It is then that I proceed to tell them, what I hope to teach you in this booklet, *“There is in fact only ONE TRUE GOSPEL! But, from the Christian pulpits of the world there are in fact many FALSE GOSPELS being preached”* it is at this point that I normally have their interest piqued, as I hope to do with you.

Chances are the gospel that you have heard preached ABOUT Jesus Christ your entire life is in fact not THE TRUE GOSPEL . . .

Have you been deceived?

YOU PICKED UP THIS BOOKLET FOR A REASON!

PEOPLE CRAVE GOOD NEWS

The word “*gospel*” simply means *good news*.

So, anytime someone delivers you good news, they are delivering to you a “gospel message”. Therefore, there can be many gospels or many items of good news.

Such is the case in the religion of Christianity; every Sunday people gather throughout all the villages and hamlets of America and the world to hear some good news after a busy week of stress and bad news.

This good news is preached or shared in their local churches by preachers with smiles as big as the moon. The congregation gives the minister his thirty minutes to deliver them some desperately needed good news. It works out for everyone involved; the parishioners get a feel good gospel and the preacher gets a check, retirement package and a free home. Everyone gets an emotional washing after this bit of good news and they are now ready to pack up the family, load up the mini van and head to the nearest restaurant for lunch. Everyone is excited about the good news that they heard today, of how wonderful they are.

Indeed, these families heard a gospel message; they heard what their ears wanted to hear and therefore they will come again next week to get some more good news.

Now, is there anything wrong with hearing good and encouraging news? Absolutely not! We all need to be uplifted and motivated and given a reprieve from the harshness of life. It is for this reason that there are men in the business of motivational

speaking and life coaching; to give you good news of how to be a success in life.

However, THE CHURCH OF JESUS CHRIST has one mission; to preach to the world, as a witness, THE EXACT SAME GOOD NEWS THAT JESUS HIMSELF PREACHED. Sadly, what we hear in our churches today is indeed good news but IT IS NOT THE GOOD NEWS THAT THE CHURCH IS COMMANDED TO PREACH.

We are told to “*go forth into all the world and preach the gospel of Jesus Christ*” and yet today in most churches you will hear good news but not the good news OF JESUS CHRIST.

Oh, yes, you may very well hear good news ABOUT Jesus; the life He lived, the lessons He taught, His death, burial and resurrection. However, that also is not the good news OF Jesus Christ. Rather, that is the good news ABOUT Jesus Christ but it is not the good news OF Jesus Christ nor is it **THE GOOD NEWS THAT JESUS PREACHED**. Yahshua (Jesus Christ) did not come preaching about Himself but rather His Father and THE SOON COMING KINGDOM OF HIS FATHER. ¹

The Messiah of Israel came with ONE MESSAGE that He preached and that message was not a message about His death, burial or resurrection or any of His miracles. Rather, He came preaching ONE MESSAGE and one message only “*Repent, turn from commandment breaking and prepare for the coming kingdom of God is approaching or at hand*”²

THIS IS THE EXACT OPPOSITE OF WHAT THE CHURCH AT LARGE PREACHES TODAY! Allow me to list a few of the good news messages being preached today in the name of Christ.

1 John 12:49

2 Matt 4:17

THE VARIOUS GOSPELS PREACHED TODAY

THE SOCIAL GOSPEL - We should rid the earth of poverty

THE FAITH GOSPEL - We should have more faith

THE MIRACLE GOSPEL - God's got a miracle waiting on you

THE PRAISE & WORSHIP GOSPEL - Let's all just worship Him

THE PROSPERITY GOSPEL - God want's us all wealthy

THE HEALING GOSPEL - God want's to heal everyone

THE GRACE GOSPEL - Everyone's sins are absolved before they
even commit sin, God no longer requires anything of us.

