

**ISRAEL 101**  
**Part 3**  
**“The Exclusivity of Israel in the New Testament”**

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One day you're going to be listening to me preach (for some of you it's already happened, many of you it has not happened yet). One day you will hear me teach and it will finally register with you that you're an Israelite. Whenever that registers up here and in here, your life is going to change. Everything you understand is going to change once you get it!

I mean, not just saying...*ok now I'm an Israelite*. No, no, no. Believing it. Literally it's a transformation, that's the word for it. You see we do believe in “trans” ha ha! We just believe in transformation ha ha ha! We believe you can literally be changed from an American, from a white man, from a black man, from a red man, from all of that into one new man. We believe there's a new creation and that the new man is an Israelite man, Remnant Israel.

Now, I've started this series because many of you do not comprehend how very special Israel is to Yahweh. Now let me pause, let me clarify again. When I say Israel, I am not referring to that piece of land in Judea. That's not the Israel I'm talking about. Now that land is special to Yahweh, no doubt. But when I use the word Israel, you have to retrain your mind not to go to the middle east in your mind, ok?

You have to know that Israel is a nation far beyond the borders of the promised land. Israel is literally a nation across the world. Primarily you'll find Israel, not exclusively, but primarily, more so in America than you do the land of Israel. You'll find more Israel in Great Britain than you will in the land of Israel. What you will find in the land of Israel is the Jewish people (well some of them are, some of them are not, that's another subject for another day). But you must elevate your thinking outside of the land of Israel.

Whenever you do that, you will no longer be worried about what am I. How many of you, since you've come into this walk, believe a little bit of what the Baptists believe, a little bit of what the Pentecostal believe, a little bit of what the Mormons believe, a little bit of what the Jehovah's Witness believe, a little bit of this, a little bit of that? And your like...*what are we? What am I?* Because we're not Pentecostal, we're not Baptist, we're not Catholic. We are a totally new creation. Once that clicks in your mind, all of a sudden, your rhythm will change—your weekly rhythm, your annual rhythm.

In days gone by, your rhythm was Christmas, Easter, Sunday church, that was your rhythm. But heaven, Yahweh, is operating at a different rhythm. His rhythm is on a totally different schedule. Do you know that Yahweh does not recognize on the heavenly calendar anything that you previously recognized? It's like two dance partners dancing to different beats, it does not line up.

Yahweh has never sanctioned Sunday worship. Now, let me clarify. He has sanctioned Sabbath worship. He has sanctioned Passover, all of the holy days. So when you become an Israelite, you will literally change your rhythm, you will begin dancing to a different tune. As you do it, here's what will happen. The gears will begin to click and all of a sudden you and the Bible will become one. All of a sudden, I mean, it will happen like that.

Whereas in the past you would just read the Bible, when you get into gear, and into rhythm with that perfect gear, all of sudden the Bible will read you. Amen. It literally will. You won't read it anymore, it will read you. And so that only happens when you know that you are an Israelite.

Now last week we spoke about the seed of Abraham. Today we pick up at part 3 and it gets gooder and gooder and gooder today than it did last week. Yes I'm from the south...gooder is a word, ha ha! Alright lets go and explain a few things and then we're going to open the word of God.

The first week of this series I taught you the exclusivity of Israel in the Old Testament. Last week I taught you the seed of Abraham. This week I'm going to teach on the exclusivity of Israel in the New Testament. Here's our job today. Our job is to find out, if as the Christian church teaches, that there was a change in Israel when we go into the New Testament.

How many of you have ever heard that the church replaced natural Israel? Has anybody ever heard that in the Christian church? The Christian church teaches a doctrine and it comes from the Catholic Church. Let me explain it like this. The Catholic Church hated the Jewish people, alright? Antisemitism began in the Catholic Church. That's why the Catholic Church changed the Sabbath day to Sunday. The pope said we want nothing to do with that detestable Jewish practice.

And so the Catholic Church hated anything to do with natural Israel. Now the question is why did they hate them? In their minds, it was the Jews that killed Christ. So if the Jews killed Christ, then we need to hate the Jews and they were the first antisemites in the world. And it still continues to this day.

So the Catholic Church created a doctrine called Replacement Theology. It's the same as Dispensational Theology, so remember those two words. Let me ask someone what Replacement Theology is. Sister, what is Replacement Theology? *They believe that the church replaced Israel.* Amen. It's that simple. Now brother what would you say Dispensational Theology is? It's pretty much the same as Replacement Theology but there are a few more nuances to it. *There are changes in times, dispensations of times, so they took different roles in different times.* In other words, Yahweh deals with the nations and his plans differently in each period of time which is all true.

The Bible said if you want to know what Yahweh is going to do tomorrow just look at what he did yesterday. He never changes. So dispensational as a Christian, the first two things you'll have to eradicate from your mind is Replacement Theology and Dispensational Theology. Sister go right ahead. *In other words, it says God changes.* Absolutely, that's right. And we know better don't we?

So, now there are two extremes in the world. On my desk right now I've got one, two, three, four, five, six, seven, eight books that I'm looking at over there. I ordered those books because I love to make sure that I'm teaching the truth. I'm not like most people, I don't order books that agree with me. I order books that disagree with me. That way I can know that I'm teaching the truth. So I ordered those eight books about Israel. That set of books is the other extreme of Christianity.

Christianity believes in replacement theology, that the church replaced natural Israel. Well these guys believe that natural Israel, genetically, by bloodline, will be the only people saved in the world because 'all Israel will be saved'. Ok? So that is their mindset. You have the Christians who think's it has nothing to do with Israel. I want everyone to listen to me carefully. They are both prime examples of what makes First Harvest Ministries a wonderful ministry. They are the extremes. FHM does not dwell in the extremes. We don't get in ditches on both sides of the road. What we like to do is find that good lane, that middle lane, that gets on the road that's going somewhere. So we don't believe that extreme and we don't believe this extreme.

So how are they all getting it wrong? Because they're missing what you have. They do not understand the first resurrection, the second resurrection. They don't understand the first harvest. They do not understand what you know of the three harvests that I've taught you about. They don't understand when they see scriptures about saved and unsaved, they don't understand many of those are referring to the first harvest, the first resurrection.

So you have a foundation here. This man is so smart that wrote these eight books, so smart. As I'm reading it I see where he gets it from, why he would think only natural Israel will be saved. I see it. There's scriptures that point to that. Then I think...but brother, please call me, you're missing what it takes. I call it the key. It is the three harvests. And that's what 30, 60, 100-fold is.

Listen to me carefully. If you have not watched my teaching on the 30, 60 and 100-fold, you don't even know where to start in what we believe. Our foundational teaching is 30, 60, 100-fold believers.\* You must get that in your mind. Why? Do you know why I don't show you these books? A lot of people say... recommend books to us. I can't. Because there's a bunch of good stuff in this book right here, but I can't let you read it. Why? There's more junk in it than there is good. If I recommend them to you, it's just going to confuse you. But the point is that book right there, if you don't understand 30, 60 and 100, you would be so confused because these folks can prove that only Abraham's physical children will be saved.

Now, what do we believe different? We do believe that Abraham's physical descendants will be in the first resurrection—do you follow me? Ok? Abraham's seed. But we also know who Abraham's seed is. So anyway I just had to clear that up because there's so much confusion out there.

Alright, remember this. The church has not replaced Israel. We have simply *repositioned* with Israel, ok? Not replaced. Repositioned. Do you remember last week I taught you about Reuben? Reuben was first, remember? He was the firstborn, but Yahweh did not recognize him as the firstborn because he rejected the commandments of Yahweh. He committed sin. So Yahweh now recognizes another brother to be first. And Reuben became last.

So, therefore, what Yahweh recognizes today as Abraham's seed is repositioning, going to the first in line above the natural descendants, if you will. But that does not mean they will be lost. They will not be lost. Oh no, no, no. Remember, we have repositioned with natural Israel, not replaced. And that's so important that you keep that in your mind.

Whenever we get to the New Testament which is where we're going right now, I want you to listen carefully to the word "The fathers". All of the New Testament shockingly speaks of THE FATHERS. Who are we referring to when we talk about the fathers? Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. Amen. That is the Fathers. Listen to me carefully. The Fathers is not Abraham. We make that mistake a lot. No, no, no.

The fathers—you have to follow that because Abraham was a father to many sons. But that is not the seed of promise. The fathers are Abraham, Isaac and Jacob (Israel). Keep that in mind. Not Abraham. You've got to trace it through Abraham, Isaac and Israel. That is where the promised seed is going to come from. So keep that in mind as we begin to read these scriptures.

Let's go to the book of Romans. We're going to start there today. Romans 9:4.

#### **Romans 9:4**

**Who are Israelites, to whom pertains the adoption, and the glory, and the covenants, and the giving of the law, and the service of Yahweh, and the promises.**

This is probably about 30, maybe 50 years after Christ died, and supposedly when he died, to the Christian church natural Israel became a nonentity. Supposedly the church has replaced Israel. But I want you to read that verse again and tell me who the Israelites are.

