

JOY COMES IN THE MORNING

Part 3

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The God that we serve is an omniscient God. He is so wonderful at what he has done. He built this earth and created a beautiful creation. But the problem is, we feel like he dropped the ball. Not me, I know better, right? But Christianity, if you listen to their message about this God, he sorta didn't have it all figured out. Why? Because the devil entered the picture and messed everything up.

Now folks if you think I'm just speaking hyperbole, I'm not. That is what the Christian message is—that Yahweh is in a war with the devil for the souls of men. And here's the problem with that folks. The same preachers that tell you that Yahweh is in a struggle with Satan to win the souls of men, the very preachers that preach this message that Satan and Yahweh are in a war, are the very ones who tell you that you serve a God that no one can defeat.

So if he's undefeatable, then how is he in a war with the devil? Ok? You have got to get these thoughts out of your mind about the God you serve. The God that you serve is sovereign. Now, to think that he created a creation with the inability to keep that creation is to worship a false God. I dare tell you today that the vast majority of Christianity worships a false God.

First of all, they worship a man as God. They worship an incarnation, and therefore, in their minds, the God they serve can do anything except have a plan. A perfect plan. To them, here is the plan. God created everything perfect. He lost it all. He put together this plan to try to get some of it back. And at the end, he's just going to get what he can and be thankful for what he got.

That's you all's God. That's the God of Christianity. Now that's not my God. Because the God I serve is sovereign. And the God I serve has an overarching plan. Notice that word: *overarching*. There is an overarching plan. And there is no battle against Satan and our God. There is no war for the souls of men. The reason people think this, they misjudge God, Yahweh, by his unfinished work. I want you to listen carefully.

The most dangerous message in Christianity today...are you ready for it? Now this is the most popular message. And yet the most dangerous message. It's called "the finished work of the cross". And it's preached by the greatest preachers in the world. The Finished Work of the Cross. Brothers and sisters, listen to me. That is why people do not serve your God. Because if that was his ultimate plan, if

he finished the work and the plan at the cross, look around. Is the world better today or worse today than it was at the time of the cross?

So if the finished work of the cross was the finished...according to Christianity, that was the end of the plan. The finished work of the cross is one of the greatest deceptions in the Christian genre today. Because that's why people judge your God wrong. They see that as his finished work. And brothers and sisters, it's been a colossal failure if that is his finished work. Nothing was finished at the cross except for the suffering of Christ and the requirement of the Passover lamb.

So, people now look at your God and they ask these questions. *How can you worship a God who allows children to be sex-trafficked? How can you worship a God who allows world wars? What kind of God allows this? Where is God?* That's what your atheist friends, your friends want to know. Where is your God? And unless you know the plan you cannot answer those questions because to you it was all finished at Mt. Calvary. Now we're just trying to get a few folks saved, put them on the first midnight train to Georgia, get them out of here, and then let the devil have it all.

That is the Christian message! No wonder nobody wants to serve your God! What a weak, effeminate God do you serve that he does not have a plan for all of this? I mean folks, listen, things are so bad in our world right now—yesterday I read a news article that at the United Nations Convention, just yesterday, they had three robots there. They looked just like humans. And these robots made an announcement to the United Nations Assembly, and said these words: *We can govern your planet better than human leaders.*

Now folks this is not made-up stuff. I've got the article on my timeline, you can go read it. They said "we can govern your plant better than humans because we have no emotions. We make decisions based on data". But then they made a promise to the world leaders. Do you know what these robots promised these world leaders? That at this time, they would not seek to overtake our planet! That's right. At this time, they will not seek to overtake human government.

They're not programmed yet. But see what happens with AI—AI starts learning more than you taught them. These robots begin learning from one another. We are living in a time to where if you don't know this plan I'm teaching you, you'll be above all men most miserable. Do you know why suicide is so high? Why everybody you know are on drugs? They don't think there's a plan. There's no hope in the world because the Christian message does not give hope.

The Christian message says...we know everything's a mess, but it gets even worse. Guess what happens after you die, you get to burn as long as Yahweh lives,

hallelujah! Enjoy it while you can because it's almost over. Well let's see—we got hell in this life, we got hell in the next life—unless—unless you are lucky enough for somebody to reach you with the gospel, ok? So this God we love created a plan for you to be saved from hell, but the only problem with that plan is this. You've got to get lucky enough for somebody to find you in the remote jungles of Africa and tell you the gospel.

So we've got a plan to get everybody saved as long as everybody hears about it. What about the billions that died that never heard? I'm mean really folks? And you wonder why people won't serve your God? He's not even fair. He's not even like your own father. No wonder they allow their own fathers to molest them, abuse them—your heavenly Fathers' going to do the same thing to them.

If you don't learn this plan, you have no hope for mankind. I want you to think about everybody that lives in your town. Do you know that according to Christian doctrine they're all going to hell except for maybe 8 or 9 of them who got lucky enough? Folks that's not the gospel. That's called Christianity.

The plan I'm talking about today needs no human support. Look the plan is working. I'm going to tell you a story. In Madrid Spain, there is a palace there called the El Escorial. There's an interesting story about this palace I want to tell you about. It's one of the greatest cathedrals ever built by man. For centuries all the kings and queens of Spain were buried in the Escorial cathedral. It's one of the most magnificent structures. When it was under construction, the architect designed a huge archway to go over the throne room area where the kings would sit.

He built this huge arch, very huge. It's one of the biggest arches ever built. But the arch was flat, and the king was so scared that that arch was going to fall that he demanded that the architect build a column under the arch. This is important for you to hear. He wanted them to build a column under the arch to support this huge arch because he didn't want it falling on him while he was sitting on his throne. This is a true story, you can go look at it today in Spain. The artist and the architect begged the king...please don't make me ruin this beautiful arch by putting a support column up. It will hold up, I promise.

But the king demanded that he put an arch there. So after crying a lot of tears, the architect obeyed the king. He built a column under the arch. And when the king saw the column he was so happy. He was so pleased that he went and sat on his throne, and now he could sit there with confidence since he had that human support system to hold it up.

But there's one problem. The arch and the column under it, the architect left about an inch of space so that the arch doesn't even touch the column. And he left that column there until the king died. And when the king died, they moved the column and he showed them that it was never connected to the arch, and the arch never moved, it never failed.

I said all that to say this. There is an *overarching plan* of Yahweh. And it needs no human support system. It doesn't need you to figure it out. IT NEEDS YOU TO TRUST IN THE PLAN! You don't have to understand the plan, but you better celebrate the plan and you better trust in that plan. That column stands today in Spain. If you ever get to go to Spain, go over there and see it. They've got a piece of wood between the column and the archway so you can see that it never touched.