THE LAW GOSPEL - Everyone should be living under Jewish law

THE HOLINESS GOSPEL - Everyone needs to line up to our spe-
cific set of man made standards

THE EMOTIONAL GOSPEL - Let's all just have good church

THE SELF HELP GOSPEL - Everyone needs to love themselves

THE ESCAPE GOSPEL - Lets all escape and get out of here

THE BAPTISM GOSPEL - Let's get everyone baptized

THE HOLY GHOST GOSPEL - Let's get everyone filled with the
Holy Ghost

Every “gospel” preached today has elements of truth within them. None of the gospels mentioned above are “*Bad gospels*” in fact, within each of those messages you can glean very good things. However, none of those gospel aforementioned are THE GOSPEL OR THE MESSAGE THAT CHRIST PREACHED and commanded us to preach to all men, they are in fact pseudo gospels and yet entire churches and ministries are built around these various “specialized gospels”.

It reminds me of the medical field and how there are specialties in the field of medicine; religion has developed these specialty gospels that attract certain followers who acclimate to the sounds of those various gospels.

TODAY’S GOSPEL MESSAGE

The gospel that we hear today is not the gospel that our Messiah preached. Rather, we hear a gospel that tells us the life story of Christ and His resurrection. YET, JESUS WAS PREACHING A GOSPEL BEFORE THERE WAS A DEATH, BURIAL AND RESURRECTION. The scriptures tell us that Jesus “*came preaching the gospel.*”

Matt 4:23 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel

If indeed the true gospel is simply “telling the life story of Christ” and causing men to believe that life story, as we are taught today, then how could Yahshua (Jesus) be “*preaching the gospel*” before there was a story to tell, years before there was a death burial or resurrection?

You and I, as students of the scriptures, must find out, it is incumbent upon us to know what our Lord was preaching before there was anything to preach. Only when we figure this out will we be able to preach the exact same gospel that He came preaching.

In the following verse you will find exactly what gospel Yahshua (Jesus) preached and once you find out, we will then explain from the scriptures the depth of the gospel that He preached so that you can now know exactly what gospel you should be sharing with the world around you.

Matt 4:23 - And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching THE GOSPEL OF THE KINGDOM

In all of the synoptic writings of the gospels you will find this same reference in all of Christ preaching, His message, His gospel, His mantra was a KINGDOM MESSAGE. He was not telling a story about Himself rather He was preaching a message about something that was approaching, something that was soon to come and that “SOMETHING” was the COMING WORLDWIDE GOVERNMENT THAT WILL SOON RULE PLANET EARTH. Not only was He preaching about this coming kingdom or government but also He was calling men everywhere to “*Repent of their sins*” or in other words “*Stop breaking God’s laws*” so that they might be transformed into obedient sons and counted worthy to rule and reign over the nations in this coming government upon earth.

One of the reasons that you do not hear the true gospel today is because Lucifer has robbed our understanding of this kingdom that Christ was preaching about. Most of Christianity today has little to no understanding of the Kingdom of God or the Kingdom of Heaven.

A STRONG WARNING

Does it matter? Can we preach just any of the popular gospels out there today and still do some good? Does it really matter which gospel we preach? As God's true, end-time church we are commissioned, no, we are commanded to preach THE GOSPEL and there is only one gospel of Christ.

Gal 1:6-9

I am astonished that you are so quickly deserting him who called you in the grace of Christ and are turning to A DIFFERENT GOSPEL

Not that there is another one, but there are some who trouble you and want to DISTORT THE GOSPEL OF CHRIST

But even if we or an angel from heaven should preach to you A GOSPEL CONTRARY to the one we preached to you, let him be accursed

As we have said before, so now I say again: If anyone is preaching to you A GOSPEL CONTRARY to the one you received, let him be accursed.

It seems from this writing that the Apostle Paul feared and warned the church of these pseudo gospels. Evidently, there were "other gospels" being preaching even in the beginning stages of the early church, the spirit of error has only magnified in our day, the final hours of the final age of man.