#### **Who are Israelites, to whom pertains the adoption...**

The adoption. If you have heard me teach on the adoption, the only sons, the Huiiothesia (watch my teaching on this Greek word Huiiothesia\*). The only ones that will be adopted as fully-matured sons are who? It's in your Bible. *Israel*. Israelites. Only Israel will be adopted as sons. Now, what does that mean? That means there will be many children of God in the kingdom, but not many sons that will be adopted fully in the family business of co-creation. This is what we've got to understand. The adoption only applies to an Israelite. And what else applies to an Israelite?

#### **...and the glory, and the covenants...**

More than one covenant. Did you see that? Who do the covenants exclusively belong to? Israelites. And what else?

#### **...and the giving of the law, and the service of Yahweh, and the promises.**

The only ones who have any promise. Listen to me carefully. The only ones who have any promise of Yahweh to rule and reign is an Israelite, the natural seed of Abraham.

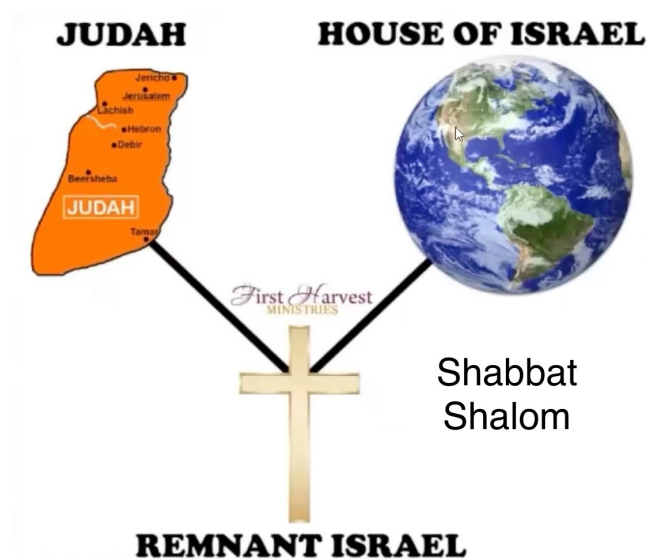

But now not all the natural seed (we're going to get to that in a minute), but a certain group of those natural seeds will be in the covenants and will be in the promises. You've got to get this in your mind. You've got Israelites—well let's just read it. Go to Isaiah. We're going to start at chapter 10 and verse 20. I want to show you who the seed of Abraham will be counted as in that first resurrection. Isaiah 10:20.

### **Isaiah 10:20-22**

**20 And it shall come to pass in that day, that the remnant of Israel, and such as are escaped of the house of Jacob, shall no more again stay upon him that smote them, but shall stay upon Yahweh, the Holy One of Israel, in truth.**

In that day. What day? The day we're living in right now. It shall come to pass. Notice not all of Israel. The what? The REMNANT OF ISRAEL. Remember our graphic. You have the house of Judah, the house of Israel. All natural seed of Abraham. Out of those two houses Yahweh calls out a remnant to escape from Babylon.



To escape from Judaism, from Catholicism, Pentecostalism, every ism out there, he calls them out and brings them through the what? Through the cross of Yahshua the Messiah or through the blood sacrifice into the New Covenant.

Those two groups of people form one new man or the remnant of Israel. Listen to me and listen carefully, the ones who are coming up in the first resurrection, in the 144,000, in the millennium government, will be, not all of Israel, but the REMNANT of

Israel. That's the 12 tribes that will be in the New Jerusalem. Read verse 21.

**21 The remnant shall return, even the remnant of Jacob, unto the mighty God Yahweh.**

That verse just said not all of Israel will return to God, to the fathers. What do you think Elijah comes to do? (We're going to wake up in a minute, you're going to start hearing the message.) Elijah comes to turn the hearts of the children of Abraham who thought they were Catholic, who thought they were Baptist,

thought they were Pentecostals—that voice comes into your life and does what? The Bible said it turns your thinking, which is your heart, back to the fathers. Who are the fathers? Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. You re-identify yourself when you hear the voice of Elijah just before the coming of Yahshua. And the only ones who will hear his voice is not all of natural Israel. Because everyone here today is a natural descendant of the lost tribes

So why didn't your mama come, why didn't your brother come, why didn't your children come? It didn't say ALL lost tribes, all natural descendants will return. It said a remnant of them. Ladies and gentlemen, I am looking today all across America at that remnant that has returned to the God of their fathers, Abraham, Isaac and Jacob! Hallelujah. I'm looking at you this morning! I see you, I'm looking at the remnant. You're here. Let's read verse 22.

**22 For though thy people Israel be as the sand of the sea, yet a remnant of them shall return, the consumption (ending, destruction) decreed shall overflow with righteousness.**

Awww, that's a beautiful verse of scripture right there. Listen. Listen to what he says. He says there will be a remnant that will return in that day. We're living in that day now. Remember Elijah comes just before Yahshua returns, to do what? (I hope it clicks in a minute) To turn the hearts. I was in church all my life and never knew what that meant. I didn't know who the fathers were. Anybody else with me, was I the only one—turn their hearts to the fathers—what fathers? I didn't know what that meant.

But now we know that Elijah has to come and take someone like brother and sister that was whatever they were and turn their heart. What is your heart? Your spirit. What is your spirit? Your mind, your thinking. Elijah has to turn your thinking and what will a remnant do? They will re-turn, do you see it? The remnant will re-turn back to the fathers when they hear the voice of Elijah.

They will leave Babylon and return. It said that even though all the lost tribes will be scattered and there'll be millions and billions of them, like the sands of the sea, they're not all going to hear the voice of Elijah. They're not all going to return, but a remnant will. And listen to what he says. The consumption decreed shall overflow with righteousness because this remnant will return, the whole earth will be filled with the glory of Yahweh and all mankind will come to him in that great day because a remnant returned to prepare the way, to make the crooked paths straight, and to bring the high places down low. Amen! Hallelujah!

Amen. That is your calling, that is the prophecy of you, that's a prophecy of sister and sister, of brother and brother. That is a prophecy that one day you'll be

walking along minding your business and being a good member of your church and somebody will send you a video of a voice, you will hear a message that all of a sudden pricks you and says every bit of it makes sense to me. And you will return! Hallelujah. You will return to your identity. Amen. You have to understand this children, you've got to get this.

I'm staying in the New Testament today because I want you to see the exclusivity of Israel. Go to Luke 1:16. And this goes along with Isaiah that we just read.

**Luke 1:16**

**And many of the children of Israel shall he turn to Yahweh their God.**

Notice what Yahshua's coming to do. He's only coming to turn who? It's right there in your Bible. The children of Israel. I don't think you're understanding it. Let's read it again.

**And many of the children of Israel shall he turn to Yahweh their God.**

Somebody say "not all". Many. Many of the children of Israel. It doesn't say many of the children of the Gentiles. *Pastor Vaughn, that scripture there, that's not the fathers though, Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. It's father Yahweh, right?* Yes ma'am, in that verse it is. Parenthetically if you're going back to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, you are going back to Yahweh as well, so, in other words, it works hand in hand.

But in this verse, I need you all to really notice something. Yahshua is coming. According to what this verse says...only to turn the children of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob to Yahweh. Amen. It's right there in your Bible not mine. Well it's in mine too. And many of who? Abraham's seed shall Yahshua turn to the Lord their God Yahweh, their Elohim. Did you hear that? Their God. I'm going to teach you today that Yahweh has never claimed to be the God of the world.

*Pastor, I thought it was talking about John the Baptist there.* I'm sorry, perhaps it is, yeah. But John the Baptist will turn them to Yahshua and Yahshua will redeem them to their God. Amen. Notice that the ministry of John the Baptist and Yahshua is only to the house of Israel. *Brother Vaughn, how do I know that I am of that natural seed line?* It is very simple. If he has turned you back to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. Ha, ha. Darling, that's what he came to do. To turn you back.

That's why when people come to Remnant Ranch we just started putting the names of the tribes on the property. Now when you drive down the driveway, there's beautiful feathered flags, starts with Judah, goes all the way down, all 12.



Why? When a Christian pulls on that property, those names will mean nothing to him. But when an Israelite sees those names...if it doesn't touch your heart, you're not an Israelite. Amen. I'm telling you, if you can drive down that driveway and it doesn't capture your heart, you're not an Israelite. To understand that the Father has turned us back to Yahweh our Elohim.

Now I want to ask you a question. In that verse of scripture, brother, is there any suggestion of any group other than the children of Israel who will be turned to God? *No, just the children of Israel.* Just the children of Israel. I want to prove it to you even further. Luke 1:32-33.

**Luke 1:32-33**

**32 He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest, and the Yahweh shall give unto him the throne of his father David.**

**33 And he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever, and of his kingdom there shall be no end.**

I want you to underline these words...his father David, and the house of Jacob. What's another word for Jacob? Israel. According to this he will reign over the house of Israel. That's all that will allow him to reign over them, did you understand that? Gentiles will never accept him as their king until he comes with a rod of iron because they don't have the covenant. Only Israel has the covenants. He is coming to do one thing—to sit on a throne.

Do you know that Yahshua is the very son of Yahweh, the firstborn son of Yahweh? And do you know that the very thing that was promised to him has still not happened? I really want you to think about that for those of you that are complaining about unanswered prayers and how the Lord hadn't come through for you yet.

He still hasn't come through for Yahshua. Ha, ha, ha! Oh hallelujah. But the Bible calls Yahshua a faithful high priest. He's still being faithful. He's still being faithful even though he doesn't have his promise yet. Yahshua—he doesn't have his throne yet. But it was promised. Let me see if I can find that scripture. I believe the only reason that he was born. John 18:37. This was the only reason he was born.