So if there is a plan, what is our duty to that plan? Trust it. And secondly, celebrate the plan as much as you celebrate the Planner. Amen. I'm going to say it one more time. Many of you are lifting up your hands worshipping a God without a plan. I tell you...learn to celebrate the plan and you are celebrating the Planner. Yesterday, when my wife and I were celebrating those Teton mountains, we began to sing to Yahweh. We began to sing as we watched old faithful shoot up. We began to worship. We were worshipping the plan. We were looking at perfection, but by admiring the plan, we were admiring the Planner.

The problem we have in the church today, many of you have celebrated the Planner, but not the plan. And how do I know that? Because anyone who is not celebrating the holy days is not celebrating the plan! Amen. Amen. The plan is in the holy days. The plan is in the holy festivals. I'm not talking about just acknowledging them. I said celebrate them. Do you know why when you come to these holy festivals we have you dancing until you can't even walk anymore? Because it's worth celebrating the continual plans of Yahweh.

These are the rehearsals of the overarching plan. And what does that plan end with? The Last Great Day. And there in the Last Great Day answers all the questions about all these people that have lived without hearing the gospel. Folks listen to me! This is why Satan took the Holy Days from the church. This is why he gave you Christmas and Easter. Because there's nothing in those that demonstrate the plan. But when you convert to holy day celebration, you now become partakers of the plan!! Oh hallelujah. And then all your worries go away!

It truly is the plan of the ages! When you celebrate feast days, you cannot worry about anything! Why? Because you know there's a plan, that this world is not chaotic, robots are not about to take over, world war three's not about to destroy us. It's all part of the plan. We're not worried about the rabbit holes. No, no, no.

Because we live under the shadow of the wings, we don't live in rabbit holes. We don't worry if we run out of food, we plan according, but we don't stress over it, we don't worry about what's going to happen tomorrow, we have a planner that we worship and that plan has got me in mind! Oh hallelujah! Oh yeah, he destroyed Egypt, but he protected Israel. You better learn this plan brothers and sisters, or you'll be like a chicken with it's head cut off, running around in circles.

Let's read about this plan. Isaiah 14:24-27. I want you to highlight these verses in your Bible, and anytime your life is in a mess, anytime you don't know how you're going to make it till tomorrow, anytime you can't figure life out—and I've been there, my God, what a hard life I've had—but these verses will bring you back to your right mind.

Isaiah 14:24-27

24 Yahweh of hosts hath sworn, saying, Surely as I have thought, so shall it come to pass...

So shall it come to pass. As I have what? Thought. What is a thought? The plan. What makes up the plan? The thoughts. As I have planned. Nothing's going to deviate that plan.

...and as I have purposed, so shall it stand.

What's the difference in the plan and the purpose? Let me show you. The purpose is the end goal. The plan is "how do we get there?" Now the church likes to preach on the end goal—we all go to heaven, but they know nothing of the plan. God has two things. Plans and purposes. My purpose is to build a feast site for all of you to come to. That's the purpose of that land. What good is that purpose without a plan? No good. Now we're getting somewhere.

Yahweh has a purpose to redeem all mankind. But to do that he needs a plan. That plan is only known by the Israelites. Not the Jews, but the Israelites.

25 That I will break the Assyrian in my land, and upon my mountains tread him under foot:

You see, that's the purpose. The purpose is to get rid of Satan. The purpose is to get evil off the earth. That's the purpose, but not the plan.

...then shall his yoke depart from off them, and his burden depart from off their shoulders.

26 This is the purpose that is purposed upon the whole earth:

This is the purpose. Now listen. He said Assyrian, but remember what I taught you many times. What has been will be again. This is the purpose. The Assyrians are the *shadow*. Remember, everything in the Old Testament is for our learning, for our understanding of the future.

What is the purpose? Read the purpose of those Assyrians one more time. What does he plan to do with the enemies of Yahweh's people? Break them, upon my mountains tread them underfoot. On my mountain. Who is my mountain? The government. What did Paul say? You will tread, you will put Satan under *your* feet. Not Yahweh's feet. Not Yahshua's feet. But my mountain will tread down my enemies. But I've got to have a plan to get my mountain ready for destroying these "Assyrians"! Hallelujah. Oh my Lord I wish you all could get it.

Then will his yoke depart. Then, then, then. Then his burden depart. Do you remember when I was talking about robots taking over? We were talking about your children on drugs, how could God allow this evil and all. But I'm reading about a point in time when that burden's going to be lifted off the shoulders of the entire world! Hallelujah!

THE BURDEN'S GOING TO BE REMOVED FROM MY PEOPLE SO THEY CAN REMOVE IT FROM THE WHOLE WORLD !!!

That's the purposes of God! Joy comes when? In the morning. When these Assyrians have been broken. Oh hallelujah.

This is the purpose that's purposed upon the whole earth. Hold on now. I thought it was just Israel. Oh no. It's starts with Israel. But the purpose is to do what? To remove the drug addiction from just Israel? Did you say the whole earth? Did you say this burden is going to be removed from all human beings on planet earth?

And yet you've never heard that preached in your church unless First Harvest is your church. Because the church knows nothing about this purpose of God. The purpose is not to get you to heaven. The purpose is to remove the burden off the whole world! The burden that they're all under.

...and this is the hand that is stretched out upon all the nations.

**27 For Yahweh of hosts has purposed, and who shall disannul it?
and his hand is stretched out, and who shall turn it back?**

Who plans to annul this plan. Did you think Satan could? The plan is the whole world and that's what I just read. Didn't I just read that? Isn't that what it says—to remove the burden from the whole world? That's the purpose.

Now there needs to be a plan to bring that purpose to pass. The plan is the first harvest. The plan is being worked on right now. So that's why I don't even listen to people when they tell me I serve a wicked God, a God that's lost control. That's called "the finished work of the cross" message. But we believe in "the finished work of the plan" message here! There is a plan and it's coming in the morning!

Joy comes in the morning !!!

Don't you worry about your night season! Joy comes in the morning! And I thank God that we're walking more and more into the perfect day where we will see the light of that morning! Oh hallelujah.

Isaiah 46:9-11

9 Remember the former things of old: for I am Yahweh, and there is none else; I am Yahweh, and there is none like me,

10 Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times the things that are not yet done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will do all my pleasure:

11 Calling a ravenous bird from the east, the man that executes my counsel from a far country: yea, I have spoken it, I will also bring it to pass; I have purposed it, I will also do it.