Think about it! Are you listening to another gospel in your church each week? Are you hearing a message of repent and prepare your garments for the upcoming wedding of Christ and His spotless bride? Are you hearing a message that reminds you to begin training now for reigning later? Are you hearing a message that calls into a sanctified life, the putting away of sin and commandment breaking?

It is imperative that we always remember that THE TRUE GOSPEL will be contrary to what the carnal mind wants to hear. A gospel of change and repentance is not the gospel that men desire. They prefer a gospel that accommodates for their rebellious living and overlooks their commandment breaking. Such a gospel has been created; carnal minded Christians flock to this so-called gospel by the multitudes. Designed by Satan himself to convince men that God is overlooking their sins; it is known as the gospel of GRACE ALONE; by perverting Paul's writings, they have created a grace message that mocks the true biblical meaning of grace.

The true gospel will never make men happy in their sins; any gospel that makes you happy is probably not the true gospel. Why? Because, THE TRUE GOSPEL of Christ brings godly sorrow into our hearts. The true gospel never pleases men, they must create ANOTHER GOSPEL, one that is pleasing to them.

I Thess 2:4 - But as we were allowed of God to be put in trust with the gospel, even so we speak; not as pleasing men, but God, which trieth our hearts.

CHRIST, THE MESSENGER OF THE GOSPEL

As we journey further into this exploration of finding out what the true gospel is, there is a very sure fact that is often overlooked by the whole of Christianity. Hardly, do we remember, as we should, that *Yahshua (Jesus)* was a Messenger of the New Covenant. He was a Messenger! Think about this.

Today's gospel, preached throughout the world, places their entire emphasis on the man, Christ Jesus rather than on His message. In doing so, we miss out on a very vital part of the true gospel, His message! While most any Christian can tell you about the man, the person, upon which the religion of Christianity is built, very few can tell you **THE MESSAGE** that He was born to bring into our world. Only when you can tell the message that Christ brought, only then can adequately present the true gospel. Everything that Christ said, all of his teachings were all related to one primary message, what is that message?

Before we jump into that message, which is **THE TRUE GOSPEL** of Christ, let's prove from the scriptures that indeed Christ is the Messenger, rather than the Message,.

Mal 3:1 - Behold, I will send MY MESSENGER, and he shall prepare the way before me: and the Messiah whom ye seek, shall suddenly come to his temple, even THE MESSENGER OF THE COVENANT, whom ye delight in: behold, he shall come, saith the Yahweh of hosts

Now, if someone is a messenger, they are basically, a news-caster, Correct? They are pretty much delivering the news or the message to you. So, therefore Yahshua (Jesus) was bringing GOOD NEWS to planet earth on behalf of His father, Yahweh (God). Sadly, the world has heard about THE MESSENGER but they have not heard THE MESSAGE that He brought.

My job and your job is to be a carrier of THE MESSAGE that THE MESSENGER brought. Can you tell me what His message was? **HE NEVER ONCE PREACHED ABOUT THE DEATH, BURIAL AND RESURRECTION AS HIS MESSAGE AND YET THAT IS WHAT THE MODERN CHURCH REFERS TO AS THE GOSPEL.** While those are a tremendous and glorious part of the gospel; they are not the full gospel. Today's gospel present a beautiful life story about the Messenger, while leaving out THE MESSAGE; that message is indeed what THE TRUE GOSPEL is.

Well meaning preachers have often told me, when they think that we are preaching “*too deep*”; they often say “*just preach the simple gospel*” and yet when it comes down to it, that is exactly what we are doing; preaching THE MESSAGE that was brought to our planet by THE MESSENGER.

Now, that we have established that Christ was The Messenger of the gospel; our next job is to find out what He came preaching. Please be reminded; When *Yahshua* came, there had been no death, burial or resurrection. He was not preaching THAT GOSPEL... But, he was preaching THE gospel. Let us now journey into the scriptures to find out what gospel.

