So, therefore, we're to believe that Yahweh prepared the Lake of Fire to torment Satan and his angels. That was it. That's what he created it for. Why was it not created for man? Think about it folks. Use your reasoning. Use a little common sense. Why was it not prepared for man? Because how long can you burn up a man?

(elder): Pastor, I just saw something in that verse. "Then shall he say unto them on the left hand, depart from me you cursed into everlasting fire..." The left hand is the enemy of God. That's Satan and his angels, but he has a plan for all men to be at his right hand (where there are pleasures forevermore it says).

That's right. Absolutely. And those on his left hand will come under judgment and they will go through the fire, but this is not a literal fire. I'll explain that in next week's lesson. I'll get into the meaning of these "fires" and show you that it's the "judgment fire" of Yahweh.

Brothers and sisters, I want you to think of something. Yahweh forbid his people to pass their children through the fire to the god Moloch. Does anybody remember that? Yahweh said such a thought has never entered my mind to pass my children through the fire. And yet we've got hell is prepared for the devil and his angels.

Again, ladies and gentlemen, let's say right now that I could take brother so-and-so and throw him in a pit of fire. How long would it take before he existed no more? May take 3 or 4 minutes. The point I'm making is this...how long can you torment? You see, this is why...

The doctrine of the immortal soul must get out of your mind!

Do you know why I tell people the most important lesson I teach is What Happens to the Dead? That is the most important teaching I'll ever teach you. You can find it here: firstharvest.tv/video/1170.

Why? Not because you need to know what happens to the dead. You need to know what *doesn't* happen to the dead. Believing in the immortal soul. What does that doctrine say? Your soul is going to live forever somewhere. That's a lie from the pits of hell. If you believe in that, then you can believe in eternal hell. Because you see how I just said that brother so-and-so would burn up in 3 minutes, well they'd come back and say...*yeah but not his soul*. Do you follow me?

Until you realize that you do not have a soul, I can't help set you free. If you're in this class today you need to watch my teachings on what happens to the dead. That is a foundational lesson. Because if you know that you do not have a soul, and somebody comes back and says...*Sister did you ever hear it taught that your soul's gotta live forever somewhere?* It can't. A soul is a living breathing body, and the minute the body is no longer breathing, it's no longer a soul. It's a body.

Now, you've got to know this because when you get to the subject of hell, if you're Catholic and you believe in the immortal soul doctrine, then you can bypass everything I'm teaching and say...*oh no, but your soul...* Well let me ask you a question. How would fire even torment a soul? I mean, come on folks. Do you remember when I started off this lesson with reasoning? I told you in the first lesson that you're going to have to learn that it's ok to use your brain and your Bible. This is where I'm at now with the brain part. You've got to stop a minute

and say wait—I'm not eternal. Now I know the church says you are. The church says that you are a spiritual being trapped in a physical body. Has anybody ever heard that? That's New Age. That's against the Torah. That's against the scripture. To believe that is to be a New Age practitioner. You are not a spiritual soul trapped in a body. You might as well believe in reincarnation if you believe that. Alright, I've got so far to go, so much to teach today. I don't want to get bogged down.

Now, let's go to another famous preacher that you've all heard of by the name of Spurgeon. Let's go into one of brother Spurgeon's services and listen to him preach. Here is what Charles H. Spurgeon says on the subject of hell.

“There is real fire in hell. The body shall be suffused with agony. Your head will be tormented with racking pain, your eyes coming out of your sockets, your ears with horrid sounds, your pulse will be rattling with anguish, your limbs will be crackling in the flame. Every vein will be a pathway for the fire to tread. Every nerve will be a string on which the devil shall forever play the diabolical tune of hell's unutterable laments.”

Give me a break! The most famous preacher that ever lived—Spurgeon. Hey you all, don't make fun of Spurgeon—I heard that sermon every Sunday night. What a great, great preacher he was. I love Spurgeon very much, but I don't love lies. A little leaven leavens the whole lump. Come on sister! You all, that sermon he preached...the title was “Sinners in the Hands of an Angry God”. Sounds like be afraid, be very afraid! You'll live in fear and Yahweh says to not live in fear.