**John 18:37**

**Pilate therefore said unto him, Art thou a king then? Yahshua answered, Thou sayest that I am a king. To this end was I born, and for this cause came I into the world, that I should bear witness unto the truth. Every one that is of the truth hears my voice.**

The only reason I was born was to be a king. And he's still not a king. Somebody said...*oh yeah, he's king of kings and Lord of Lords*. No, no, no, no. That doesn't happen—go to the book of Daniel—that doesn't happen till his second coming when all the kings will lay their crown, that's me and you. We will lay our egos, we will lay our way of thinking, our authority, at his feet.

It's on that day he finally becomes what he was born to be. He's not the king of the earth right now, who's the king of the earth? Satan is the king of the earth, is he not the 'god of this world'? Yes. That's the king of this earth. Satan rules planet earth. Now it's only because Yahweh allows him to because Yahweh owns the earth but Yahweh has leased it out to whoever could take dominion over it. The only one who's been able to take dominion over it so far is Satan.

That's why this year 86,000 of our teenagers have died from fentanyl overdoses. We're losing our own children because Satan is god of this world. People say... *why doesn't God...* no, no, no, no, no. Without this pain not one of you would pray the prayer "thy kingdom come". *Brother Vaughn, I just wish the world was a better place*. Then you're praying erroneously, that's why I don't believe in climate change, that's why I don't believe in any of this demonic junk.

Because ladies and gentlemen, I've read the book. I know there's a kingdom coming and this world will never pass away, I know who holds it in his hand. So, therefore, I don't live in fear, I live in total faith. I have no fear of tomorrow, I have no fear of today because I know who's in control. You have to get that kind of faith or you will live your life in fear of every new little YouTube video clip that somebody inboxes you.

I got one a while ago about two asteroids that, supposedly from the book of Revelations, is on it's way. I couldn't care less about asteroids. I couldn't care less about aliens. I couldn't care less about flat, round. I couldn't care less about any of it because I know that all that matters is **THY KINGDOM COME, THY WILL BE DONE**...on earth whether it's flat, round, green, blue or yellow. Thy kingdom come to earth, let it be done on earth as it is in heaven. Hallelujah!

We cannot get tied up in the minutiae, we must get tied up in the message! (That's a good quote.) Don't get tied up in the minutiae, get tied up in the message. The message is that Yahshua was born to be a king, and guess what? If the purpose of his birth (oh God help me now. I'm about to preach). If the purpose of his birth was to be a king, then guess what the purpose of your birth was? To be a king with him. He was going to be the king of... come on now! *Kings! Hallelujah!* The king of kings!

He never fulfills his destiny until we fulfill ours. For him to be a king of kings, we must first become the kings of the earth! *The Royal Priesthoods*. The royal priesthood. See, listen to me, if you weren't born sir to be bound by pornography, you were born to tell pornography...not today. You were not born to be bound as an animal. You were born to rule and to reign. Hallelujah.

The Holy Spirit has revealed to me that some of you brothers are struggling with pornography. And even some sisters. I want you to hear me and hear me well. You have the power. I said you have the power to say NO to that old slave master. Ok? Praise Yahweh! Some of you brothers, put your computer right in the living room where your wife can see it when she walks by. Uh oh, it got quiet in here. You're a king, you are not an animal. An animal has no control over themselves.

That's why I talk to people about polygamy. I have many friends who believe in polygamy. And they bring up...*well, you know, it was allowed in the Old Testament*. It sure was, and guess what had not been given yet in the Old Testament? The outpouring of the Holy Spirit, ok? Now listen, but they say it's in nature. You're right. One buck, many does. Absolutely. Right now they told me we've got five rams about to be born at Remnant Ranch, and I'm like...*how? We've only got one ram out there with all those females. He's hitting every one of them*. That's polygamy darling. That one ram, they're wearing him out! That one ram runs from all the female sheep because they're wearing him out.

Amen. Now that's polygamy. Is it natural? I'll tell you what. I'd rather see you as a polygamist than a homosexual married to a man. But anyway it is what it is. That's what I don't get about America. Polygamy's illegal. You'll lose your whole family over something that is natural—I didn't say it's godly—I said it's natural. But a man can marry a man and raise all the kids he wants, and that's legal.

You all saw what they did to those polygamist children, took them all from them. Now I'm not here to talk about polygamy today, but I'm here to talk about being king. Because when you're a king, you can say no to all the others and choose one and be faithful and loyal. I'm trying to tell you that you were born to be a king. You were not born to be religious, you were born to be a king. Let's read about that. Let's go to Genesis 1:26-28. Oh hallelujah. I'm going to show you why you were born.

### **Genesis 1:26-28**

**26 And Yahweh said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness, and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creeps upon the earth.**

Why are we creating man? What's the one purpose? To be a king. What does a king do? He has dominion. Yahshua said...I was born to be a king. And guess what? So were all of his brethren. We were born to be kings and have dominion.

**27 So Yahweh created man in his own image, in the image of Yahweh created he him, male and female created he them.**

For one purpose. To take dominion over the earth. Over your earth which is your body. Over your drug addiction. Praise Yahweh. Now that phrase “made in the image of God” in the Septuagint is *Eikona*. Literally it means *prototype*. Not only resembling something, but just like from where it is drawn from. In other words, Adam was made as a prototype of Yahweh. Literally. He was to carry in himself the ability to create.

You'll never find an animal that can write a song, only a man can. You'll never find an animal that can engineer a building, only a man can. You'll never find an animal that can write a piece of poetry or can create with their mouth, with their hands. Only man was created to create. That is the family business of the Elohim. The family business is to take dominion over our earth. To become a king.

Do you know how someone becomes a king? They take over a territory. They literally take dominion, win a war. The day you take dominion over your flesh, you've become a king. And that's the purpose for which you were born. That's why none of these self-help drug addiction groups, that's why none of these counseling centers can help anybody. They never teach men the purpose of their birth. It is literally to take dominion over your earth. We've been made the very image of God, the very likeness of God.

Now read verse 28.

**28 And Yahweh blessed them, and Yahweh said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it, and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moves upon the earth.**

He said I'm creating man to do one thing. I want him to have lots of children. I want large families. Why? Because I am re-creating myself in man. And it is your job what I started. It is not my job to finish what I started. It's your job to finish what I've started. It's the same way with salvation. He that started a good work in you—he starts the work, and then you have to work with him to finish that work in sanctification. He started the work, but said I want you to finish it.

Why do you think Yahweh hates abortion? Because his very first command is to have as many children as you can have. That's why when I look at a certain family in this church who has many children, I see a prototype of Yahweh. Nobody wants children anymore. Nobody. In the world we live in, I almost don't blame you. *It's selfishness*. It is. Nobody wants children, nobody wants large families. They just want houses, larger houses, it's selfishness. They don't want to give up the good life.

When I go to this large family, those people, and there are two of these families, do you know how much time the parents get? Zero. Have you ever heard of "me time"...I need some me time? No, no, no. You've got too much of you, that's the problem. It's selfishness. When I go to their house, there is never a moment when she doesn't have two arms full and I literally see the plan of Yahweh. It was for loving parents to have children. They didn't need "me time", they needed "children time".

I go there and I get so convicted. That's why people don't like to be around them. They call them weird because it's a conviction to the world. The first commandment—multiply. Replenish the earth with your children. Do you know why he wanted you to have a lot of children? The apostle Paul said that the children are sanctified by the parents. What does that mean? It's so simple. It didn't say they were "saved" by the believing parent. It said that the children are "sanctified" by the believing parent.

What does that mean? Those children are set apart in a special position to have more of a chance of salvation than other people in the world will have. If evil parents are having children, the chance of those children finding Christ is slim. Whereas the believing parent sanctifies their children. In other words, they put their children in a position to be set apart, to come to salvation much easier than others can. That's why Satan doesn't want you, he wants the world, but not the church. We have been called to subdue the earth. That's the purpose of our birth.

Now let's continue reading. Let's start at Luke 1:54. Now in the verses we're reading Yahshua is spoken of as the ruler of Israel only. Do you know why? He will only rule over those that come into covenant and ask him to rule over them. Yahshua is a king to us. Why? Because we have subjected ourselves unto his word.

#### **Luke 1:54-55**

**54 He hath holpen** (helped, embraced) **his servant Israel, in remembrance of his mercy,**

**55 As he spake to our fathers, to Abraham, and to his seed for ever.**

Who is mercy being given to? Mercy is always being spoken of as being given to Israel only. Why is that? They're the only ones who need mercy. They're the only ones who broke a covenant with Yahweh. They're the only ones who violated the covenant. Therefore, mercy is only needed for Israel. The promise of mercy was to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob and his seed only.

Israel is that group of people that the fathers are the fathers of. Listen, you cannot call them fathers unless they're your father. And that's the only ones who have the promise of mercy. Let's go look at Luke 1:68.

**Luke 1:68**

**Blessed be Yahweh of Israel, for he hath visited and redeemed his people.**

I want you to read it again. Of who? Of Israel. You will never find Yahweh described in any other way. You will never find him Yahweh of the Philistines. You will never find a Yahweh of the Canaanites. You will never find a Yahweh of the world. YOU WILL ONLY FIND A GOD OF ISRAEL And if you're not an Israelite, he's not your God.