Luke 16:16 - The law and the prophets were until John: since that time THE KINGDOM OF GOD is preached

According to your own Bible . . . What was His Message? The Kingdom of God

WHAT THE GOSPEL IS NOT!

THE TRUE GOSPEL IS NOT ABOUT THE LIFE OF CHRIST ALONE! We must get this into our thinking. When we simply tell the story of Christ life, His miracles, His good deeds, His love for humanity, His death, His burial, His resurrection; we are telling a VITAL PART of the gospel, but we are missing a huge dimension of the gospel, the totality of the gospel. We are experts at telling the world about THE MESSENGER but not about the message that He brought.

Yahshua came preaching a message! He came preaching about His fathers coming Kingdom. Yet, in modern Christianity, we are clueless about THE COMING KINGDOM of God to our planet. Yet, Christ came preaching to all dwellers of earth about a coming day when He would rule all of the earth as the righteous king of all kings. He told of a coming day of rest when “*the wicked will cease from troubling and the weary shall be at rest*” He preached about the day when all wrongs would be made right and all of earth would be restored to her rightful creator, Yahweh.

Now, many of you reading this will immediately think, “*Oh, I know all about the kingdom, I’ve heard the kingdom preached about.*” However, in this booklet you will perhaps be forced into acknowledging that before now you have never truly understood the magnitude of this subject with all of it’s glory and importance in our lives.

Now, we read earlier in Luke 16:16 that Christ came preaching “*the gospel of the kingdom of God*” so let’s study the meaning of the words; *gospel* and *kingdom*

Gospel – is an Old English word for “*god spell or good news*” So, truthfully, any “Good news” is gospel. Thus the reason that we must discover the TRUE GOOD NEWS.

Kingdom – this word is hardly understood by modern day readers as most of us have never lived in the culture of a kingdom; most of us are children of democracies or republics, without monarchs. So, to make this word easy to understand, I am going to ask you to replace this word KINGDOM with another word that you may find easier to comprehend the meaning of. When we change the word KINGDOM to GOVERNMENT, then we can seem to better identify with that word as we are all acquainted with the word GOVERNMENT.

Now, having changed this word, we can try and proceed with this understanding of the Kingdom of God. Having done so, we can now change the phrase “*Kingdom of God*” to the “*Government of God or Yahweh*.” If Christ therefore came preaching the good news of the Kingdom of God, what was He actually preaching? THE GOOD NEWS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF GOD OR YAHWEH! It is only when you get this idea of government firmly planted into your mind will all of the scriptures began to unfold before you.

We are now going to examine this idea further by looking at the early Apostles and seeing exactly which gospel they were preaching. Were they simply preaching the life story of the man *Yahshua* or were they preaching something of greater depth?

I believe the truth will astound you!

What gospel did Paul preach?



Acts 19:8- *And he went into the synagogue, and spake boldly for the space of three months, disputing and persuading the things concerning the kingdom of God.*



There were three components to Paul's gospel found in Acts 20:25, 21

- 1 - Repentance
- 2 - Christ
- 3 - The Kingdom of God



Paul's message was clearly made up at least two parts; the man, *Christ Jesus or Yahshua* and also it included another dimension; the message that the man *Christ Jesus* preached, **THE KINGDOM OF GOD**. According to the above verse, Paul preached for twelve weeks or three months about the very message that this ministry preaches to the world; *the coming Kingdom of God to planet earth during the 1,000 year reign of Christ and His 144,000 government during The Day of the Lord*. As you research verses 21-25 of the 20th chapter of Acts; you will find one message or one gospel constituting three parts;

- *Repentance from breaking the commandments of Yahweh*
- *The life story, the mission and the sacrifice of the Messiah*
- *The soon coming Kingdom of Heaven to earth*

What is the difference in his gospel and today's gospel? Quite simply; they are preaching only the man without preaching His message.

What gospel did Paul preach?