He said I purposed it and I will do what? I will do the purpose through the plan. The plan is in the Mazzaroth. That's why we taught you on the Mazzaroth the very first few weeks in these studies. Because the plan he's purposed to do is in the Mazzaroth. It ends with Leo the Lion.

Those of you that's just joined us, if you don't know that plan, and what is the Mazzaroth, go to firstharvest.tv/video/1937 for part one of the series, and watch the whole series. Because he said that whatever I put in the plan, I don't care how chaotic it looks, I don't care how bad it gets, I will do that purpose. Hallelujah. I'm glad I serve that kind of God. I'm glad I can trust in him. I'm glad I don't have to worry, I'm glad I don't have to sit around and say...what's going to happen. I just trust that arch, hallelujah. I don't need a column under it, oh no. I just trust that arch.

Now I want you to remember something. Yahweh's plan is like a blueprint. If you're going to build a hotel building, that plan is made up of many parts, many different floors. However, from now on I want you to change the word "floors" in the plan to the word "ages". The building that Yahweh is building is made up of different ages. You're going to learn a lot in the next few weeks about these different ages and how they all work.

I'm going to give you a homework assignment. I want everyone of you to read Psalms 72:1-20. I'm not going to read it today, but as you read it I believe it's going to speak to you. Now all of you sitting at your table in your house is a book called the Bible. In that book God reveals the plan of the ages to get to the purpose. It unfolds over different ages of time.

Now the Christian church that we grew up in as we know it has been living in a fool's paradise with their pet doctrines, ranting and raving about an endless eternity with golden streets and harps and white nightgowns we're supposed to be walking around in. For some, they talk about the crackling, searing, tormenting flames of hell. Yet every one of those, whether it's heaven or hell—both paradigms have totally overlooked the plan.

They see a verse here and a verse there that alludes to hell, and alludes to heaven, and they think that's the purpose. So therefore, they don't know the plan. But when you know that the purpose is the restoration of all things, all of a sudden the plan becomes important. Let me ask you this: If the purpose is to send people to hell or send people to heaven, you don't really need a plan for that do you? Hello? You don't really need a plan for that do you? You're just either going to hell or going to heaven.

But if you've got a purpose to redeem mankind, to restore all things, to lift the burden off the whole world—you're going to need a plan for that. That plan included two entities. Yahshua and then you. And until you find your place in that plan, you will live your life backsliding every year, jumping from church to church, Zoom group to Zoom group, looking for more knowledge. The problem that you're having is too much knowledge without knowing the plan. You've got to know this plan.

You have found truth. You don't need to jump to another Zoom group. You have found the truth. I say that without reservation. Folks, we're teaching you the plan here, and your place in that plan. Amen.

Eternity. Now next week I'm going to start teaching about eternity, that word eternal and the meaning of eternity. Sometimes eternity is not what you think it

is. We'll go into that next week, not this week. Let's read Ephesians 3:8-11 and then we're going to get into some deep Bible study right after that.

Ephesian 3:8-11

8 Unto me, who am less than the least of all saints, is this grace given, that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ;

I want you to notice what he said. I must preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ. That one verse has destroyed modern Christian thinking.

9 And to make all men see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world (age) has been hid in Yahweh, who created all things by Yahshua Messiah:

10 To the intent that now unto the principalities and powers in heavenly places might be known by the church the manifold wisdom of Yahweh,

Listen. Go back now. There has been a plan that has been hidden from the whole world. Not even the prophets knew the plan. Do you know Isaiah didn't know the plan? He knew the purpose because he prophesied about that great Sabbath day. He prophesied about the day of the Lord. They knew the purpose but not the plan. The apostle Paul is here saying in our day the plan has been revealed.

11 According to the eternal purpose...

The plan matches up with the purpose. Come on now! The plan will lead you to the purpose! And I believe that Paul told you that purpose in the very first line when he said *all men*. Read that verse one more time (9) and tell me if you don't see the word *all men* in that plan. ALL MEN. That's the plan. That's the purpose. The plan matches up with the purpose. From the beginning of the age it was hidden in the previous "floors" of this building.

Listen, help me Holy Ghost. When he began building the "purpose" there were buildings. The first floor, the second floor. In those floors, the plan was not known. But on the 4th floor, Yahshua came on the 4th day, we start now revealing the plan to get us to the 7th floor, which is the last floor of this building.

The purpose is the 7th floor. If you come in on the first, second or third floor, it looks like chaos. When you get to the 4th floor, now only a small group of the management team is given the rest of the plan to get to the 6th floor. That

management team is called the 144,000. Read as Paul will tell you who the plan is being revealed to right now before it's being revealed to all men. Keep reading in verse 10.

This plan might be known by who? The church. The House of Israel. When we get to the 4th floor, now Yahweh reveals the plan to the management team that's going to help him build floor 4, floor 5, and floor 6. That's why we're called coworkers with Christ, joint heirs. Because remember brothers and sisters, when Yahshua left the earth, he didn't leave the earth. Come on now.

He left his "body". If his body stayed here, he never left! He left his body. Literally he left his body on the earth to build the building with Yahweh. Lord have mercy! That's why when people tell me the fullness of the Godhead is in Christ, I tell them they're crazy. Because it doesn't say that. It said that the fullness of the Godhead is in Christ BODILY! It's not in the head, it's in the body. The fullness of God is in the body!

Listen to me! The fullness of Yahweh—it's in the body of Christ. Christ was the first of the firstfruit. Christ was the head of the body. The fullness of Yahweh is in you brother and sister, in his body connected together into one body. Whatever's in the head is in the body.

That's why the Bible said to pluck out the body and get rid of those who don't want to join with it. The apostle built floor number 4, and then our forefathers built floor number 5. You and I are finishing up floor number 6 right now. And the closer we get to the 7th floor is where the management sits. Remember when you go through a building, where does all the upper echelon sit? Their offices are on the top floor. Management sits up there and we're building up to there.

Listen. Yahweh is building this thing with your help! But Yahweh, if we're helping build it, we need you to tell us a little bit more of the plan. He says ok...the path of the just is like the noon day sun that shines more and more and more into the perfect day—you want more? Ask for more. If you want me to give you more, love what I already gave you. Obey it. Live by it and I'll even give you more so we can build this thing together. Oh hallelujah.