How long does this last? *Well pastor Vaughn, I thought that he was going to get them all.* He is. And soon I'm going to teach you a lesson called The Day After the Millennium where I'll bring you into the 8th day and start teaching you what happens after the millennial reign. Yahweh does not become the God of the all in all until he first redeems Israel.

And then after the millennial reign, the Bible said Yahshua will put death under his feet, and take the restored planet along with the first fruits, the first harvest, and will do what? Then Yahweh himself will come to earth and make his abode here with us. And the Bible said then Yahweh will become all in all. But until such a time, he is only the God of Israel.

Sister go right ahead. *So does that mean in the millennium that he's only looking for Israel still?* Well, no. Israel comes up in the first resurrection. Watch this: What is the purpose of our resurrection? To begin a long process of retraining the world. Remember the Bible said they will come to Zion to say...teach us his law. They're still not Israelites. As a matter of fact, he said if you don't come up for Tabernacles—there'll still be some not keeping Tabernacles—I'll give you no rain.

There'll still be old natures and habits. That's what people don't get about the millennium. The whole earth will be filled with the glory of God. But humans will still have their old memories of Christmas, they will still have their old memories

of their habits and their traditions, just like some of you! You're still being converted, you still have some of those old soul ties, you're being converted.

So to answer your questions sister, it's going to take a millennium, and then the great white throne judgment to convert the nations into Israelites, to get them to come into the covenant. And after that millennium, then you have the great white throne judgment. Then every knee bows, every tongue confesses, and they come into the New Covenant through Yahshua at which point then the whole world is Israel. Because the word Israel simply means what? Overcomers with God. Or sons of God, princes of Yahweh.

So as soon as the whole earth submits to that, he is now all in all. Why? Because all of Israel will be saved, everyone will be Israel at that point. Amen? They will all come in through the cross of Christ. Hallelujah. Great question. Let's keep reading where we were just at and read that last line.

**...for he hath visited and redeemed his people.**

Who is he redeeming? Israel. His people. You listen to me. His people have always been Israel. They're the apple of his eye.

Go ahead sister. *I just have to say two things. One, verse 72 says it in just one line. To show mercy to our fathers, to remember his holy covenant. That's it. And I had to keep reading, and it's amazing how the scriptures completely open up! I just want to keep reading it because it keeps saying it in a whole new way!* And sister that is my ministry right there! To bring you back to the word. This ministry is not to bring anybody to Shane Vaughn, do you understand?

When she just said I can't stop reading, my chills just went off because that is my ministry, to get you to keep reading, to get you to continue reading. Shane Vaughn will fail you. I want you to hear me. Do you know the burden I carry knowing that all of you are watching my life? Do you know what a burden that is? I will fail you. There will be a day when I will do something you don't like or disagree with. You better look past me. You better see the message I am teaching you. Amen?

*Pastor I see that spirit of Elijah in you. You are named John. John was sent by Yahweh like John the Baptist. You've got to and that's what you've got to follow. That voice that is leading us back. That one scripture just told us that he redeemed his people. What does that tell you? Listen to me carefully. Only Israel, the seed of Abraham, needs to be redeemed with a kinsman redeemer.*

The world doesn't have to have a kinsman redeemer. Why? They were not in debt, they didn't break the covenant. They will get a Jubilee. YOU must have a redeemer. Does that make sense to you? Amen. They get a year of Jubilee where they'll all be set free. Amen.

Brother go right ahead. *Ok, so the blessing in all of this is because we do have a kinsman redeemer. We get to be awakened while we transition into it. Because we've been awakened and called back we only have that ability through the redeeming of the kinsman. So now because we've been redeemed, now we're awakened preparing to reign in the kingdom.*

And brother let me follow up on that because that's a great point. Do you know that you were born to rule and reign with Christ? And do you know that Yahshua said that we would sit with him on his Father's throne in that government? I want you all to watch this carefully. What is sad is that not one place from Genesis to Revelation have you ever been promised a place called heaven. It's so weird, not one time anywhere—find it for me, show it to me—where you were promised to go to heaven. And yet that's what everybody wants.

But I can show you where he promised you that if you would suffer with him you would reign with him. Now there's a promise and nobody wants it. I want you to hear what I just said. You have no promise of heaven ever, and that's where all his followers want to go. You do have a promise that if you suffer with him he'll put you on a throne with a government to rule the nations of the world. And no Christian wants that—none. They want to be saved and go to heaven. They don't want to suffer and rule and reign.

I just laid it on you. Nobody wants what they were promised. *The whole world has been deceived. Revelation 12:9. We can use this as evidence though correct? Because the ones who aren't awake, that's by design. To redeem them is to understand the harvests they're a part of rather than the harvest we're a part of.*

When you get those three harvests brother, all these scriptures will make sense to you. Everyone watching me right now, if you're training for reigning, get that motto, get it in your heart. Don't let it just be a saying. I didn't create that to be a cute t-shirt emblem. Those words have meaning. First Harvest Ministries is training for reigning. That's not a cute slogan. That's your destiny. Schooling for ruling. That's why Christians will look at you when they see you tithing, and say... *well you ain't gotta do that to go to heaven.* And I say you're exactly right, thank you so much, have a great day.



When they see you keeping the feast of Tabernacles...*well you ain't gotta do that.* Thank you, I understand. But you see, I am so past where you are sir in my thinking, not better than you, but in my thinking I couldn't care less about salvation. I'm no longer stuck on SAVED! I'm not stuck there anymore! I'm not glued to the cross. I'm marching to Mt. Sion. I realize I don't have to do anything.

Listen folks, those of you who are not tithers—do you know why you're not a tither? You still have not brought your flesh under subjection to the word of God. Put him first in all things. Do you know those of you who are not keeping the feasts, do you know why? You still think that you can do it your way. You're not a king, you're still a slave to your own way of thinking. But when you get to the point, in a few weeks from now, you'll feel the test—December 25th when everybody doesn't understand what kind of a cult you've joined, when they don't understand why—it's not going to hurt anything.

Yesterday, I was with my wife at my mother's house at Thanksgiving. And I'll always honor my mother, I'll always show up anytime she invites me over. It was a long drive, but I went. Having to catch a flight last night, I still went. She serves lunch. Dressing? That's good, so good. And the biggest ham you've ever seen. No turkey. No turkey! Nothing but ham. I sat there, and of course I wasn't tempted to eat the ham, I don't even like ham anymore.

But then I thought...why didn't she cook a turkey? I could grab some turkey with this dressing. But now there's only four of us at the table and you can't hide that you're not eating the ham. And she's worked so hard and proud of this ham. I knew right then that my light, my example of obedience, was so important in that moment. And then it dawned on her that she remembered all of a sudden that we don't eat pork. But we never one time said...well we don't eat pork. We didn't tell her that.

I got everything else on the table, but she noticed I didn't get her ham. I didn't have to say...well why did you cook ham? You know we don't eat pork. No! No, no, no. Be wise as a serpent, harmless as a dove. And oh, my mother, you could see it on her face. A conviction. She felt so bad. And what does that have to do with my salvation? Nothing. It has to do with my willingness to obey the word of Yahweh—wherever it takes me.

Sir, you have to obey the word of Yahweh by being good to your wives. You can't be a Sabbath-keeper and a wife-beater. And there's more ways to beat than with your hands. You can beat with your tongue. We can't just be Sabbath-keepers, we have to be Word-keepers. Ma'am, there's more ways to rebel against your husband than openly. If it's in your heart and you're doing it behind his back, you need to conquer that.

We're all training for Israelites to say yes sir, to him. Yes sir to the word. Get it out of your hearts. Get rebellion out of your hearts. Get it out. Rebellion to authority is a sure sign that you need to pray some more. You need to crucify that and ask the Lord to help you with that. Amen.

Go ahead sister. *I just got a question that's off the subject, probably for the next time, but you know when we go through the millennial reign, is earth itself going to be transformed, like renewed?* Oh yes. Yes ma'am. Go watch my teaching called A Millennium Mentality\* and I explain how the whole earth is going to be changed. I go into details, how the rivers will be healed, how gold will be coming up from the earth. I teach about all of that from the scriptures.

Sister go ahead. *The way I'm looking at this is like this, as Israelites, what we're talking about here is inheritance. That's our inheritance. Like when the children of Israel were given the inheritance, the 12 tribes. So I have a question. In Numbers 36 it talks about the inheritance wasn't to be passed from one tribe to the other. So it was to remain in the tribe that it was given. So in the kingdom, whenever...what is that relating to?*

Well, that doesn't shock me because remember there'll be 12 gates to the city. In other words, there's not going to be this commingling of tribes still evidently in the New Jerusalem. So to me, in other words, each tribe will be allotted their right to rule and they'll go into the gates according to the tribes that they were born from. So I don't see a change in that at all personally.

*Ok, are they going to rule over a nation that is their tribe?* Well they'll rule over nations. As a matter of fact if you remember Yahshua told the apostles that they would sit on 12 thrones judging the 12 tribes of Israel. So evidently each tribe will be ruled over by one of the apostles. And then the tribe will rule over whatever nations are allotted to that tribe—which I don't know what that would be. But we'll find out real soon, I promise you. Amen?