Acts 28:30-31- And Paul dwelt two whole years in his own hired house, and received all that came in unto him. Preaching the kingdom of God, and teaching those things which concern the Lord Jesus Christ, with all confidence, no man forbidding him.



Luke, the writer of Acts, differentiates between preaching about the kingdom of God and preaching about Jesus Christ!

While both are vitally important, they are clearly two separate subjects!



Notice carefully, the above verse. Once again you will see the balance of Paul's gospel. He taught about two subjects; The man, Yahshua and also about the Father kingdom that Yahshua would one day rule over. He never preached one without the other; to do so impossible and yet somehow modern Christianity has managed to do so.

Countless are the sermons where even the smallest child can recite the numerous details about the Son of God. Volumes of Sunday School literature fills the minds of our children concerning this Nazarene. However, one would be hard pressed to ask the average congregant or student to as readily tell them about the Kingdom of God. Sadly, this is an embarrassing truth and a very indictment against our jobs at educating the church in the fullness of the gospel as preached by Christ, His Apostles and the early Apostolic Church. The time has come and now is when we must remove the scales from our eyes and once again face the truth, preach the truth and to the nations of the world, be a witness of this glorious truth of not only the crucified lamb but the soon coming King and His glorious government of saints.

What gospel did Phillip preach

Acts 8:12 - But when they believed Philip preaching the things concerning the kingdom of God, and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women

We see that Phillip not only preached the kingdom of God, but he also differentiated it from the teaching *about Christ. Remember, the messenger is not the only part of the message*

There is a biblical principle that all students of scripture are familiar with. This principle or law of hermeneutics is called “The principle of the double witness.” When establishing correct doctrine there must be a preponderance of the collective evidence. Both, the old and the new covenant must bare witness with the same. The reason that I am calling forth the written words of several Apostles to prove this point is because of necessity. We are trying to establish for you, Apostolic authority in this teaching.

We now present to you another early church father, Phillip. In the verse mentioned in the above graphic you will notice upon close examination, the same thing that we saw in Paul’s writings on previous pages of this booklet. There is indeed a differentiation of the several parts of THE ONE TRUE GOSPEL.

Phillip is preaching first about the coming Kingdom of God to our planet. However, this is not his only subject matter. He now preaches the part of the gospel message that we have all mastered, the story of the man, Christ Jesus or Yahshua the Messiah.

It is noteworthy in this verse that there is a separation of these two subjects and yet there is no separation, if that makes any sense to you. The kingdom without the king doesn't exist. However, to preach the King without the kingdom is a tremendous lack of responsibility for the gospel minister.

These ones to whom Phillip was preaching, they were all baptized in the name of Yahshua, the Messiah. However, they were being baptized not just for baptism sake. They had just heard a message about the coming kingdom of the Messiah and in response to that message, they were ready to yield their lives to the Lordship of the Son of God or *Yahweh*.

This is the travesty of the modern gospel. Men are indeed being baptized in the name of Christ but for what, they know not. Sadly, many of them are being baptized for baptism sake or for salvations sake. They didn't hear the rest of the gospel which describes why they should believe on Christ. The reason? That they might begin the process of conversion; that they might begin training for reigning and schooling for ruling with Christ. Only when we have a correct understand of the whys will we seek to discover the ways.

We must align ourselves with a millennium mentality. We must move into a fuller understanding of this One World Ruling government that shall soon consume all other kingdoms and governments. We must preach what Phillip was preaching in the above verse; both Christ the King and the message of the Kingdom.

What I am trying to introduce to you is THE MISSING PART of the gospel while being most careful to in no way belittle the known part of the gospel.

We are all familiar with the titles of Christ our Messiah. We have all preached through the years of His glorious attributes and the roles that He either has or will fulfill. We all know Him as our Savior who shed His precious blood to purchase and redeem the lost sheep of the House of Israel.