I want to tell all of you something. Your walk with God will end the moment he reveals a truth to you and you consider it as nothing. My dear darling friends, I'm sorry if you thought when you started keeping the Sabbath day that you had found truth. I'm so sorry that you thought you had arrived when you caught the Sabbath day. I'm so sorry to tell you that was a trap door for you to walk through. I'm so sorry to tell you that was the beginning of the rest of your life. The total transformation begins at the door of the Sabbath. That's why you can't go join a

Seventh Day Adventist church. They have the Sabbath as well. But they stopped at the Sabbath.

You can't stand still or you're sitting in darkness if you're not walking in the light. I hope when I'm dead and gone that's one thing you'll always remember—pastor said if you're not walking in the light, you're sitting in darkness. And even the light may have been there yesterday, it's not there today.

Listen folks. There's a reason that some of you have tried to even leave this ministry and go hop on another Zoom and you're back. Let me tell you why. We don't deal in all doctrine here, ok? Doctrine is not what all we're trying to teach. We're trying to make all doctrine line up into a plan. A plan that you can have confidence in. We don't want you to learn that the pope replaced the Sabbath day. A child can know that. Come on. But thank God we know that. I'm not belittling it.

But for those of you who are stuck at the Sabbath, we're waving bye to you. We didn't forsake the Sabbath. We still keep it. But my Lord, we're moving on even further and further and further. Some folks don't want to go. But I do. I want everything Yahweh has for me.

11 According to the eternal purpose which he purposed in Messiah Yahshua our Lord.

Ok, so go back to verse 8 that we were just at and read until you find that word Gentiles.

8 Unto me, who am less than the least of all saints, is this grace given, that I should preach among the Gentiles...

Alright I want to stop right there. Now ladies and gentlemen, we're going to go into a deep Bible study here. The first thing you've got to learn when learning the plan is that you've got to learn what a Gentile is. And no you don't know. Some of you do, but the majority of Christianity does not know what a Gentile is. I'll prove it to you.

Let me find somebody that looks smart. Unmute yourself brother. *Anybody that's not an Israelite would be a Gentile.* Ok, now that's about 75% truth right there. Let's go back brother, what's your religious background? *Baptist.* Ok. Growing up as a Baptist, tell me if you were taught this. Correct me if you weren't. Were you taught that there's basically two groups of people in God's plan—the Jew and the Gentile? Would that be fair? Yes. Ok.

Now according to the Baptist tradition, if you were not a Jew, you were a Gentile. What that meant was that you were not part of the covenant of the Jewish people. Would that be correct? Yes. Ok, alright. Thank you. You can mute yourself.

Now I want to explain to you today what a Gentile is and what it's not. Before we do that, let's go to the book of Genesis 12. Everybody needs to know that the whole story of your Bible really does not begin until Genesis chapter 12. That's really where the story of the Bible begins. Anything before Genesis chapter 12 is just background noise if you will. How many of you've ever been to live theatre? When you go to a live theatre, you have what's called props, you have backgrounds right? But the show is not about the background is it? Normally it's about a main character, correct?

When you go to a theatre, you see these backgrounds that add to the story, but the story's not about the background. Everything about Genesis chapter 1 to chapter 12 is painted in broad strokes. It's just the background to get you to the main character of the whole Bible. You already know who I'm talking about. Abraham ok?

Why do you think Genesis chapter 1 doesn't give you a more detailed account of creation? Because the Bible wasn't supposed to be about creation. Does anybody understand what I'm trying to say? It wasn't a science book. It wasn't to tell you how this organism did this or that. That's not the point. You're getting caught up in the minutia. You're getting caught up in the details that don't even matter. We believe all that by faith.

Yahweh through Moses wrote Genesis 1 through 12 as a quick note. Why do you think when we get to Genesis 6 and you read about those angels sleeping with women and it just seems to go right on with no explanation, and you're like...wait, what? I mean, come on Moses, details please! Well those details come in the book of Enoch which I'll begin teaching you after this series.

But anyway, Genesis 12 is where the story of the Bible begins. We're going to start there so you can understand the plan. Genesis 12:1-3 to begin.

Genesis 12:1-3

1 Now Yahweh had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee,

I want you to listen. I really want to talk to my church right now. Every one of you, your whole life was the background to get you to this point where he calls you out from your family, from your friends. Oh hallelujah! The story of Abraham

will be your story. The child abuse I went through, the divorce, everything in my background was “Genesis 1-12” if that makes sense to you. It was not even important to the story. Ohhh no, because there came a point in my life when he called me out of the background. Oh hallelujah. There came a point when he will say to you NOW it’s time for you to come out, and I’m going to call you unto myself.

At that moment in your life, everything else is your background, it’s not your story. That’s why you don’t need to give too many details to people when they want to know about your background. Hallelujah. The details. I’ll give you the details—here’s the details. One day I was caught up in my background, and one day I heard a voice like Abraham did...saying I want you to leave all of that and follow after me, hallelujah! That’s where your life started. That’s where your story starts, the same place that Abraham started.

Now that call you may or may not answer. You may love your family more than you love God. If you do, that’s ok, it’s a false god and you’ll be dealt with in the judgment for it. There are some of you that have false gods living in your house—it’s called your children—they are your gods. Did you know that for many of you your life is consumed with your children and making sure they have enough activities to keep them happy, to make sure they go to the church of their choice, to make sure that they have enough programs to keep all their little wimpy behinds from bothering you, make sure they go to the right church, that they’ve got a good youth program for your kids—instead of you saying “I don’t care, me and my house are going to follow truth”. Your children are your gods and you are worshipping them instead of truth. If you don’t believe me, wait till Christmastime. You don’t want to upset your children, but you don’t mind upsetting your God.

It’s false gods. One day—choose ye this day. Choose! Sister, there’s going to come a time when you’ve just got to say...it’s as simple as this...I choose truth! I love my family. I love my friends. But as for me and my house. We love you...but as for me and my four, it’s the way we do things. God first. And folks, you’ve got to come to this point in your life where you’ve got to love truth more than your husband, more than your wife—their feelings cannot matter to you. You have to stand for truth. If not, you’re not fit to govern—you will not be in the government I promise you.

Now, I want you, if you’re taking notes, to write down the following promises that Yahweh makes to Abraham. Why am I going to Abraham? I thought we were talking about the plan. Well the plan starts with Abraham. If you want to know the end you need to go to the beginning. And that’s where we’re at today, at the very beginning of the plan. I’m going to show you in a few minutes where the

Christian church messes up the plan. Let's read about the promises Yahweh gave to Abraham, verses 2 and 3.

2 And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing,

3 And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curses thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed.

Promise #1

I will make of you a great nation. I will make you one, single, great nation.

Promise #2

I will bless you.