Charles Spurgeon was the greatest preacher in history as far as a prince of preachers. Do you know how many people tell me...*pastor Vaughn, you need to preach hell hot*. Well, I prefer to preach there's a day coming where JOY is coming to this planet. Hallelujah! Oh hallelujah. I'm not serving Yahweh for fear of hell. I'm serving him looking forward to JOY coming in the morning! Hallelujah! Amen.

The church says that when you die you go to hell—you go straight to hell or straight to heaven. That's not Bible. They perish! The Bible said...without the hope of the resurrection, they have perished. They don't exist somewhere else—they have perished! But of course, if boy doesn't mean boy anymore, maybe perish doesn't mean perish anymore. But in the world I grew up in, perish means *perish*! You're done without the resurrection.

Now the second resurrection they will all come up to face a 100-year judgment. I'm going to be teaching in two weeks on that 100-year judgment. I can't get to it

today. This series is going to take me God knows how long because I have so much to explain to you about this beautiful joy that's coming in the morning.

Now it's sad to me how the church would rather hear "hell hot" than joy comes in the morning. It's something messed up in our minds. There's something messed up in our minds that that's the message we want to hear. I need to move along quickly.

Some will ask me...do I believe in hell? I most certainly believe in hell. But the hell of the Bible verses the hell of human tradition are not the same at all. The hell of tradition is hopeless and eternal, while the hell of the scripture, like every judgment of God, is corrective, remedial and restorative.

Remember this: To get your doctrine right, it must line up with Torah. It must line up with the character of Yahweh. The only way the doctrine of hell stands the test is if Yahweh's mercies are no longer new every morning. Sister, if hell is this hot and this eternal, that must mean one day his mercy will not be new every morning. Now the church I grew up in did teach that, but one day you would cross the mercy line. Has anybody ever heard that one? You'd cross the mercy line—there'd be no more mercy. Well then, there's no more God because the God I serve—his mercy is new everyday! How many of you should be dead today? Unless he runs out of mercy, then the doctrine of eternal torture is a slap in his face—don't ever preach it again!

Now, we do preach judgment and I'm coming to that probably next week. I may get to some of it today. There will be a judgment and it will not be anything nice. Have you ever heard of the rod of iron? Oh it's coming. Don't think that this world's getting off scot-free. I'm asking you...did you get off scot-free? No. Neither will they. They are right now because we're living in what? This evil present age. They will come under the rod, oh yes they will, just like you did. And it will feel like hell. But it's only to restore creation. It's only to bring them into correction so that the Father can restore all things. This is the message that First Harvest Ministries preaches—we serve a God who has a plan, and that plan will never fail.

Here's my question I want to ask you sister. If Yahweh could save the vast majority of his creation would he? Yes he would. Ok, maybe he can't though. Maybe he doesn't have the power to do that. Maybe he's so bound by our free will that he doesn't have the power to do that. You see, that's the God Satan loves for you to worship, that weak God. That powerless God. That God who is too weak to keep his word.

Why do you think Yahweh blesses this ministry so much? We're telling the truth about him. Did you hear me? Why do you think we're sitting there with 30 acres of land that we don't even know how we paid for, preparing a place for his people to come and live and gather? Because we are restoring his truth to this earth little by little, here a little, there a little. And he is blessing it because we have magnified not only the name Yah, but we have magnified the very character of Yah, and restoring it in this our day.

So the question is: If he could save the vast majority, would he? Every one of you right now needs to answer that question in your mind. The belief that God cannot do some things, or that God is limited in his ability, is fairly common among Christians. Many think that God's ability to act is limited by man's "free will". People often think that God either cannot override man's will or that he is incapable of making man change his will to conform to the will of God. That is the Christian God.

But my question is: Would he be God at all if he was that limited? Ok? I'm going to make you think today. The Christian church has convinced you that your God never overrides man's free will. This is a major doctrine, major, that God would never force a man to do anything. Oh you poor, pitiful, mislead believer. What a weak God if he's depending on your choices. (That would make us God.) Isn't that amazing? Where did this doctrine come from? Satan himself to limit your God's ability to take your stupid choices that you made and undo them all in one moment with a little bit of mercy. Christianity serves that God, not Israelites. Israelites serve the God that can harden Pharaoh's heart and un-harden it when he gets ready to.

