

The Book of Hebrews Verse by Verse

Part One—Chapter 1:1-4

Today we're going to journey into the book of Hebrews. But before we do, there are a few things I want to point out to you. I need to, of course, set the foundation. Before we open the book of Hebrews, I want to talk to you about the author of Hebrews first. Paul wrote the book of Hebrews to the Jewish people in Israel. I want you to remember that. I'm going to say something that might throw some people off. The book of Hebrews was not written to you. Of course the whole Bible is the Word of Yahweh (God), and all inspired; it's the original, and every one of us receives from it. But the letter itself was not written to the Lost Tribes of Israel, and it was not written to the Gentile.

This book was specifically written to the Jewish people in Israel. Why is that important to understand? Because when you read the book of Hebrews, keep in mind that Paul is in a prison cell, and he is writing letters, and this particular letter he is writing to the Jewish people. He is going to be scolding their hide in the book of Hebrews. If you don't understand that, when you begin to read the book of Hebrews, you will get it all backwards if you don't know who it was written to. Let's go to Acts chapter twenty-four, verse five. The first thing I want to help you understand is about the apostle Paul. This verse is specifically about the apostle Paul.

Acts 24:5 For we have found this man to be a pest: one who stirs up trouble among all the Yehdaim throughout the world, and a ringleader of the sect of the Nazarenes.

So before you can understand the book of Hebrews, what do you need to understand? You need to understand who wrote the book of Hebrews, and you need to understand who this person was. According to this verse, he was a troublemaker in all the churches. Paul was a troublemaker. Amen? And he was a pest. He was always on the news. He was always going against

the establishment of his day. If you ever get discouraged, go read Acts 24:5 and remember that Paul was marked by the Church as a troublemaker, a rabble-rouser. But, he was not a troublemaker to the House of Israel.

He was a troublemaker to the Jewish people, in other words, the established church of his day. You need to remember this about the apostle Paul—he was always making the preachers mad. He was always making the Church angry at him. He was a leader. What group was he a leader of? *The Nazarenes*. Let me talk to you about the Nazarenes. Before the word Christianity or Christian ever came into the vernacular of mankind, the original followers of Yahshua (Jesus) were not called Christians. They were called Nazarenes.

Why? Because Christianity is the creation of capilicity. Simon Magus, the Sorcerer, the Magician and Marcion—all of these people a hundred years after Christ died, there was still a little sect or a little group called the Nazarenes. They were not what we know of today as Christians. They were not trinitarian. They were not Sunday Sabbath keepers. They were not pagan celebration keepers. They were Nazarenes.

Notice what they called the apostle Paul. He was a cult leader. Do you know what the word sect means? A sect is a cult. The funny thing about it is that anytime you leave mainstream Christianity, you all of a sudden become a cult. *They are joining a cult*. Has anybody here heard that said about you? Well, the apostle Paul was a leader of the cult of the Nazarenes. They were people who woke up and smelled the coffee. They saw what was wrong with Christianity, and they were under the apostle Paul. He was their leader. He told them, “Follow me.”

Can you imagine if the apostle Paul was alive today and came on this Zoom and said, “Follow me.”? The whole world would have him in the headlines saying he is telling people to follow him. But he said, “Follow me as I follow Christ.” In other words: *As I follow the Word, you follow me. But if I get out of that Word, then unfollow me. But if I’m in the Word, follow me and we will all become troublemakers to the establishment.* Why? We will fight

for TRUTH. The cult that Paul led was outside the Christianity of their day. This is something you need to understand to see who you are today. You need to see your forefathers in these Nazarenes.

His name was not Paul. His name was Shaul, and I will refer to him as that to help you get more acquainted with Hebrew terminology. Each letter written by Shaul was written to unique audiences with unique challenges. When attempting to understand any of his letters, you must line them up with all the other letters. Let me explain it like this. All the letters that the apostle Paul wrote were like jigsaw pieces to a puzzle. They are called the Pauline Epistles. That is the theological phrase for those collections of writings—the Pauline Epistles.

Every epistle that Paul wrote, and by the way, there are probably hundreds of epistles that he wrote that we do not have. They were not preserved. They were not kept. So imagine if I wrote you a letter today. Let's just say that Pat and Jon Kahl had written me a letter and let's say I was their sect leader, their cult leader. They wrote me a letter, and let's say that Pat and Jon Kahl have a unique set of problems. Let's say that Pat and John are having someone living in their home with them that is causing them marriage problems. They write me a letter and they say in that letter, "Here is our problem. How do we deal with it?"

Let's say I write them back, and let's just say that I say to them, "It would be best if you didn't have people living in your home." Let's say a hundred years down the road, that one letter, not the letter she wrote me about the specific problem, but the letter I wrote her gets found and after I am dead and gone, all of you family members say, "Pastor Vaughn says we can't have anyone living in our homes." Are you picking up what I'm putting down? Without the letter that Pat and Jon wrote to me, you have no context for the answer that Paul gave to these churches.