Go ahead sister. *Shalom pastor. I'm still a little confused. I've got the three harvests. The barley, the wheat and the grapes. Ok, the barley is at Yahshua's coming, that's when the remnant, the bride, comes up. The wheat is at the?*

That would be at the second resurrection.

*That's at the great judgment.*

Now let me help you right there. Remember in the second resurrection you have saved people who are already saved.

*Alright, where does that happen?*

At the end of the thousand-year reign. We, the first harvest, the tribes of Israel, the remnant, comes up at the beginning of that thousand years. The purpose of our coming up is because Yahshua, even though he's divine, is still only one entity ruling billions of people. He needs what? Just like the Queen of England, she needs a cabinet of ministers to govern her kingdom. Yahshua will not be governing his kingdom. We will, alright?

He will govern us, we will govern them. We will teach them, we'll reeducate this planet. We'll establish schools, there'll be Sabbath schools in every town. It will be a total reeducation project that will last, changing human nature. The Holy Spirit will pour out on all men. Every one will receive the Spirit, but sister think about that. So people will say...well if everybody will have the Holy Ghost, wouldn't they change overnight. And my question is: did you?

*No...ha, ha, ha! Alright, so the second is at the thousand years that's coming to a close.*

Correct.

*And then that's when those who have changed move up or...*

No. That's when your saved, your 30-fold believers, those who are saved right now—they're not going to hell, they're not lost. They didn't make the first resurrection. But they are coming up as children of Yahweh, saved. Called, but not chosen. Keep that in mind. They come up with the sinners. They come up "the just and the unjust". They come up together.

*Alright, they're in the thousand years.*

At the end of the thousand years.

*Ok, so we're teaching the earth, not the dead. We're only teaching during the thousand years.*

Yes. So let's say Yahshua comes back today, ok? Nothing would change. It's not like everybody would fall dead. Life keeps going. People still having babies. People still die during the millennial reign.

*I got it.*

Ok. So, all those people who got converted during the millennial reign by you and me, by the teachers, those people will die eventually, ok? ... 100 years old, the Bible speaks of that. Now when that happens, they will come up also in the second resurrection. Let's say right now Yahshua comes. Today people would still die that's supposed to die today. Alright, those people still have to come up, right? But they got saved, if you will, under our ministry. But they still have to come up, they've not been tested, they've not been tried like you were. So they both come up together.

Now, the saved people, they're good to go. But what about all the people who never heard the gospel? That is the Grape Harvest. The Wheat Harvest is the saved people that were not 100-fold, that were not first harvest.

*So the wheat and the grapes will mingle, but their final...*

They will not be harvested together, ok? They will come up together, but one group of those are saved people, they're not going into the lake of fire, the judgment. In other words, these grape people, if you think the grape people are going to get by with a life of sin and just be granted...no, no, no. They will be punished, they will be tried by fire. That's the grape harvest, they have to be trodden down. They will be cast into that judgment for 100 years. That's the grape harvest. The wheat don't go through that.

*The wheat misses the 100 years, they go through the 1,000 years to get to that...*

That's correct.

*Thank you. I got it finally. Finally I got it.*

I'm glad. Those three harvests will help everybody understand God's word so much better.

(another sister): *Where did you get the 100 years?* I taught on it, where were you at? Let me think what lesson that would've been. (a brother): *That's a single scripture he's talking about.* (same sister): *That's what I'm talking about.*

That's in Isaiah. I taught about it because it had to be explained. I know I taught on it but I just can't...I taught on such much, who knows, but we'll find it for you.

Alright, let's read Luke 1:73-74, 77. I've got a long way to go.

**Luke 1:73-74, 77**

**73 The oath which he swore to our father Abraham,**

**74 That he would grant unto us, that we being delivered out of the hand of our enemies might serve him without fear.**

Alright, you've got the word us, we and our in that verse. I need to know who the us, the we and the our is. It's all referring to our father Abraham. So these are Israelites. It says the oath which he swore to our father, Abraham. That he would grant to us that we, being delivered out of the hand of our enemies, might serve him. Who are the only ones who are being delivered out of the hand of the enemy right now? Us, Israel. We, us. Abraham's children. We're the only ones. That proves to you that the world is not being delivered out of the hand of the enemy right now. That's why they're all on drugs, on alcohol. They're not being delivered. Only us, we.

Read verse 77.

**77 To give knowledge of salvation unto his people...**

To give knowledge of salvation only. You all it's right there in your Bible. He only gives the call of salvation to Israel

**...by the remission of their sins.**

Of who's sins? Theirs. They're the only ones who have sin because they're the only ones who understood the law. If you're living outside the United States of America, we cannot convict you for breaking one of our laws. Do you understand that? We can't convict you, you're out of our jurisdiction. Those that are outside the covenant are outside the jurisdiction for redemption.

Let's read Luke 2:34. This is a good one, I love this one. Talking about the birth of Yahshua.

**Luke 2:34**

**And Simeon blessed them, and said unto Mary his mother, Behold, this child is set for the fall and rising again of many in Israel, and for a sign which shall be spoken against.**

Many in where? In Israel. This child is born for the falling and the rising of many, not all. Many in Israel. Nobody else. I said NOBODY ELSE. That's why he was born—for Israel. Didn't he say I only came to save Israel, the lost sheep of the house of Israel? Why is that so hard? It's so hard because you were raised a

Baptist—for God so loved the world. I’m going to deal with that scripture next week. I’m also going to deal with the word Gentiles next week. It gets good. We’ve got a long way to go and a short time to get there.

Matthew 1:21. It gets so good. You see I’m trying to prove something to you. When we were in the Old Testament reading about how special Israel was, we were all ok with that. *But in the New Testament everything changes brother Vaughn.* Well let’s find out. Let’s just keep on because I’m all up in the New Testament.

**Matthew 1:21**

**And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name Yahshua, for he shall save his people from their sins.**

For he shall save everybody from their sins! *No, his people.* I thought it said that he came to save whosoever will, anybody who wants to come, let him come. No. That’s because you don’t know about the last great day. Remember when Yahhsua said those words it was on the 8th day of the feast. You need to learn your feasts and then you can read your Bible right.

But he said he only came to save HIS people from THEIR sins. Because no other people are accounted as sinners. Do you remember the illustration I did when I brought 5 people to the front of the church? And I said you’re law, you’re grace, etc? And I said when you set law down you’ve got to set grace down. Why? Because you don’t need grace if there’s no law, remember? This law was only pertaining to Israel. Therefore, only THEY needed mercy, only they needed grace.

**Matthew 2:6**

**And thou Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, art not the least among the princes of Judah, for out of thee shall come a Governor, that shall rule my people Israel.**

Oh wow. There’s a governor coming, a king. And he’s only going to rule MY people Israel. You all we’re in the New Testament now—where everything supposedly changes about Israel.

**Matthew 15:24**

**But he answered and said, I am not sent but unto the lost sheep of the house of Israel.**

If you want to watch a Christian lose their mind, make them read that verse. I only came for the lost tribes of Israel. My, my, my. Sometimes I don’t know what

else to say except what it says. It's pretty plain. I was sent to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.

**Matthew 15:31**

**Insomuch that the multitude wondered, when they saw the dumb to speak, the maimed to be whole, the lame to walk, and the blind to see, and they glorified Yahweh the God of Israel.**

Of Israel. You'll never find him to be described any other way but the GOD OF ISRAEL. I'm going to bring you all the way through the New Testament. I'm trying to see when it changes.

**Matthew 19:28**

**And Yahshua said unto them, Verily I say unto you, That ye which have followed me, in the regeneration when the Son of man shall sit in the throne of his glory, ye also shall sit upon twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel.**

Notice the only ones who will have thrones and rulership are the tribes of Israel in the millennial reign. The times of regeneration are the times of the restitution of all things. This is the millennial reign. There will be 12 thrones that will govern 12 tribes. Why? Because in the millennial reign that is all that will be saved which will come up in the first resurrection, the 12 tribes of Israel. You all it's right there in your Bible, there's nothing you can do about those verses, you cannot erase them. Christianity would love to erase them. The Roman Catholic Church would love to convince you that they are the New Israel.

**Mark 12:29-34**

**29 And Yahshua answered him, The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel, Yahweh our God is one God.**

Notice that word "hear". Why did he say O Israel? Because they're the only ones who can hear right now (I'm gonna let that hit ya'll in a minute). HEAR O ISRAEL. Do you know why people cannot hear my message about who Yahshua is, that he's not Yahweh? Do you know why people can't deal with it? They're not Israel. A Christian must have a trinity or a oneness. They cannot have the truth! They can't hear the truth.

Hear O Israel. Yahweh is one. He's not three. He's not a man. He's not a son of man. He is one O Israel. But only Israel can hear that message. Christianity cannot hear that message, they will go berserk on you.

*Can we read the rest of that passage? Sure go ahead.*

**30 And thou shalt love Yahweh thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength, this is the first commandment.**

**31 And the second is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these.**

**32 And the scribe said unto him, Well, Master, thou hast said the truth, for there is one God, and there is none other but he.**

**33 And to love him with all the heart, and with all the understanding, and with all the soul, and with all the strength, and to love his neighbor as himself, is more than all whole burnt offerings and sacrifices.**

Notice right there what Yahshua said. There is none other than he. He didn't say none other than me, he said there is none other than HE. That's God.