Promise #3

I will make your name great.

Promise #4

All families of the earth will be blessed because of Abraham.

Now, once God called Abraham out of Ur, which is modern-day Turkey, then Abraham settled in the land of Canaan. Why was it called the land of Canaan? Because it's where the Canaanites lived. But I want you to notice two more promises that Yahweh made to Abraham. We'll find those promises in Genesis 13:14-16.

Now once we're done with all these promises, you've got to look back on them in your notes, and I'm going to ask you a pivotal question about these promises. And Yahweh continues to make promises to Abraham.

Genesis 13:14-16

14 And Yahweh said unto Abram, after that Lot was separated from him, Lift up now thine eyes, and look from the place where thou art...

Where was Abraham when Yahweh makes this promise to him? He's in the land of Canaan. Now the first promise was that he'd give him Canaan land. And that's where Abraham is standing right now, in Canaan. And now Yahweh is going to give additional promises to Abraham. Listen to what he says: *Now lift up your eyes beyond the land of Palestine, if you will. Lift up your eyes beyond the land of Canaan. Lift up your eyes and look.*

...northward, and southward, and eastward, and westward,

He's in Canaan. You were taught in the Christian church that Abraham was given the promise land, which is Palestine where Jerusalem is today. But that's not all the promises given to Abraham. He said look north, south, east and west.

15 For all the land which you see, to you will I give it, and to your seed for ever.

To your seed. Somebody say *sperma*—your offspring, your natural descendants. *I will give all the land, north, south, east and west.* And folks he did because the Muslims are his natural seed as well. Come on now. But keep reading.

16 And I will make thy seed as the dust of the earth: so that if a man can number the dust of the earth, then shall thy seed also be numbered.

Brother Vaughn, he's talking about the Jewish people. No, you can number the Jewish people. You can number the Jews folks. You can number them right now. But according to this promise, his descendants were going to cover the whole earth, and there would be so many of us that you couldn't even count us. That's the promises the Christian church forgot about.

Now in chapter 12, he promises them what? Canaan land, a great nation—one singular great nation. But over here all the families of the earth would be blessed. Now, I want you to look at those promises that you just wrote down. I want you to look at them. I want you to answer one question. Do those promises line up with the condition of the Jewish people? No. Have all the families of the earth been blessed? Have they become a great nation? Have they continued as the sand of the sea—north, south, east and west? Go read Genesis 12:4-6. We've got more promises. Go ahead and write these promises down also.

Genesis 12:4-6

4 So Abram departed, as Yahweh had spoken unto him; and Lot went with him: and Abram was seventy and five years old when he departed out of Haran.

So Abraham has left. Keep reading.

5 And Abram took Sarai his wife, and Lot his brother's son, and all their substance that they had gathered, and the souls that they had gotten in Haran; and they went forth to go into the land of Canaan; and into the land of Canaan they came.

Oh really? So when I was telling you a while ago he was already in Canaan in chapter 13, and some of you was like...I don't know about that. Here's your Bible proof that the minute Yahweh called him out of Ur, he went straight to Canaan land. Read verse 6.

6 And Abram passed through the land unto the place of Sichem, unto the plain of Moreh. And the Canaanite was then in the land.

The who? The Canaanite. So where is Abraham standing? In Canaan! This is what you and I so lovingly refer to as The Land. We love the land! I do too, don't get me wrong. But I have to teach you the truth. While Abraham is standing in that little area called Palestine now, Yahweh says, and we already read it... *Now lift up your eyes Abraham.* Amen. Because this little area of Palestine is not my PLAN.

And yet the whole Christian church, John Hagee and all of them, I love them—but their focus is on the land! Yahweh told Abraham to get his eyes off of the land, and look north, south, east and west! Whew—who...hallelujah! You all, we've got this thing backwards.

Alright, they possessed the land of Canaan, they did that. What do you think that battle was for where Melchizedek paid tithes? Abraham paid tithes to Melchizedek. They defeated them, they took Canaan land. *But Abraham, this is not my plan. This is the beginning of my plan.* Oh hallelujah.

Genesis 22:17

That in blessing I will bless thee, and in multiplying I will multiply thy seed as the stars of the heaven, and as the sand which is upon the sea shore; and thy seed shall possess the gate of his enemies.

So here we have two more promises—that his descendants will be like the stars of the heaven there will be so many of them. I'm sorry, does that sound like the Jewish nation to you? Here's another promise. They will possess the gates of their enemies. Has the Jewish nation ever possessed the gates of their enemies? Never. They've been defeated everywhere they go. They've been taken in by every military in the world—Assyria, Babylon, on and on and on.

Possessing the gates of your enemy is a euphemism for having military power greater than all your neighbors! Listen folks, don't get me wrong. The Jewish nation has a part in this plan. But the problem with the Christian church is they've made that the whole plan—if we could all get back to the land—I'm in the land today—I live in Mississippi. I'm in the land, hallelujah. A land where no man dwelt before—the great United States of America, end-time Israel. That's why I love America. I love the land, hallelujah. I live in the Jer-USA-lem. Hallelujah.

Let's go over the promises we have so far.

Promise #1: He would become a great nation.

Promise #2: All the families of the earth would be blessed because of him.

Promise #3: They would possess the land of Canaan.

Promise #4: Their physical descendants would be many people.

Let's go to Genesis 17:4. Whenever you think of Abraham, you think of the Jewish people, maybe the Muslim people because they both came from him.

Genesis 17:4

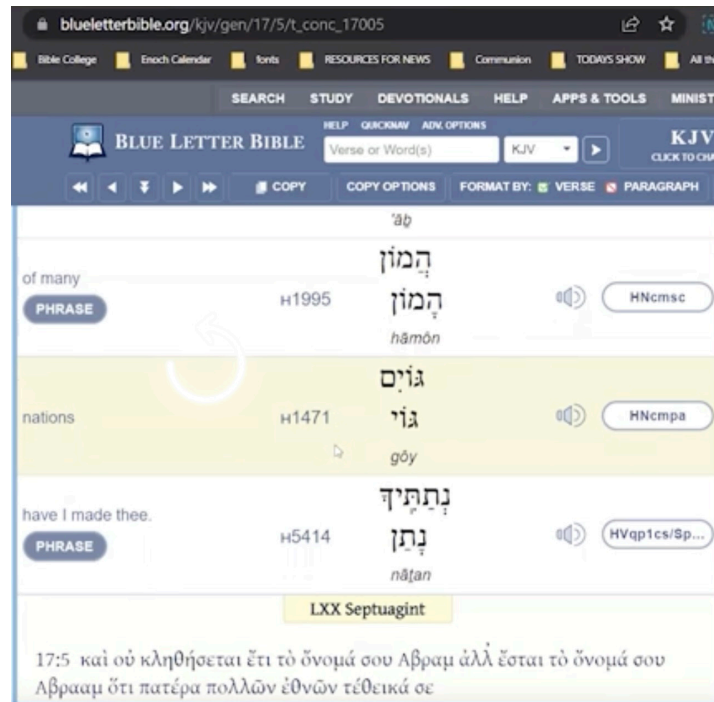
As for me, behold, my covenant is with thee, and thou shalt be a father of many nations.