We have all come to trust Him as our healer and our deliverer. Many of us call Him Lord and Master and submit our lives to Him as such. However, even though we are all familiar with those terms and those parts of the majestic gospel; are we as familiar with the missing part?

The major theme of the gospel should be; the soon coming King. However, while some Christians still believe in the coming of Christ, most of our understanding stops there. King of what? What will that kingdom be like and what is my purpose in that kingdom. He is returning to literally sit on the literal, earthly throne of King David in the city of Jerusalem.

His father, Yahweh, made Him a promise, that He would sit on David's throne and to this very date; that promise has not been fulfilled; THIS IS THE MISSING PART OF THE GOSPEL.

Venture with me into the Pauline epistle of II Cor 11:4

For if he that cometh preacheth ANOTHER JESUS, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or ANOTHER GOSPEL, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him.

An honest person can hardly read the above verse and not see yet again; the distinction between THE MAN and THE MESSAGE. When the false gospel comes, according to Paul, it will come wrapped in the name of Jesus or Yahshua but this will in fact be ANOTHER JESUS, not the biblical one. Not only will this be another Jesus but also another gospel or another message.

We can see plainly that the true gospel and the false gospel are both comprised of the man and the message. However, one of those gospel will portray the true Messiah of Israel and the message of His soon coming kingdom. The other message will present a Christ of no commandments, a Christ that looks a lot like Santa Clause and then they will tell you that HE IS THE MESSAGE.

Do all the Apostles Agree?

By this time it should be more than plain to any honest student that all of the Apostles spoke of the Kingdom of Yahweh in all of their writings. The main theme in the true gospel is the King and His Kingdom, the Man and His message!

Now, let us move on to all of the gospel writers; called the synoptic writers. Do they agree? Will we find the same thread of thought in their preaching? Do they simply preach the lamb of God without preaching the soon coming Kingdom of God? Unlike the modern church, they, like the Apostles we studied previously, completely understood the True Gospel.

The Times of Refreshing

There is a time spoken of by all the Holy Prophets, a future time when all of the earth will be refreshed and restored. There is a coming world government when all of Lucifer's wrongs will

be made right; when “*the wicked shall cease from troubling and the weary shall be at rest.*” Now that you have an understanding of The Time of Refreshing; I would like to present you with a scripture for you to ponder;

Acts 3:19-21 Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when THE TIMES OF REFRESHING shall come from the presence of the Lord. And he shall send Jesus Christ, which before was preached unto you. Whom the heaven must receive until the times of restitution of all things, which God hath SPOKEN BY THE MOUTH OF ALL HIS HOLY PROPHETS
SINCE THE WORLD BEGAN.

Please read those verses carefully and ponder their meaning! Not only did Paul, Phillip, the Apostles, the gospel writers and Christ preaching of the future day, known as the Kingdom of God but according to the book of Acts, so did ALL THE PROPHETS! Can't you see? This is the message of the book!

Question to be answered

So far, what gospel have we proven that Christ, Peter, Phillip, Paul, the Apostles and all of the prophets of the Old Testament preached? Was it just a gospel ABOUT Christ? Or was there another dimension to the message? Indeed, the scriptures have proven concretely that the true gospel has been preached in both Old and New Testaments; Christ and His Kingdom!

Let's go back even further than the Holy Prophets and let's see if we can find this true gospel being preached, even before the flood of Noah.

Jude 14-15; And Enoch also, the seventh from Adam, prophesied of these, saying, Behold, THE LORD COMETH WITH TEN THOUSANDS OF HIS SAINTS. To execute judgment upon all, and to convince all that are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have ungodly committed, and of all their hard speeches which ungodly sinners have spoken against him.

Who was Enoch? He was a gospel preacher before Noah was even born. You ask me, "*How was he a gospel preacher before the New Testament?*" Quite frankly, because, He understood THE TRUE GOSPEL of the coming Kingdom of Yahweh to planet Earth, to rule and govern with His holy saints.