**34 And when Yahshua saw that he answered discreetly, he said unto him, Thou art not far from the kingdom of Yahweh. And no man after that dared ask him any question.**

Amen. Amen. Boy he'll tell you who he is. He'll tell you who his Father is. How Christianity messed it up so bad—it's only Israel that can hear that the Lord our God is one. That's why if you've not been baptized in the name of that one. He said you must be baptized in the name of "Yah is my salvation".

That's what Yahshua means. Yah is my savior. You have to be baptized in the name of, in the sentence, in the declaration over your life. Yahweh is my savior. When you're baptized in the name of Yahshua, that is not a name as much as it is a prophecy, a statement of faith. When we baptize you in the name of Yahshua, we're baptizing you in the truth that your savior is Yahweh. He is the savior of all mankind. He alone is your savior. Hallelujah.

Hear O Israel because only Israel can hear.

#### **John 1:11-12**

**11 He came unto his own, and his own received him not.**

Ok do you remember the verse earlier where we talked about his people? I saved my people from...well who are his people? It tells you right here. He came to his own (which is his) and his own received him not.



**12 But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of Yahweh...**

Only them. Only them did he give the authority to become the sons of God. Not all of them because they didn't all receive him. But the ones that did and the ones that do—the remnant. A remnant, they alone have authority to train to reign. They alone have the authority to go to school for ruling. They alone have the authority to become the sons of God. Because they're not the sons of Yahweh right now, but prophetically. They are still children being matured into the sons of God.

**John 1:31**

**And I knew him not, but that he should be made manifest to Israel, therefore am I come baptizing with water.**

So who is Yahshua to be manifested to only? Israel. Do you all see that? He only came to be manifested to Israel.

Go ahead sister. *I was just going to mention that Yahshua was saying that in Mark 12. He was quoting the Shema in Deuteronomy 6:4. He's speaking to Jewish people, and he's calling out the lost tribes to remember what they forgot. Amen. Oh hear Oh Israel. Amen. Because they had forgotten it just like they forgot Sabbath while they were in Egypt. And that's what's on every Mezuzah in the Jewish homes to remind them of the one God. That's the one thing Jews can't deviate from.*

You can never deviate from One God. That is the signature of an Israelite. That's why elder, a Jew, could not come to Christ as her Messiah. Because they made him so much more than a Messiah and she knew as a Jew...hear O Israel the Lord your God is One. There is no other that can claim to be Creator God besides him. *That would be the two witness, from the Old to the New.*

Absolutely. Both of them. Spirit and Truth, the law, the prophets, the Psalms, and the New Testament. Listen. There's going to be a ministry in the last days that has the two witness anointing. You must have that double witness. Any doctrine you can't find in the Torah, in the Tanakh, you better be careful of it. Like the rapture, the incarnation, all of these you better be able to find it. Like eternal torment, you better find it in Torah or you've got a problem and you've got to fix that problem.

Now, let's get out of the gospels. *Oh brother Vaughn, no, no, no, none of that changed till the book of Acts.* Alright, let's find out.

**Acts 1:6**

**When they therefore were come together, they asked of him, saying, Lord, wilt thou at this time restore again the kingdom to Israel?**

Here we are in the book of Acts. There's still a mention of the kingdom of Israel after Christ is dead and gone. Go to Acts 2:22 and tell me who Christ is still being made manifest to.

**Acts 2:22**

**Ye men of Israel, hear these words...**

That's it. You men of Israel. You men of Israel listen because this is only for you!

**Acts 3:12-13**

**12 And when Peter saw it, he answered unto the people, Ye men of Israel, why marvel ye at this? or why look ye so earnestly on us, as though by our own power or holiness we had made this man to walk?**

**13 The God of Abraham, and of Isaac, and of Jacob, the God of our fathers, Yahweh, hath glorified his Son Yahshua, whom ye delivered up, and denied him in the presence of Pilate, when he was determined to let him go.**

The God of who? Our fathers. I told you to watch for that word "fathers". He is talking to the descendants of three men, Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. This is who the gospel was for exclusively. You have to know that.

**Acts 2:36**

**Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that Yahweh hath made that same Yahshua, whom ye have crucified, both Lord and Christ.**

Why didn't he say let all the world know? He said let all the house. Only they need a Messiah! Only they need a redeemer. The world has committed no sin because they have no law. Israel needs to know she has a Messiah. Let all of Israel know.

Let's see who the promise of the Holy Spirit is given to.

**Acts 2:39**

**For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as Yahweh shall call.**

Alright, there's your remnant. As many of your children as Yahweh will call to return. He's not going to call them all. Only a remnant—Isaiah 10:20. Only a remnant will return. He said this promise is unto you. Who is he talking to? He told you in verse 36 who he's talking to...therefore let all the house of Israel know. And then in verse 39...that this promise is unto you. Who? The house of Israel. And to your descendants of the house of Israel.

Not only that, but to all of those that are in the lost tribes that are afar off, those who are not here in Jerusalem. It's to them. But not all of them. Isn't that something how he clears it up. As many of them as Yahweh will call.

*Go ahead sister. I love how everything's been lining up. I was stuck in 2 Samuel 7 when David prayed to Yahweh. It was in 2 Samuel 7:18-23. About how it says in verse 23—and who his like your people Israel, the one nation on earth that Yahweh went out to redeem as a people for himself to make for himself a name. I just saw how everything was lining up that he had me reading this week. You know, hear O Israel your God is one, and then this. It's so beautiful.*

Absolutely. It lines up perfect doesn't it? Brother I just saw your comment, I'll be dealing with those verses next week. He's referring to Matthew 28:19 ... go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. That is on my agenda for next week. Brother you're welcome to come back.

First of all, the first thing I'll prove to you is that that verse is a fraud, that verse is a lie, that verse was not in the original scriptures. It was added by the holy Catholic Church. If you don't believe me go google "is Matthew 28:19 in the original scriptures?". You'll find out it was added as a fraudulent scripture. But I will deal with those. I love when people think they've got me. You don't have me. I know this truth from front to back. So Matthew 28:19 is fraudulent. It was added by the Catholic Church to prove their trinitarian doctrine. Alright. You don't need to believe me darling. Go google, that's all you've got to do. Amen.

Let's pick up at Acts 3:25.

### **Acts 3:25**

**Ye are the children of the prophets, and of the covenant which Yahweh made with our fathers, saying unto Abraham, And in thy seed shall all the kindreds of the earth be blessed.**

Listen. You, the house of Israel, are the children of the prophets, and only you are the children of the covenant which Yahweh made with our fathers.

**Acts 5:31-32**

**31 Him hath Yahweh exalted with his right hand to be a Prince and a Savior, for to give repentance to Israel, and forgiveness of sins.**

I'm not even going to say anything. I'm going to just let you all read it. I mean I don't know what I can say. It pretty much says it itself. Talking about Yahshua, him has Yahweh exalted to be a prince and a savior, not to be a co-equal or a co-God. Uh oh. He exalted him to be a what? A prince and a savior, to give repentance to Israel because only Israel needed repentance, and the forgiveness of sins.

By the way, this is in the book of Acts. This is after Christ has left and supposedly replaced Israel with the church. *And verse 32.* Go ahead and read verse 32.

**32 And we are his witnesses of these things, and so is also the Holy Ghost, whom Yahweh hath given to them that obey him.**

That's exactly right, it never changes ever, ever, ever.

Let's find out who Yahshua was. Acts 7:37

**Acts 7:37**

**This is that Moses, which said unto the children of Israel, A prophet shall Yahweh raise up unto you of your brethren, like unto me, him shall ye hear.**

I want you all to read that one more time and I want you to underline the word UNTO YOU. A prophet shall Yahweh your Elohim raise up unto you Israel. Him you will hear. He just said that this prophet was only being raised up unto you. Were Moses and Paul both wrong? He didn't say unto everyone, he said I'm raising him up unto you. When I get done today you will never be able to discount who Israel is.

**Acts 10:36**

**The word which Yahweh sent unto the children of Israel, preaching peace by Yahshua Messiah (he is Lord of all).**

Who was the word sent to? Israel. Who was Christ to be preached to? Israel. Yahweh only gave his word to Israel. That's why I tell you—if you hear this message you are an Israelite because he only sends the revelation of it to his people Israel.

Now I realize a lot of you watching me right now have a million questions about Paul and when everything was sent to the Gentiles. You hang tight because I'm about to bust that bubble probably next week.

**Acts 13:22-23**

**22 And when he had removed him, he raised up unto them David to be their king, to whom also he gave testimony, and said, I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after mine own heart, which shall fulfill all my will.**

**23 Of this man's seed hath Yahweh according to his promise raised unto Israel a Savior, Yahshua.**

Hallelujah! According to David's seed he has raised up Yahshua unto Israel! Yahshua is only the savior of Israel. Yahweh is the savior of the world! Yahshua came to be the redeemer of Israel. Yahweh will be the savior of the world. Yahshua is the kinsman redeemer of Israel. Glory! Glory!