Pastor, Proverbs 16:9 says Yahweh directs a man's steps. Oh no, no. Man's choices directs his steps. That's what the church says. But what does the Bible say? Folks, do you really believe it was me? Do you really believe that it wasn't Yahweh that allowed me to spend three years in a prison cell when I shouldn't have spent one night in there? Yahweh had to set me free from a bad situation to prepare me for this ministry. Look, anyone else would've got by with what I did. Hallelujah! Oh but it was Yahweh that said...go arrest him right now, go get him now because I need to sit his little hot tail down for three years so that I can give him this message. Yahweh directs our steps! But the God of the Christian church is limited by people's choices. Brothers and sisters, aren't you glad that isn't true?

God would not be God at all if he were so helpless in the face of billions of people, each restricting God in his own way by his free will. Is God a mere bystander in human history? Is God merely a good counselor to men? Does God wish that men would follow him, but can do little or nothing about it? Is this how you define the

meaning of “God” “Yahweh” ? Before you shake your head no, before today, you may have. No wonder your God is so weak.

Yahweh is sovereign!! Put that in your notes. Write it in your mind. The Bible gives us many examples to show that God is anything but helpless. He constantly takes the credit for overthrowing entire nations, for redeeming Israel from Egypt. If you want to know about the sovereignty of God, read Isaiah 45 over and over again. Do you know what God said to a pagan king like King Cyrus? God took a pagan king and used him to do exactly what God told him to do. Just like he did with Donald Trump.

I want to give you a scripture. Once you come to believe in the sovereignty of God, once you have no doubt of his sovereignty, your faith level will go through the roof. Let's read Romans 9:17. Let's talk about one of the most evil men that ever lived. Worse than Hitler. His name was Pharaoh. Let's find out what Yahweh says about Pharaoh.

Romans 9:17

For the scripture saith unto Pharaoh, Even for this same purpose have I raised thee up, that I might shew my power in thee, and that my name might be declared throughout all the earth.

You've got to be kidding me? What did he just say about the most evil man that destroyed Yahweh's people? He said...I raised you up, I'm the one who made you do those horrible things. Uh oh! Houston we have a problem because that is not the God Creflo Dollar preaches. The God that the Christian church preaches—what do they tell you? All good things come from the Lord, and all bad things come from the devil.

Pharaoh was a bad thing that came from God. This is why you can never get bitter at your enemies. Many times they are the ministers of God! Your greatest enemies are normally tools in the hands of God to test you to whether you believe in sovereignty or not. Ladies and gentlemen, the Father uses your enemies to set you up. That's why the Bible says...render to Caesar what belongs to Caesar because as you learn obedience to earthly government, to church government, you are learning obedience to heavenly government.

And you must learn as a wife—when you learn obedience to your husband, you are learning obedience to your Father in heaven. There is not one woman watching me now that is even allowed to pray to Yahweh while in rebellion to your husband. Did you know that he doesn't hear your prayer? Do you want me to look the scripture up? The Bible says when a husband and wife are arguing it hinders your prayer. Did you know the Bible said that? Do you know why? You're

in rebellion to your authority. You're not allowed to pray until you get it right with your husband and your wife. Do I need to bring these scriptures to you? I'll do it.

Do you know that the Bible says if a woman makes a vow to God and her husband disagrees with the vow, he can cancel it? Did you all know the Torah said that? Why? God hates rebellion on every level. Because it's a test for you. He cannot use you in the coming kingdom with that. *Brother Vaughn, I don't have a husband.* Then get a pastor. Get some male authority. Yes I said a male authority you bunch of lesbian spirits. Get male authority. Whew-wee, boy do they hate it. Let me tell you something—I fight that demon everyday. There is a maceration of men in God's church. There is literally a maceration of male authority in the home, in the church,

God is calling us all to notice that those we think are against us many times are what's making us better! The Father is calling us all. When we have something in our life that is pricking us, it's really checking us. That's what it's doing—it's checking us. Don't fight back in rebellion! Obey Yah.

I want to read you all two verses. Let's go to 1 Kings 12:4, 15. I want to compare these two verses. Now this is when the house of Judah and the house of Israel had their famous split. It looked like such a horrible thing. How many of you remember when they went to Rehoboam and asked him to lower their taxes? And Rehoboam came back and said something that really makes no sense. He was very cruel to them. Let's read about it.

1 Kings 12:4, 15

4 Your father made our yoke heavy; but now, lighten the burdensome service and the heavy yoke he placed on us, and we will serve you.