The above verse tells us what the gospel was in those days; the same as it is today! **REPENT AND PREPARE FOR THE COMING KINGDOM OF YAHWEH.** Now, let's see if the Chief Apostle, Peter, regarded Enoch's message as THE TRUE GOSPEL message.

II Peter 2:5 - And spared not the old world, but saved Noah the eighth person, a preacher of righteousness

The Apostolic prelate himself, Peter, identifies Noah as “the eighth son from Adam” while Jude in our previous verse identifies Enoch as “the seventh”. Noah was evidently preaching Enoch’s message and Peter rightly calls him a “preacher of righteousness”. Why? Because, even before the flood, THE TRUE GOSPEL was going forth “*Prepare for the Day of the Lord*” the great millennium reign. In order for Peter to call Noah a preacher of righteousness, he had to be preaching THE RIGHT MESSAGE.

What message are you hearing today? “*Just confess Christ and believe in your heart and you’ll be saved*” without any mention of preparing for the soon coming of the Kingdom of God. We are given no instruction from modern Christianity in the ways of righteousness lest we be accused of legalism and bondage.



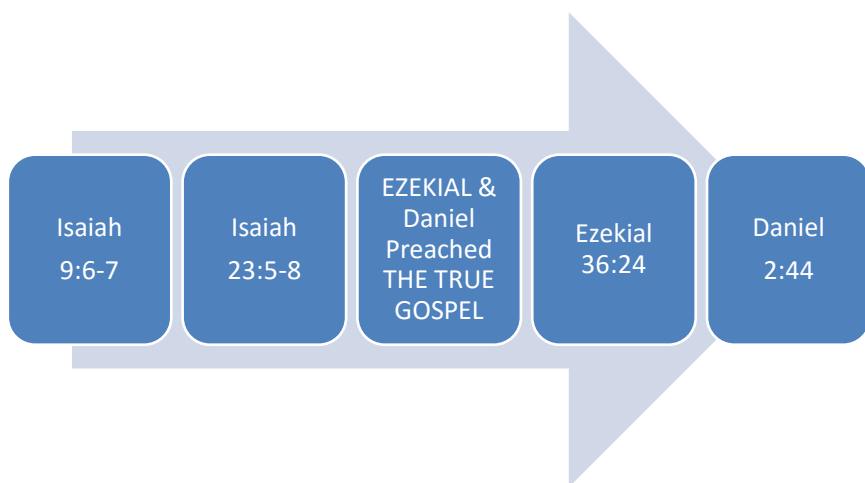
What gospel did David believe?



Psalms 67:4

*O let the nations be glad
and sing for joy: for thou
shalt judge the people
righteously, and govern
the nations upon earth.
Selah.*

What gospel did Isaiah preach?



As a serious student of the scripture; you owe it to yourself to read the above verses. You should stop right here until you have done so. When you read Isaiah's writings, you will be astounded at how much he speaks of this coming day of the Lord, this coming Kingdom of *Yahweh* to planet Earth.

The Message of the Messiah

Would you answer a question honestly? What if you have not been preaching the true message that our Messiah preached? Would you change your message? I did! For 30 years, I preached the life story of Christ but never one time did I preach His message.

*Mark 1:1 - The beginning of the gospel of Jesus Christ,
the Son of God*

*John 12:49 - For I HAVE NOT SPOKEN OF MYSELF; but the Father

Please note that He did not come preaching about Himself. Rather, He came preaching about a message that had been entrusted unto Him to deliver to the world.

*Mark 1:14 - Now after that John was put in prison, Jesus came
into Galilee, preaching THE GOSPEL OF THE KINGDOM OF GOD.*

If the Kingdom of God was such a prevalent message of Christ and His Apostles and His Prophets, why do we not hear this message preached today? Quite simply, the god of this world has deceived the entire world. He has transformed his ministers into angels of light and bringing the church into the sleep of death.