*Go ahead brother. Pastor we were watching last night the teaching on Hanukkah when you said you went to Zechariah 14, and at the end of the second verse it says...but the remnant of the people shall not be cut off from the city. It just kept pressing on my heart, and I went to the King James Version, of course they have it incorrect, they call it residue, right? You went to the other verse before. But the word "yether", the remnant, means two cords being wound tightly together, to lock into place, and to support what is the true message. So I just find it amazing that Yahshua comes and he brings it all together for us, ties and knits it together so that we can be connected to our Father Yahweh. And it's just amazing.*

I love that. I love that part about a remnant will stay with the city, In other words, a city, prophetically would be New Jerusalem. And there will be a remnant there.

*And pastor just one last thing. One thing I think a lot of us have missed is in verse 2 when he said...for I (meaning Yahweh) will gather all the nations to battle against Jerusalem. All these people, all these that Satan is ruler of the earth, he's going to use him to bring these nations against it. But verse 3 says...then the Lord will go forth and fight against those nations. Oh hallelujah.*

That's exactly right. Go ahead brother. So I just have a question here. We were always taught, like you said, that in Matthew 28:19 that that's a false verse. So I was always taught that we're supposed to go out and preach the gospel. Then we're taught that we actually don't, that's incorrect. So what is an evangelist? I was always taught that that's what they're supposed to do.

To the house of Israel. In other words, you preach the gospel, but you're only going to reach Israel. So you still preach the gospel, but you're just looking for Israel, that's all you're doing. You throw the message out and Israel will hear it. So we still preach the gospel of course, and we do it in all the world. But we're just looking for Israel, we know the world's not going to receive it. We know the whole world's not going to respond.

We know very few this message is for. But it's just like my YouTube videos—they went out, they found Israel. And they still do everyday. We have new people here today, still finding Israel. So we still give the gospel, we still tell the kingdom is coming. But we do it without the expectation of Christianity, of a world harvest. *Ok, I gotcha ya.* We don't get disappointed when only Israel responds. Amen.

Brother go right ahead. *It's amazing how when the Holy Spirit turns the light on all of these verses that we've always read and glossed over. When you gloss over these, you take away all these scriptures that the Holy Spirit has shined a light on for us and it gets pretty thick. It really does, it just amazes me about that with the Holy Spirit. They always say you can't understand the scriptures without the Holy Spirit and it's absolutely true. I always thought I had the Holy Spirit. I didn't know I was following hard after God, but it just shows now, I mean, it wasn't there before!*

It wasn't there before. None of this was there before, I know. We get so stuck in Paul's writings. They want us to stay in Paul's writings and the epistles. And without this background. Next week I'm going to get into Paul's writings where the gospel supposedly went to the Gentiles because the Jews rejected it. And now supposedly God's rejected them and now only bringing in the Gentiles. I'm going to get to all of that, ok? Because the greatest misunderstanding is that word Gentiles. I'll take a lot of time to break that down.

Go ahead sister. *So in other words, everything we've ever learned Yahweh is now pulling it together and opening our eyes to see what we couldn't see. We couldn't be where we are if we hadn't have known what we knew back then, right?*

Absolutely. That's correct. That was our journey. Hallelujah.

Let's move on, I'm running out of time. Let's go to Acts 26:6-7

**Acts 26:6-7**

**6 And now I stand and am judged for the hope of the promise made of Yahweh unto our fathers,**

**7 Unto which promise our twelve tribes, instantly serving Yahweh day and night, hope to come. For which hope's sake, king Agrippa, I am accused of the Jews.**

He said I'm standing here about to go to prison. The reason I'm going is because a promise was made to our fathers of the 12 tribes. And this promise is only a hope to Israel. He said I'm going to prison in hopes that Israel will see her savior. Read Acts 28:20 and read what Paul says.

**Acts 28:20**

**For this cause therefore have I called for you, to see you, and to speak with you, because that for the hope of Israel I am bound with this chain.**

I'm in prison now. Do you know why I'm here? For the hope of the world? No, no, no. For the hope of Israel. He went to prison because of Yahshua, and he's telling you who Yahshua is, the hope of Israel. There are so many scriptures—we've gone through how many today, and I haven't even started. Scripture after scripture that's trying to show you who Israel is and who you are. Now let's move forward. Let's go to the book of Romans. It's just getting fun.

**Romans 1:7**

**To all that be in Rome, beloved of Yahweh, called to be saints, grace to you and peace from Yahweh our Father, and the Lord Yahshua Messiah.**

Notice that word...called to be saints. He's not writing to everyone in Rome. He says to all that be in Rome and then he tells you who the all is that he's writing to. Beloved of Yahweh. Who has always been the beloved of Yahweh? Israel. Called to be saints. That's who I'm writing to. Everybody in Rome I'm not writing to. I'm only writing to the beloved because only the beloved are called in this day to be saints. Boy that is powerful.

**Romans 1:13**

**Now I would not have you ignorant, brethren, that oftentimes I purposed to come unto you, (but was hindered until now,) that I might have some fruit among you also, even as among other Gentiles.**

I want you to notice something. You better pay attention to this verse. He said in verse 13 I'm writing to who? What's the key word? Brethren. When he says brethren, he is speaking of the seed of Abraham. He says brethren and then notice what he calls those brethren who are in other countries that he's writing to as well. He says other Gentiles. See we're getting ready to get into the whole

Gentile thing real soon (next lesson). Your problem is and my problem was that you don't know what the word Gentile means. You were brought up that Gentile means non-Jews, non-Israelites. No, no, no darling.

The word Gentile is simply the word *goy*. It just means "other nations". That's all it means. It just means the nations. Well, if you were not a Jew, then you were scattered among the nations. The only place that was not Gentile was Jerusalem, the land of Israel—that was not Gentile. All the other nations are Gentiles and any brother who's in those nations is considered Gentile, they're part of other nations.

You need to get this in your mind. I'm going to prove it in the next lesson, I don't have time to prove it today. But he calls them brethren. Read that again because I want you to see how that he is referring to brethren in other nations as other Gentiles just like these brethren.

**Now I would not have you ignorant, BRETHREN, that oftentimes I purposed to come unto you, (but was hindered until now,) that I might have some fruit among you also, even AS AMONG OTHER GENTILES.**

Other Gentiles. Brethren I have fruit. Listen, what's he call fruit? The people he's brought the message of Christ to. He said brethren I also have fruit among other Gentiles who are brethren. This is so important because when we get into the Gentile thing, you've got to retrain your thinking.

### **Romans 3:19**

**Now we know that what things soever the law saith, it saith to them who are under the law, that every mouth may be stopped, and all the world may become guilty before Yahweh.**

Now watch this. This is so good. He says...whatever the law says, the law and the prophets, the Torah, it only says to them who are in covenant with that law! That's more powerful than I even know how to explain right now. He just said... everything written in the Torah was not written to the world.

It was only written to Israel, therefore, all of the promises, the curses, and everything, and the kinsman redeemer, everything contained within it only applies to those who are under that law. It's not saying anything to anyone else but Israel. It's not speaking to anyone who's not under that law. The whole epistle of Rome is written to the Israelites who are in Rome at that time, otherwise known as Gentiles.



**Romans 4:24**

**But for us also, to whom it shall be imputed, if we believe on him that raised up Yahshua our Lord from the dead, who was delivered for our offenses, and was raised again for our justification.**

But who? See how you read that and you don't even see? But for who? Us. And who did he just say us were? He said it in chapter one, verse 7. Brethren, beloved of Yahweh, called to be saints. He said this imputation of salvation is only for us! You see how you read that verse and you didn't even see what it is saying? But for us. Then you say...who is us? Go back to the previous verses. You'll see who the us is. Those of us who are under the law. Israel. I hope I'm making that plain. But to US it was imputed. Nobody else but us.

**Romans 7:1**

**Know ye not, brethren, (for I speak to them that know the law,) how that the law hath dominion over a man as long as he liveth?**

The whole book of Romans is written to these brethren who are under the law. You thought it was written to Gentiles. They're called Gentiles only because they don't live in the land. They're scattered among the nations or the Gentiles. And they are now identified as Gentiles but they are beloved brethren.

**Romans 9:7**

**Neither, because they are the seed of Abraham, are they all children, but, in Isaac shall thy seed be called.**

In Isaac, the children will be called. This is Sarah's children, not Hagar's. You see, just because you're a natural-born child of Abraham does not make you part of this promise. No, no, no. Only through Isaac, the seed of promise will thy seed be called. Let's read Romans 11:17-18. Now this is important. Everybody pay attention. This is where Paul is teaching about the olive trees.

**Romans 11:17-18**

**17 And if some of the branches be broken off, and thou, being a wild olive tree, wert grafted in among them, and with them become a partaker of the root and fatness of the olive tree.**

Brothers and sisters, you are that wild olive tree. You're being grafted back into the olive tree, right? Here's my question. Can you graft anything back to the olive tree that is not an olive tree? (I lost you all so I'll do it again. Pay attention.) You cannot graft a banana tree to an orange tree, you know that, right? Ok, if you are being grafted back into the olive tree, that can only mean you always were an olive tree. Oh, there's more power in what I just said than you can understand.

You cannot be grafted into Israel unless you are Israel. Amen? You cannot graft a banana tree into an orange tree. Only like begets like. The way you can come back into Israel is if you already were Israel. Oh man, that is so powerful.