If you'll lower our taxes just a little, we will serve you King Rehoboam. We will serve you and we will all be happy. Well you know brother if that was me, and my whole kingdom would settle down with a little tax break, I would probably give them that tax break wouldn't you? To save my kingdom.

But if you read verse 11, he comes back and says hey, my little finger is thicker than my father's loin, wherefore my father loaded you with a heavy yoke, I'm going to raise your taxes. I'm going to make it harder on you. Now that's not real smart, you're about to lose your whole kingdom over a dollar?

Well we look at that and it makes no sense. But when we go to 1 Kings 12:15, it will all make sense.

15 So the king did not listen to the people, because this turn of affairs was from Yahweh so He might perform the word which Yahweh had spoken through Ahijah the Shilonite to Yeroboam son of Nebat.

It was a what? It was a turn of events from? Was it from King Rehoboam? It was the Father Yahweh that made him raise those taxes! Why? Because there was a prophecy years earlier about the kingdom being rent into was there not? And somebody had to make it happen.

So imagine that day when all these people went home crying and praying to Yahweh...why did the king raise our taxes, we need you to come through for us, we thought you loved us, we thought you cared about us, oohhh.

Mature believers don't pray like that. Mature believers say...blessed be the name of Yahweh, our taxes have been raised for a purpose, we know you'll give us the means to pay them, we thank you that you're sovereign, anything that we're going through, we give thanks in all things for this is the will of God concerning me, whatever state I find myself in is because you allowed me to be in it! (I'm preaching to somebody right now.) Whatever state I'm in, you allowed it! To Yah be the glory!

You all, that king didn't raise their taxes. They're mad at the king when they should be thanking Yahweh that he raised their taxes. Amen. I'm trying to teach you valuable lessons today. The Bible said it was a turn of events from Yahweh. You know, the God who doesn't get involved with politics.

It wasn't Satan that went against Job. It was Yahweh who *sent* Satan against Job. Exactly. Why do you think this ministry has never been focused on the devil? We don't cast him out. We don't go around looking for him. We don't let you fall in the floor while he makes a show in front of the whole church, coming out of you, spitting in your buckets. WE DON'T DO IT!

Why? He's nothing to us! We serve a God that gets all the glory! We don't spend one minute giving the devil glory around here. Take that to your tent under the preacher that wants to cast him out of you. If you want the devil out of you, listen to my preaching and he cannot stay around. I promise you that. You won't have to keep going from chair to chair to get deliverance—you'll walk in deliverance everyday of your life under this message. Why? We give Yahweh the glory.

What is restricting Yahweh from performing his will? Let's find out. I want you to think about it today. What is stopping God from saving mankind? Is he really under a self-imposed restriction that limits his ability to save all men? If so, by what law? Now that's a question you have to ask.

What law makes it imperative for God to allow his children to use their free will to destroy themselves? Do we follow that practice with our own children? Must I stand in the driveway and merely tell my child not to go into the street when I see a car coming? What stops me sister when my child's on a tricycle and going into the road and I'm saying...*now you make sure you make the right choice baby.* And there's a car coming and I'm standing there watching it...*oh now honey, you're fixing to run into that car, make the right choice.* Nothing is stopping you!! Come on now! Ha ha!

But according to Christianity, there's this so-called law that stops him from saving all his children. I can't find that law in the Torah. I can't find it anywhere. I only find it in Christianity. I don't know about you, but I'm going to teach my child to make the right choice, right? But if I'm standing there, he's making the wrong one, I'm getting ready to jump out in front of that car myself and save my creation—those children are my creation.

Where did we come up with this God that cannot save us? My Bible said his hand is not short that he cannot save. His ear is not heavy that he cannot hear. So what is it that is restricting us or restricting God? Let's go to Numbers 14:21. I want to prove to you today that Yahweh is the winner! 2 Peter 3:9, and 1 Peter 2:4. Let's roll.

Numbers 14:21

But as truly as I live, all the earth shall be filled with the glory of Yahweh.

Oh hallelujah. Oh! ALL the earth. Hallelujah. My friend, as surely as I live all the earth will be filled with my glory. Joy will come in the morning. All the earth! Everything will be filled!

2 Peter 3:9

Yahweh is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering (patient) toward us, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.

