- Prayer is a weapon that destroys pride.
- Pride is innate in every individual and must be relinquished in order to truly pray.
- Every human being, regardless of age or gender, prays at some point in their life.
- Not all prayers are effective, and the following explanation will shed light on why.
- Prayer is not about words; simply reciting prayers does not guarantee effective communication with God.
- The power of prayer is not determined by the duration of time spent praying.
- A robot programmed to pray continuously would not receive answers to its prayers because prayer is not solely dependent on words or time.

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The Importance of a Personal Relationship with God in Prayer

- When coming to God in prayer, it is important to remember that one cannot approach God as a robot.
- Vain repetitious prayers, such as reciting the Lord's Prayer without understanding its meaning, should be avoided.
- The Lord's Prayer is not about reciting specific words, but about understanding the manner in which prayer should be conducted.
- The first aspect of prayer mentioned is the desire for God's kingdom to come.
- Just as God does not hear a robot's prayer, He also does not hear the prayers of the rebellious.
- Scripture states that prayers are considered an abomination if the person turns their ear away from hearing God's Word.
- Building a relationship with God involves obedience to His law and His Word.
- God does not speak to rebellious individuals because their rebellion can have a negative influence.
- Obedience to God's law is necessary for prayers to be heard.
- Parents sometimes cut off their children due to rebellion, not because they do not love them.
- Blessing rebellious individuals with fellowship can enable them to continue in rebellion, so boundaries need to be set.

Misconceptions about Prayer and Divine Healing in Christian Churches

- The speaker criticizes the mindset of some Christians who disregard the importance of keeping the Sabbath day holy, claiming that their prayers become an abomination when they rebel against this truth.
- These scriptures, which emphasize the significance of the Sabbath, are rarely discussed in mainstream Christian churches as they worship a different idea of God, whom the speaker describes as a "teddy bear," "Santa Claus," or "dream of Genie" God.
- The speaker argues that when prayers go unanswered, some Christians blame God instead of taking responsibility for their own actions and choices.
- The speaker's doctrine on divine healing differs from most churches, as they do not believe that everyone will be healed. They attribute this belief to the consequences of sin, particularly sins committed against one's own body.
- Divine healing is distinguished from miracles, with the latter being considered as a special intervention by God despite one's actions, while divine healing is said to require personal responsibility for actions, such as making unhealthy lifestyle choices.
- The speaker highlights the importance of understanding that healing is not guaranteed for everyone and suggests that it is not God's will to heal everyone, as healing is described as the children's bread, not for the rebellious.