You shall be a father of what? Many nations. Wow, wow, wow. I thought he was the father of the Jewish people. I thought he was the father of Israel. But he has a promise that the Christian church never talks about. Now they try to spiritualize that which we're going to cut that head off today. They try to spiritualize that—*you know we've all become the seed of Abraham*. No we haven't. Only the lost tribes have and I'll get to that later.

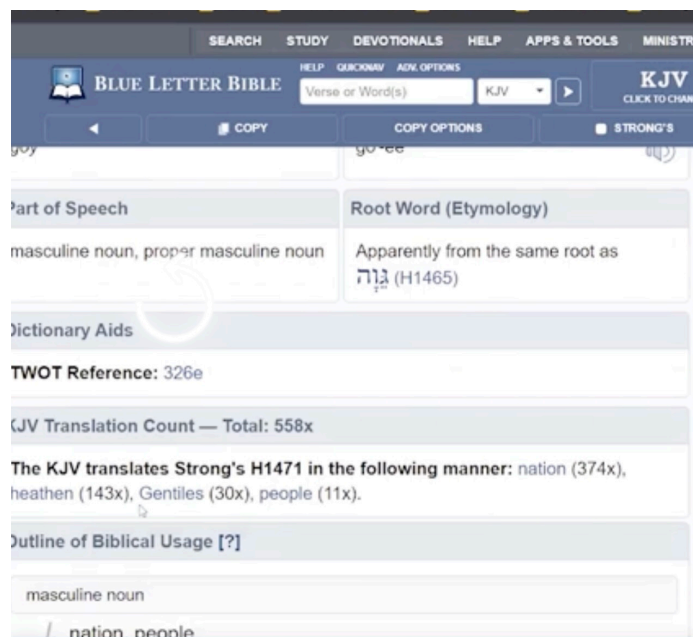
There will be many physical nations that Abraham will be the father of. We know he's the father of the nation of Judah, Jerusalem. Nobody denies that. We know he's the father of the Muslims. But that scripture promised many nations, not two. MANY NATIONS. This is the part about Abraham that people forget—that he will be the father. Do you know what the father is? The progenitor, the seed. You are not a nation unless you came from the *seed line* of the progenitor of that nation. Now this is what Abraham is—the father of many of these nations.

Now I want to continue and let's talk about this word nations. Abraham is promised to be the father of many nations. Let's look up that word nations in Genesis 17:5. I'm going to look it up and share it on the screen for you. Let me show you how to get past Christianity's conundrums if we can. Now this is where you need to learn to study your Bible.

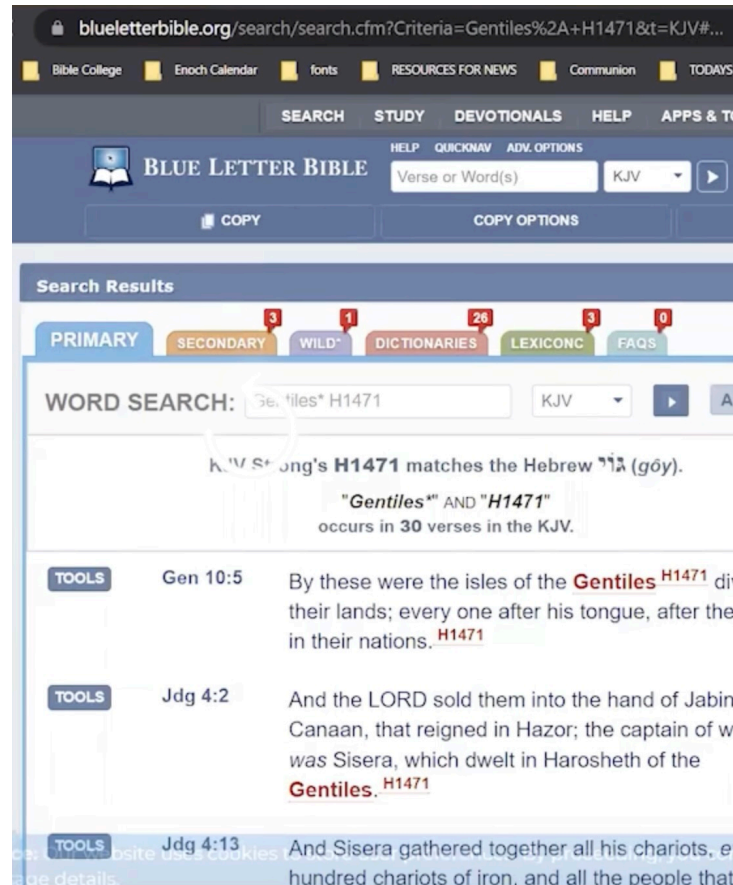

The Hebrew word for nations is *Goy*. Let's look up the word *goy*. Now for some reason it's translated as *nations* by the translators. But guess what else it could be translated as. *Gentiles*.



Abraham will be the father of many Gentiles. Mistakenly known as Gentiles. Oh hallelujah, we're about to get somewhere. The word goy has been translated 30 times.



Genesis 10:5. "By these were the isles of the **Gentiles**." Why did they translate it Gentiles there? Ladies and gentlemen, you're going to find out today that Abraham is the father of who you were mistakenly calling Gentiles. And that's why Paul had to go to the Gentiles—he was going to the **Goy!!** Who you're calling Gentiles are the nations that Abraham is the physical father of, and that's why Paul had to go to the Gentiles, or the nations, because they were also THE PHYSICAL DESCENDANTS OF ABRAHAM!

But in our mind Gentiles are not the children of Abraham. Is anybody with me? How many of you thought Gentiles are not the children of Abraham physically? Now you were taught they could become the seed of Abraham spiritually, but not physically. This one here is going to require you to know that the word "Gentile" in the New Testament is very misleading, and that's why Christian churches will tell you... *yeah but Paul was sent to the Gentiles*. No, he was sent to the "nations"

because among the nations were the physical Gentiles (goy) of Abraham because Abraham would be the father of many Goy.