Oh if he could only make that happen sister. If he only had the power to get what he wanted. My God. Read that again because that just ministered to me. Hallelujah. I'm so sorry God that even your prayer can't be answered. I'm sorry Yah. It's his prayer for ALL men to be saved. If only he could figure out a way to make that happen. Is anybody picking up what I'm saying?

Yes pastor, we are that light on the hill. The first harvest. And I'm getting ready to jump over into that lesson today where I'm going to show you how it's going to

happen. *Uh, brother Vaughn, it didn't say it was going to happen...it said that he would like for that to happen.*

Wait a minute, are we talking about the same Yahweh that gets what he wants? Maybe you're talking about a different God. The God I serve? If he desires for all men to be saved? With Yahweh, all things are possible. The only thing that's impossible is for him to break man's will and get them all saved—now he can't do that now!

1 Peter 2:4

Coming to Him as to a living stone, indeed rejected by men, but chosen by Yahweh, and precious.

Yahshua was chosen by Yahweh to be a living stone, to bring all the other stones into it. *Brother Vaughn, that would be great if that could happen. But there are evil men stopping God's will and Yahweh's powerless to do anything about it.* How powerful is God? Let's start at the beginning.

The Creator owns all things! The first verse in the Bible establishes that Yahweh is the Creator of all things. "In the beginning Yahweh created heaven and earth." Most people in the world believe this, but few people understand what it implies. It means that Yahweh owns everything by the right of creation. Listen! You own what you create. One owns what one creates. If I write a song today...guess what? I own the rights to that song. Christianity is the only religion in the world that believes in a God that created man but has no right to man. He "wrote a song" that he has no right to change the verses.

Let's read the Torah. Leviticus 25:23. This is paramount that you understand.

THE LAND SHALL NOT BE SOLD FOREVER !!!

Lev 25:23



- God holds the right of eminent domain.
- He had divided the land of Canaan among the tribes and families of Israel as their inheritance. However, they did not have the right to do as they pleased with their land. God retained sovereignty over the land.

The land that you're looking at—who owns that land? Yahweh. Sister, what are you created out of? *My cellular flesh from my Lord. He wonderfully made me.* And what did he use to create your forefather Adam? *The same, with clay.* With his hands, what did he do? He took the land that he owned and created man out of land. Now we're getting somewhere—you all better hang tight now—we're going to Torah, ok? Let's see what the Torah says.

Leviticus 25:23

The land shall not be sold for ever: for the land is mine; for ye are strangers and sojourners (tenants) with me.

Oh hallelujah, it's about to get real good. We're getting into the Torah now! Hallelujah! Listen. You can sell the land temporarily. You can sell the land if you get in trouble and you get in debt—a debt you cannot pay, and you've got to sell MY land. You can do it temporarily. But that's not YOUR land.

Every 49 years I'm going to get it all back!! You don't have the right to sell it forever!! You all aren't picking this up—it's about to get good. Yahweh holds the right over every man on planet earth, and those men can sell their souls temporarily, they can give themselves to Satan temporarily, but joy comes on the Jubilee, the Last Great Day, when Yahweh gets everything back that he created !!! You better believe in the law of Jubilee!

How dare you give Yahweh's land away you bunch of Christian dumb butts! How dare you preach that Yahweh's land goes to Satan while we go to heaven, Yahweh's man goes to hell while we go to heaven! He said you cannot sell what's mine forever! That's why if you don't know Torah you cannot know your Bible! If you don't know Torah you are as dumb as a box of rocks, get out of the pulpit! Read that again...I get the Holy Ghost all over me when he says these words.

He said everything I've given you—why do you think he asked you to pay the tithe? Now I'm going to talk to you! Half of you all in this room don't even pay your tithe. And I love you. I couldn't care less if you ever do or don't. You pay here and you pay there. Do you know why? You're his tenant! Hallelujah.

He gave you \$10 and he charges you rent \$1. Do you not get it? It's a covenant where you don't admit that he owns your income, he doesn't own your house, he doesn't own your stuff—you're your own God! If you're not a tither, you're a false God worshipper—you are your own God. Don't keep the Sabbath if you're going to keep the tithe. And the tithe belongs to the ministers of the Tabernacle.

Listen to me carefully. You folks that are going over into these Zoom meetings—don't make me call names—where they're teaching against tithing—I challenge

them to a public debate today! When they tell you it was just animals, what do you think animals were? They were the commodities of that day! Get out of them Zooms...I love them...they've got truth over there, but you need to find a pastor.