*Can we read verse 18 there? Sure.*

**18 Boast not against the branches. But if you boast, you bear not the root, but the root you.**

Here's what he just said. The Jewish people, the natural house of Israel, that's the roots of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. Don't brag. Don't make the mistake of saying...*I'm a Christian, I'm no longer associated with Israel, the church is a new thing, the church is totally separate from Israel.* That's why they believe in the rapture. Listen to me carefully. They have to have a rapture. Why? Because they believe that the church has nothing to do with natural Israel, that God is going to deal with Israel in the future, but not now.

So in order to make that lie fly, you've got to fly out of here as a separate entity before the tribulation because that's only for Israel. That's why once you destroy your rapture theory, you destroy this lie that we're separate from Israel. No, no, he said don't you brag, don't you say...*oh they rejected Christ, we accepted Christ.* Don't you brag! They're the roots darling that you've got to go back into. God will never accept any tree but an olive tree.

What do you think those two witnesses are in the book of Revelation and in Zechariah? The Bible said these are the two olive trees that stand before the Lord! Those two witnesses are Ephraim and Manasseh, and Judah. Those two witnesses are the lost tribes and the house of Judah coming back together by the Spirit of God!

Go right ahead. *Pastor, that's what Christianity has been grafting in everything except the true olive and it will never produce olives. Anything but olives.* Ha, ha, ha! It'll produce Christmas, Easter. It'll produce Sunday worship. It will produce anything but what you find in those roots. Folks, remember when I taught on Halloween, Holy Halloween? I started with the roots of Halloween. I told you if the roots are not holy, the tree can't be holy. I'm telling you our roots are holy. And the more you come back to these roots, you'll produce what's in the roots...shabbat shalom. You'll produce what's in the roots! Brothers and sisters, these two olive trees are the witnesses of the end times. Hallelujah. Whew!

**Romans 15:8-10, 12, 16**

**8 Now I say that Yahshua Messiah was a minister of the circumcision for the truth of Yahweh, to confirm the promises made unto the fathers.**

What promise was made to the fathers for Israel? He just said Yahshua was a minister to Israel only. That's what he just said. He said that I (Paul) said that Yahshua was a minister of the circumcision (we know that's referring to natural Israel) for the truth of Yahweh to confirm the promises made unto the fathers. And the only promise given to those fathers was for their seed. Read verse 9.

**9 And that the Gentiles might glorify Yahweh for his mercy, as it is written, For this cause I will confess to thee among the Gentiles, and sing unto thy name.**

Now watch this: *See brother Vaughn, it says the Gentiles.* But here's what you're missing. That the Gentiles might glorify Yahweh for his what? Who did I teach that were the only ones who needed mercy? Come on now! The Gentiles don't need mercy. Only Israel needed mercy and any Israelite that does not know they are an Israelite, they are Gentile.

And that's where we mess our brains up reading this about the Gentiles. Now listen. He said it is written for this cause I will confess thee among the Gentiles. That's Yahshua. That's a prophecy from Psalms 18:49. David said those words. Why? Because the olive tree would be transplanted among the Gentiles. Read verse 10.

**10 And again he saith, Rejoice, ye Gentiles, with his people.**

That comes from Deuteronomy 32:43. When the Gentiles are reunited with Judah his people. Remember what he said about Israel? You shall not be my people, I shall not be your God. They will say of you...you're not my people. Only Judah remained his people. But the day will come when the Gentiles will be reunited, or the lost sheep who think they're Gentiles, will be reunited with my people. "With his People" are all the Israelites together, the dispersed Israelites coming back into unity with Judah. Read verse 12.

**12 And again, Esaias saith, There shall be a root of Jesse, and he that shall rise to reign over the Gentiles, in him shall the Gentiles trust.**

Isaiah was talking to Israel. The only nations who could trust God were Israelites. There will be a root, who is Yahshua, of Jesse. And he will rise to reign over the Gentiles. In other words, among those Gentiles (we'll talk about this next week),

would be his people, and they would call themselves Gentiles. He will reign over them as well. He will bring them back. The prophecy was always for these two trees, and these two sticks, and these two houses. There's not one prophecy of anyone else until after the millennial reign. Read verse 16.

**16 That I should be the minister of Yahshua Messiah to the Gentiles, ministering the gospel of Yahweh, that the offering up of the Gentiles might be acceptable, being sanctified by the Holy Ghost.**

*So there you go pastor, it's not just for Israel, it's for the Gentiles instead of Israel now.* Here's the problem. The word GENTILE is a Latin word and it's given a manufactured meaning. You've got to get the meaning of it out of your mind. I'm going to show you next week (next lesson), when I get into it, that the house of Israel is the Gentiles being referred to as Gentiles.

It is a total mistranslation. Rome made the word Gentile to support the view that the Roman Catholic Church was the New Israel of God. Translators carried on the Roman church word meaning because they were blind to their identity as Israel. Going back to the book of Corinthians let's go there quickly. 1 Corinthians 10. We find that these so-called Gentiles could only be Israelites. Let me prove it to you.

**1 Corinthians 10:1-4**

**1 Moreover, brethren, I would not that ye should be ignorant, how that all our fathers were under the cloud, and all passed through the sea,**

**2 And were all baptized unto Moses in the cloud and in the sea,**

**3 And did all eat the same spiritual meat,**

**4 And did all drink the same spiritual drink, for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them, and that Rock was Christ (Messiah).**

Now hold on. Of course we know that's wrong, I've taught before that was not Yahshua—that was the anointed rock.

Listen, here's what he says. Who is he talking to in verse one? He says "our fathers". He is talking to the descendants of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. So when you read the book of 1 Corinthians, you thought that was written to the Gentiles. How many have been taught that those were written to the Gentiles? Brothers, he's not talking to Gentiles here. He is talking to those who drank that spiritual rock, those that went through the Red Sea, those who have the same father as him—our fathers.

Let's go to Galatians 3:13 and let's find out who these people are that we thought were Gentiles.

**Galatians 3:13**

**Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us, for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangs on a tree.**

Who? Who did he redeem from the curse? Us. Israel. You all learn your pronouns. The pronouns are so important. Christ has redeemed US from the curse. Not the world. Us! From the curse.

**Galatians 4:4-5**

**4 But when the fulness of the time was come, Yahweh sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law,**

**5 To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons.**

To redeem! To redeem them that were under. That means somebody was not under the law. Somebody this does not apply to. Do you all know that's been in your Bible for 2,000 years and you just saw it? He came to redeem them who were under the law. Brothers and sisters, if the Gentiles were never under the law, he did not come to redeem them! They're going to get a Jubilee not a redemption. I pray you can see this. Let's prove it further. Now, this is what he's doing to all of us.

**Ephesians 2:12**

**That at that time ye were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope, and without God in the world.**

Do you remember when Yahweh said of Israel...I'm putting you away, you will not be my people and I will not be your God? Hopefully you all remember those verses, I've read them over the past few weeks. When he divorced Israel. Put her away from the what? The commonwealth of Israel. He sent her where? Among the Gentiles, to take on the identity of Gentiles. He sends her out and he is no longer her God. *I thought he was everybody's God.* He just told Israel...I'm not going to be your God while I've put you away in divorce.

However, when I send my son, to break down that middle wall of partition between you all two, when I send my son to die, then I'm going to send you to the waters of baptism for you to die. Now we've got a dead wife. Now I can marry you again because the old woman's dead, I'm not remarrying her, I'm marrying a new

woman. Oh ain't nobody hearing me. You all got to understand what he said. He said...you are a stranger to the house of Israel, you're a wild olive branch. But I'm sending Yahshua to bring you back to the covenant of promise. He can't bring you back unless you were part of it at one time. Oh, man, man, man, man, man! Oh it's so good. It's so good. It's so perfect.

You were a stranger to the covenant because God put you away. He gave you a bill of divorce. And he can't remarry you because that's against the Torah, right? A man can't remarry the same wife in Torah. So therefore, Yahweh could not remarry Israel. You all need to go watch my lesson Did God Remarry Israel?\*

Yahweh did not remarry Israel. No, he puts Israel in the water to die. And what comes up is one new man. He can marry a new one, he can marry a new wife, not an old wife. See, you're not even the same, Israel isn't even the same woman. And Israel's a brand new creation! My Lord, help me Holy Ghost!

And that's why people say that Yahweh—they teach in the Messianic churches that Yahweh had to come and die to remarry Israel. But, no, no, no darling. No, the Bible says either party to the covenant, not the husband only. The wife could die. It's one party is dead to the covenant, then they can marry again.

Yahweh killed the woman in the water, and that's why he said when you come up, all things will be passed away, everything will be new—I'll marry a new wife. It will not be natural Israel, it will be Remnant Israel! Whew! Hallelujah!

And that's why he sent Paul to preach to them to be baptized. He said everyone of you must be baptized so that we can put the old Israel in the grave. My, my, my. Hallelujah. Yahweh did not die! How can you even say such blasphemy?! *Oh he had to die to remarry Israel.* No, Israel had to die to remarry him.

Whew hallelujah. I'll teach that in detail. Go watch that sermon: Did Yahweh Die to Remarry Israel\* that I bring all the scriptures out and show it to you. Don't let people tell you that Yahweh had to die. That's blasphemy. You've recreated God.

I've got thirteen more good scriptures here. Oh, my, my, my. *Just give them to us and we'll look them up!* Alright.