Abraham would be the physical father of many
nations that are not Jewish.

In the American Dictionary of English Language, the word nation, the etymology of that word denotes “a family or race of man descended from a common progenitor”. You will be the father of many *Gentiles*. Somebody say the physical father, the progenitor. Quit trying to over-spiritualize this. *Oh yeah, I know we’re all the seed of Abraham because of Christ.* No. You were already the seed of Abraham and you were identified as such because of Christ. Oh my, my, my, my, my.

You could use the word “tribe”. You’ll be the father of many tribes. But the New Testament translators took that word “the father of many tribes” and changed it to Gentiles, and then your Christian preachers convinced you that meant anything that’s not the children of Abraham to keep us out of the plan and the plan out of us as well. Read Genesis 17:7 and tell me if Yahweh makes a covenant with the physical descendants of Abraham.

Genesis 17:7

And I will establish my covenant between me and thee and thy seed after thee in their generations for an everlasting covenant, to be a God unto thee, and to thy seed after thee.

Thy seed. The covenant of this many lands that I’m going to give you possessing the gates of your enemies, military strength. That covenant, of all the families of the earth being blessed, I’m making with your physical offspring. And now ladies and gentlemen, you’ll know why Paul had to go to the Gentiles. Because Abraham’s children were there, and they were called Gentiles, but they were *physically* the children of Abraham. And Yahshua came only to seek and save the lost sheep of the House of Israel.

If you are saved today and in this Zoom class, it’s because, just like Paul found them, someone found you. You were already the physical seed of Abraham or you could not have responded to the Covenant! You are children of the Covenant. You knew. And the Sabbath is the *sign* of the Covenant. That’s the seal of this Covenant.

Now most people believe the Gentiles are the nations besides the children of Abraham. Let’s imagine that Genesis 17:4 is read like this: I will make you the

father of many Gentiles. Why couldn't it have been translated that way? Because it would have messed up the whole Christian teaching. Do I have anybody smart here? Go look at Genesis 17:4. Take the word nations out because I've already proven to you, it's on your screen, is it not? Nations is *goy*.

I will make you the father of many *goy*. Now read Genesis 17:4 and take the word *goy* and translate it as *Gentiles* and tell me what the Bible says Abraham will be.

Genesis 17:4

As for me, behold, my covenant is with thee, and thou shalt be a father of many Gentiles.

Wow! How can that be? Gentiles are not the children of Abraham (supposedly)! That's what they want us to think. That way, when you start keeping the Sabbath, they can say... *but you're a Gentile*. Bunch of dummies. Like that's some magic wand to get you out of covenant requirements. *Sister, you're a gentle, that's not for you!* They don't believe you're a child of Abraham sister. They don't believe that you belong to Abraham.

I want to show you the word "covenant". Let's go to Psalms 105:8-9. And folks I'm running out of time—we're going to run through this.

Psalms 105:8-9



8 He hath remembered his covenant for ever, the word which he commanded to a thousand generations.

The covenant is to a thousand physical sperm descendants of Abraham. You listen to me everybody! The covenant is not for anyone that's not a descendant of Abraham. So if you tell me you're a New Covenant Christian, this covenant is to a thousand generations. You can't be in the New Covenant and not be a child of Abraham. It's impossible.

9 Which covenant he made with Abraham, and his oath unto Isaac.

Now notice, listen. Who does the covenant transfer to? Isaac. That's why the Muslims are not in the covenant. Because the Muslims comes from Ishmael the wild donkey. They are not covenant children. That's why the gospel does not affect them. Do you now know why they're Muslim? Come on now. They can't receive this gospel — unless, unless, unless — somewhere down the line the seed line of Isaac has crossed into them, and they've come through the lost tribes, and somewhere that seed line has found them and mixed in with them. But, ladies and gentlemen, the Muslims are the children of Ishmael. They do not have the covenant.

Now, I want to show you what the word covenant means. I'm going to share my screen with you. Let's look up the word covenant (from blueletterbible.org).

Look at the word covenant. It's *brit*. The word covenant is the Hebrew word brit. In case you ever wondered where "British" comes from. They're covenant people. They are children of the covenant. Ok, so the very throne of Great Britain is a covenant throne. That's why you need to go back and watch all of our teachings on Tracking the Tribes and you'll see that the children of the covenant wound up there. And then Tia Tephi's throne was established over the Israelites.

That covenant passed down to Isaac. And we find that in Genesis 17. I'm not going to read all these scriptures, but let's go to verse 21, and tell me who the covenant goes to?

Genesis 17:21

But my covenant will I establish with Isaac, which Sarah shall bear unto thee at this set time in the next year.

So only those who come through Isaac. Where do you think the word Saxon comes from? It comes from Isaac's sons—Saxons. Only the children of Isaac carry the covenant. What about Ishmael? You'll find that in verse 20.

Genesis 17:20

And as for Ishmael, I have heard thee: Behold, I have blessed him, and will make him fruitful, and will multiply him exceedingly; twelve princes shall he beget, and I will make him a great nation.

And he did. The Muslim nation is a blessed people. They have all the oil, a lot of wealth. They are a blessed nation. Ishmael's children are blessed. But they're not holders of the covenant. When you understand that then you understand several different things. Let's go to Genesis 25. Isaac is the covenant holder. He marries Rebecca. Let's read about something quite interesting with Rebecca.

Genesis 25:22-23

22 And the children struggled together within her; and she said, If it be so, why am I thus? And she went to enquire of Yahweh.

23 And Yahweh said unto her, Two nations are in thy womb...

Listen. Now the covenant went from Abraham to Isaac. Now Rebecca is pregnant with two nations inside of her. Read...

And two manner of people shall be separated from thy bowels...

Two different people will be separated—two nations! And Abraham will be all of their father through Isaac. You'll recognize one nation, but the other nation will be lost. Read...

...and the one people shall be stronger than the other people; and the elder shall serve the younger.

Now this is Jacob and Esau. The elder shall serve the younger. We were the younger. I want to explain how the birthright blessing goes down. Who does it travel down to now? Jacob or Esau? Jacob (the last shall be first). Jacob was the younger. Listen folks, and listen well. Why do you think we, in the United States of America, protect our older brother and feed them and give them money called The Land of Israel? They serve us! Because they don't have the birthright blessing!

What does Judah have? The kingly blessing, the scepter. But they don't have the birthright blessing. It's so hard to teach these things when people are so acclimated to one way of thinking.