God is saying to you...the money, the \$10 is mine! I'm making you a tenant. This is your inheritance. I woke you up. I gave it to you. And if you will not pay me \$1 then you don't believe the 10 is mine. Folks it's a principle. It's not a law. It's a principle. I didn't plan on teaching on tithing, but I will tell you...half of you here don't tithe. You're not going to go to hell if you don't pay tithe. Darling, we don't teach that. You're not going to die lost if you don't pay tithes. You're just not going in the government of trustworthy 144,000 government officials that paid "rent" on the land that their Father gave them.

And I don't care if your 10% is \$1. We've got a lady here that every week sends me \$4. I can only suppose that her husband gives her a \$40 allowance maybe. I know how much her income is. And do you know what? My wife is in the other room, and she'll tell you that that \$4 came through on my PayPal, and I showed my wife that this is the greatest offering I've ever received. And we get some large offerings.

But that \$4 says to me...*I'm listening to you Pastor. I hear what you're teaching me. Teach me to be a tenant of the Lord's inheritance. I'll pay my rent. I will say to him...you've given me this land, here is my thank you because you didn't have to give me anything.* It is selfish people that do not tithe to the work of Yahweh. Amen. I didn't mean to go there today, but evidently *he* did. Ooh, they were shouting over there before I got onto tithe...let me get back to over there. Hallelujah. Listen, it's not going to affect me one way or the other whether you tithe or not, but it will effect you. Amen.

Yahweh retains THE RIGHTS !!!

The people's rights were limited by certain restrictions set down by law. This shows that God retained sovereignty over the land, even though He gave the people a certain level of authority.

One restriction was that they did not have the right to sell their property for ever, that is, in perpetuity. Their inheritance was non-transferable. If they incurred a debt, they were allowed to sell land only until the Year of Jubilee, which occurred every 49 years (**Lev. 25:8**)



Yahweh retains the rights! The people's rights were limited by certain restrictions set down in the Torah. This shows that God retains sovereignty over the land even though he gave the people a certain level of authority. What did he tell Adam? Take dominion over the land. That was the authority man was given, but Yahweh retains the rights. Put that in your notes. Yahweh retains the rights. You've got to remember that going forward.

Yes! Satan is the god of this world. Yes, Yahweh gave Satan dominion over this earth. But Yahweh retains the what? The rights. You've got to remember that or you'll get all messed up. Ok let's continue.

Yahweh retains the rights. One restriction was that they did not have the right to sell their property forever. That means in perpetuity. Their inheritance was non-transferable. If they incurred a debt, they were allowed to sell the land only until the Year of Jubilee. Read Leviticus 25:8.

Leviticus 25:8

28 But if he is not able to restore it to himself, then what was sold shall remain in the hand of him who bought it until the Year of Jubilee. Then in the Jubilee it shall be released, and he shall return to his possession.

You can sell it temporarily. Yes, you can put it in debt temporarily. But when that 7th day rolls around, my God. When that 7th seven rolls around, I don't care who you owe the debt to, I don't care how bad your life was indebted to sin, on that year of Jubilee, all debts are forgiven! In that year of Jubilee, all obligations to the law are even forgiven! Hallelujah—in the year of Jubilee.

Folks, I'm here to tell you, that year of Jubilee is soon to come. Joy does comes in the morning! I've come to tell you that Jubilee is about to return, oh hallelujah. Hallelujah!

What belongs to Yahweh can only be lost how long? Temporarily. This meant that a family could not lose their inheritance for more than a generation. It made sure that every citizen would have freedom, they would have their land. The land belonged to God, so no man had the ability or the right to lose his land for all time. He was only capable, by his own will, to "lose" it temporarily, because that was the extent of his authority. By law, under God's sovereignty, a man could only lose (or sell) his land temporarily. You all have got to get that in your notes and in your mind. You have free will, yes you do, but it's only good temporarily.

(from elder reading scripture: Pastor that last verse I read must've been meant to be read, but I read the wrong verse. I read 28.) Well good, then read it.

Leviticus 25:8

8 And you shall count seven Sabbaths of years for yourself, seven times seven years; and the time of the seven Sabbaths of years shall be to you forty-nine years.

Yes sir. That is seven Sabbaths—the Shemitah. That is called the Shemitah. That is when no matter what you did by your own freewill—hey, these children of Israel had freewill—they could sell their property, yes right? Good old freewill. But on the Shemitah, your freewill expires. Amen. On the Shemitah his will takes over. In the Shemitah, no matter what you did with my land, I get it all back. Hallelujah.

He's got a plan. In the beginning was the plan. The plan was with Yah, and the plan belonged to Yah. Folks you all better know about this plan. It's in the Mazzaroth. Man was created by what? Land! This means that God owns all men. If he owns the land, he owns everything created from the land. Man is part of the "land" that God owns by right of creation.

Brother Vaughn, we sold ourself into sin. Ok, you can do that. You've got freewill. You can mess up all you want to. And you're going to owe a debt. And you're going to have to pay the debt. But in the Shemitah, no matter what you've done with your freewill, it all comes to an end. You can't lose it forever.

Brother Vaughn, what about all these drug addicts? They won't be drug addicts forever. Hallelujah. *But brother Vaughn, they've made a wreck of their lives.* They have a right to do that temporarily. But JOY comes in the morning! Thank Yah for truth! I said, thank God for truth!! There's hope for mankind.

Listen. I want you to put this in your notes:

Man does not have the authority, right, or even the ability
to "sell his soul to the devil" for all time.

It doesn't belong to him to sell. Now I'm ready to show you where he can sell it temporarily. Somebody say Shemitah. When the Shemitah comes, it doesn't matter who you sold your soul to—it goes back to the owner! Is anybody listening to me?? Oh hallelujah!

Brother Vaughn, I've sold my soul to drugs. That's good. Then drugs have to give you back in the Shemitah. *I've sold my soul to homosexuality.* Homosexuality's got to give you back in the Shemitah. *I've sold my soul to...* it's got to give you

back! Joy comes in the morning. Oh, and there will be a judgment for your sin. Let's talk about that judgment. Yahweh is responsible for his creation. Put that in your notes. Yahweh is responsible for what he creates. He's responsible for it.

I am responsible for the land that Yahweh has given me for my ministry. Why do you think that nobody's allowed to pull onto the land without signing a waiver? I'm responsible. I can't afford a lawsuit on that land. I can't afford to lose that land. I'm responsible for protecting what I own.

And yet, we don't even hold Yahweh to that responsibility? It's about to get good everybody...hold onto to your bloomers!

In the divine laws in the Torah of liability, God lays down the principle that a man is responsible for what he owns. For example, let's go to Torah. Exodus 21:33-34. If a farmer digs a well on his land and neglects to cover up that well, and a neighbor's ox falls into that well and is killed, the owner of the pit is liable and must pay damages to his neighbor. Let's read what the Torah says.

Exodus 21:33-34

33 And if a man uncovers a pit, or digs a pit and fails to cover it, and an ox or a donkey falls into it,

34 The owner of the pit must pay for the loss; he must pay its owner, and the dead animal will be his.

Now it's getting ready to get real good folks. This lesson's about to take off. I'm about to show you that Yahweh is bound by Torah to restore everyone that fell into the pit that he created. Oh hallelujah!

Again, if a man lights a fire and it gets out of hand and burns the neighbor's field, the man who lit the fire is liable because he created the fire and therefore is it's owner.

Exodus 22:6

If a fire breaks out and catches in thorn-bushes so that it burns stacked grain, standing grain, or a field, he who kindled the fire shall surely make restitution.

Wow. Everybody except Yahweh. Yahweh created something that has turned into a fire. Ok, it's fixing to get good. Required of you to listen. It's going to require you to understand. There's the Torah. Yahweh is bound by the Torah. There is a Torah principle. If you created a mess!...whew!...you've got to fix it!! *That's why it grieved God when he created man*. Now brother you are exactly right because

that creation turned into a mess. And now it's on him to fix the mess. And that's why he sent his own Son! Hallelujah! HE HAD TO FIX THE FAILURE BECAUSE HE CREATED IT! Whew! If you don't know the Torah, get out of the pulpit!

Who is responsible for evil?

Did you know that Yahweh is ultimately liable for all the evil that has ever occurred in the world? Are you ready to accept that? Until you're ready to accept that he's responsible, you can never accept that he's got to fix it. I'm going to make you think today now. According to Torah sister, if I dig a well, and I don't cover that well, can I say...*well your stupid ox shouldn't of been...your ox...*no, no, no. No, I can't blame the ox. Then how can God blame Adam for falling into the trap that God set?