We are the children of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. The Jewish people are also. But they are a separate nation. The older will serve the younger. They're a much older nation than we are. But yet they serve the younger because we carry that birthright blessing. God chose it to be that way. Let's go read Genesis 35 and let's see who winds up with the same promises as Abraham.

Genesis 35:9-15

9 And Yahweh appeared unto Jacob again, when he came out of Padanaram, and blessed him.

Now who are we talking to? Yahweh is now about to bless Jacob. He started with Abraham, it went to Isaac, and now the covenant is held by Jacob. You all, it's imperative that you get these things because a few months down the road when I'm still teaching this class, you've got to go back to this to understand that.

10 And God said unto him, Thy name is Jacob: thy name shall not be called any more Jacob, but Israel shall be thy name: and he called his name Israel.

11 And Yahweh said unto him, I am Almighty Yahweh: be fruitful and multiply...

Now hold tight. Before we go any further...*brother Vaughn, what does this have to do with us?* Everything! Because this is Jacob. This is Israel! Do you remember when Israel was dying? And he's ready to pass on this covenant blessing? Oh hallelujah!! Do you remember when Israel was dying and now he's ready to pass this same covenant on? Who did he lay hands on and say...my name be upon them? It was Ephraim and Manasseh !!! It went to the younger!

It went to the tribes that would carry this covenant blessing and that their descendants would cover north, south, east and west. It did not go to the Jewish people! It didn't! If it would have, it would've went to the tribe of Judah. Judah received the scepter, and indeed they gave us the greatest blessing. Yahshua will be that great king that comes from them, but they don't carry the birthright. Who carries it? Whoever the descendants of Ephraim and Manasseh are!

...a nation and a company of nations shall be of thee...

A what? Jacob is promised a nation? And a what? A company of nations. What would you call the United States of America if it's not a company of nations? Are we not a company of 50 sovereign, independent nations that came into agreement to work together in the Compact? And now the elder brother is serving the younger brother Ephraim and Manasseh—we literally have to pay the bills of

Israel, we have to pay for their military, we make sure we gave them their land back. How can you not see the truth! And you're trying to get back to the land!! Hallelujah! You better stand for America. That's why we defend Donald Trump so we can restore this *good land* that Yahweh has given unto us! He crowned our good with brotherhood from sea to shining sea!

You all, I'm sorry, but when I looked at them Teton mountains yesterday, I haven't ever seen anything in the land that looked that beautiful! Yahweh gave us the most beautiful land in all of the world. Oh, my, my, my!

I will make you father Jacob of one great nation...and a COMPANY OF NATIONS! We also gave Jerusalem back to Judah. Do you know who gave the Jewish brethren their land back? It was our brother Great Britain. The Balfour Treaty. Do you know the only reason they have a place today is because their younger brother gave it to them? And now they serve their younger brother! My God from Zion, I can hardly deal with it! Help me Lord, I'm so excited. I've got ten minutes left, ten minutes. Finish these verses before I just lose my mind.

...and kings shall come out of thy loins...

See, those kings will come out of thy loins. Read...

12 And the land which I gave Abraham and Isaac...

Listen, now we're back to Jerusalem, the land ok? Here's a multitude of promises—I'm giving you Canaan land that I gave Abraham. Read...

...to thee I will give it, and to thy seed after thee will I give the land.

13 And Yahweh went up from him in the place where he talked with him.

14 And Jacob set up a pillar in the place where he talked with him....

Isn't that amazing? That right after we get the promise of the British people, now we find the pillar stone, oh my, my, where the promise is now given to Jacob of these company of nations, and it's that same pillar stone that every king of England's been inaugurated on since it's beginning! Folks, you better tie these pieces together. Read about that. Read...

...even a pillar of stone: and he poured a drink offering thereon, and he poured oil thereon.

And he anointed that stone. Read...

15 And Jacob called the name of the place where Yahweh spake with him, Bethel.

Bethel, or the house of Yahweh, or the people of Yahweh. Wherever you find this stone you'll find the House of Yahweh, you'll find the body of Abraham, you'll find the people—wherever you find this stone! He named the stone...The Family. Oh my, my, my. Hallelujah. And I'll give the land to your descendants after you. And I will give it to you.

My, my, I'm out of time. Let me quickly move over now to Exodus 3:6-9. Why did Yahweh love Israel, the people of Israel?

Exodus 3:6-9

6 Moreover he said, I am the God of thy father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. And Moses hid his face; for he was afraid to look upon Yahweh.

7 And Yahweh said, I have surely seen the affliction of my people which are in Egypt and have heard their cry by reason of their taskmasters; for I know their sorrows;

8 And I am come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians, and to bring them up out of that land unto a good land and a large, unto a land flowing with milk and honey; unto the place of the Canaanites, and the Hittites, and the Amorites, and the Perizzites, and the Hivites, and the Jebusites.

9 Now therefore, behold, the cry of the children of Israel is come unto me: and I have also seen the oppression wherewith the Egyptians oppress them.

Now notice this. I'm going to prove to all of you why God loves America. *Brother Vaughn, America is wicked.* You don't know the preachers who inbox me and tell me I'm wrong. *America's Babylon the Great. She's this, she's that.* Listen! You don't understand—so was Israel! Yahweh did not love Israel because of Israel!

He loved her because of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob !!!

You've got to know what I'm telling you right now! Notice what he said. Israel, I have loved you because of Abraham! America, Yahweh doesn't love you because you're great. He remembers a covenant that goes to a thousand generations!

Do you know why Yahweh has blessed me? It's not because of me. I had a little grandma who had a covenant with Yahweh and I'm in her generations. Do you understand that? Do you understand that blessings flow down?

Go to Deuteronomy 4:37. I want you to know why Yahweh loves many of you in spite of yourselves, why he's patient with you, why he's patient with America.

Deuteronomy 4:37
And because he loved your fathers....

Uh oh. Why? Because he loved your fathers. Read...

...therefore he chose their seed after them, and brought thee out in his sight with his mighty power out of Egypt.

Why did Yahweh bring this rebellious people out of Egypt? Because he loved Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. Why has Yahweh blessed America? Because he loves Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, the fathers of the Covenant. Now before I close, Yahweh said just before Yahshua returns—come on now! He will send a voice into your life—the voice of Elijah, and Elijah will turn your hearts back to the Fathers!!! Abraham, Isaac and Jacob !!!

This ministry is not calling you back to the law. We're calling you back to the Fathers! Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. He loved them, therefore, he loves you !!! I've got to go. May Yahweh bless you every one! I'll see you next Sabbath.

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