As in Adam, all die. In the second Adam, all have to live!! Oh hallelujah!! All is being restored to what he had intended. And the heaven's are holding him back until the restitution of all things! Yahweh is bound by Torah.

You can't blame the devil for being the devil. Who created the devil? Yahweh created him. But Yahweh's not responsible. Really? Do you know that we wouldn't even allow one of our children to cop out on that? If you've got a child, are you going to let them say...*well I, I, I...*? No. Well Yahweh knew and according to Torah, he is responsible.

It's accountability. You create a world. You create a devil. But I'm not responsible for you all's choices. Because that's why they say...*the devil made me do it*. And he well may have darling, but Yahweh's going to make you undo it. Hallelujah. Yahweh said...sin is crouching at the door. And brothers and sisters, who allows him to crouch there? Yah!

Listen. Now this is very important that you understand. *Brother Vaughn, are you saying that we all get off scot-free?* Oh no. I didn't get off scot-free. Sin crouched at my door and I'm still paying when I look at my three children. I'm still paying under the rod of iron. Nobody's getting by with anything. Your choices have consequences. So does Yahweh's. Do you know what I had to do with my bad decisions? I had to fix it! When I got out, I had to go on the straight and narrow and fix my choices.

Yahweh is going to fix this broken world. And he's not going to do it through Yahshua. He's going to do it through you! But you cannot fix what is broken while you're still broken. That's why he's fixing you now so that we can fix them later.

Pastor, Isaiah 54:16 says...and it is I who have created the destroyer to wreck havoc. Absolutely. He said...I created the waster to destroy. You cannot blame bad men because the bad men did not create themselves. In the case of the ox falling into the pit, the one who dug it cannot say...*that stupid ox fell into the pit by it's own freewill*. Do you all know that argument would never work in a court of law, yet we let Yahweh off the hook by saying...*well it's by my own freewill*. Huh. Who created you so that you could fall into that ditch with that freewill?

I'm trying to make a point today that you serve a good God who's going to bring the Shemitah. The year of Jubilee is on it's way for planet earth. We must preach about this joy. The best is yet to come!

Brother Vaughn, no, Adam and Eve made the choice. They went into the garden and they chose the wrong tree. Wait a minute. Who created the trees? And who created the serpent who deceived them into taking the tree? Who created it? Yahweh. So now can Yahweh violate Torah by saying...*the stupid ox fell into the ditch?* You all better learn Torah. If you don't know Torah, then get out of the pulpit. Everything goes back to Torah.

If he created it, he has to fix it. Now, he allowed it to be broken. Why? *Brother Vaughn, why even create it?* I'll tell you why. So very simple. Why create it when he knows it's going to be broken? Because within himself, Yahweh was the propensity to be a lot of things. He could be a father. To be a father, you need what? Children.

He had the propensity to be a healer. To be a healer, there must be what? Something to heal. He had the propensity to be a savior. To be a savior, something must be lost. He had the propensity to be a deliverer. But for him to show forth his majesty, there must be something to deliver. He allowed the thing to break so that what was inside of him could come forth, his ability to repair. His ability to restore is displayed in giving you the ability to fall.

If I had the propensity like brother does to be a carpenter, I need a piece of wood, or else my abilities are never displayed. The song I wrote Beautifully Broken in all the right places. He is the potter. How can he display his pottery if there's none that is broken? You see, he let it fall apart so that one day he can fix it all and display his ability to fix broken things! So that you will love him even more than you do right now.

Brothers and sisters, if he allowed it to be broken, it's only so that he can look beautiful when it's all restored. Now, there is so much more that I want to talk about but our time is gone. I want to continue through the Torah and show you these laws that are coming to pass. One of the things I want to talk to you about

next week if I can—John 3:16. “For God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten son”. His son is the repair job. And yet that son is just the first of the first fruits. Next week we’re going to get in to how this repair is going to work. And next week we’re going to talk about hell, the lake of fire—we’re getting there. And I know you already have questions about certain scriptures that seem to indicate the lake of fire. I get it. We’re going there. In the meantime, you’re doctrine has to line up with his character. Amen. Amen.

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