They would write to him, he would write them back. Therefore, what he is speaking to that local church does not necessarily apply to every church. He wrote different things to the Church of Rome, the Church at Colossae, the

Church at Galatia. Keep all of that in mind when you are considering Paul's writings. There is a saying that I learned from some friends of mine. It is simply this: What is understood need not be explained. So maybe that will answer your questions. Have you ever read the writings of Paul and wished he had been more detailed about what he was saying? Have you ever wished he had explained it better? Now you know why he didn't—because what is understood need not be explained.

Who was he writing to? The Jewish people. They understood the things that you as a former Gentile do not understand. Therefore, there were things he didn't have to explain. They understood what he was saying. You were an American. You were born in America. You don't understand everything Jewish. Therefore, when you read his writings, you are like, "What is he talking about?!" But those people understood, so therefore, he didn't have to break it down. He didn't have to explain it over, and over, and over. Hopefully that helps you to understand a little about the writings in Hebrews.

The book of Hebrews is one of Shaul's deepest writings and it was written to the Jews. He wrote to people that were very familiar with the Law and the Priesthood. So when you are reading his writings in the book of Hebrews and you are seeing the Law, and you wish he would have explained it better, there was no need for him to explain it better in those days. Why? Because the Jewish people knew which Law he was referring to. You don't understand that.

For example, do you know when you read Paul's writings about the Law, that sometimes he is referring to the Law of Yahweh (God) and sometimes he is referring to the law of the Pharisees? Sometimes he is referring to the law of the land. Which law is he referring to? We can know that by the original Greek and Hebrew writing. The word for law is the word *nomos*. That word encapsulates the law of the land or the culture of the day, but if you see the word *ho nomos*, then that is the Law of Yahweh (God). Paul didn't break it down because the Jewish people knew the difference.

Therefore, when you read that the Law has been done away with and that we are no longer under the Law, that particular law is simply the Law of sin and death. So these Jewish people understood the different nuances of the Law, which you don't. That's why these books can be a little complicated. Shaul was a leading Pharisee. He was an expert in what? The Torah. Anyone that believes that Paul came to do away with the Torah, they don't understand that Paul was an expert in the Torah. In the Torah it tells Paul that this Torah will never pass away. So if he comes to do away with the Torah when he was an expert in it, he would violate his own conscience.

What you are going to find is that Shaul was an enemy of the *oral law*; the oral law from the mouth of the sages and the rabbis. These men took the words of Torah and took away from it and added to it. These are the men who created all of these Sabbath Laws—you can't do this, you can't do that, you can't pick corn, and so forth. Paul was the enemy of the oral law which was called the mishnah or talmud. Not that they were horrible, but they were being placed equal to the Word of Yahweh—the Torah.

Remember that. The mishnah is not a bad document. The talmud is not bad. They have great wisdom in there. But when you equate those with the Torah and make them equal, then you have committed a grave injustice against the Torah itself. Shaul knew the bondage of Judaism. Judaism controlled the churches of Paul's day. They were the leaders of the temple and the synagogue. The entire religion of Judaism is a hellenized religion. It is just as pagan as Christianity. It's like anything I write. There may be great wisdom in it, but it will never be equal to the Torah. We have to keep that in mind as we study.

I want to talk to you for a minute about paganism in the Christian church and the Jewish church. Here is the problem: Many of you have run out of Babylon. You have left Christianity, but then you turn to Judaism for your answers. There is a great problem there because Paul was in a war against the religion of Judaism of his day. Not the pure religion; not the original faith, but remember what happened to the second temple? It had become hellenized. Remember when they came in, they removed the Zadokite

priesthood and replaced it with Justin the priest. At that point, hellenization began to creep into the Church of Israel and the religion of Judaism became perverted, just like the religion of Christianity became perverted.

You have not been called out of Christianity into Judaism. No, no, no. You have been called back to the original faith of the Nazarines. You have been called back to the original faith of the original sect of Paul. Paul was never against Torah. He was against Judaism. I am not against original Christianity, but I am against modern Christianity; the one that has left the Word of Yahweh and adopted fables. We have to be very careful. Even with our calendars, even with the days we keep holy, who do we automatically turn to? The Jews. We want them to teach us.

But brothers and sisters, the voice of Elijah is going to restore all things; not the Jewish people. It's not the Jewish people that are going to restore all things. They are the ones who messed it up, just like the Catholics and the Protestants did. But the Bible said there will be a voice of Elijah that will rise up in the end times and it will restore all things, not the Jewish people. If you are looking to their religion, you might as well look to Catholicism. Here's what Wikipedia says about hellenization:

Hellenization is the adoption of Greek culture, religion, language, and identity by non-Greeks.

As the Greeks took over the known world, so did their way of thinking. Their way of thinking is polytheistic. Their way of thinking is the total opposite of a Hebrew mind. Let's see what Wikipedia says:

The twentieth century witnessed a lively debate over the extent of the Hellenization among the Jews that has continued until this day. The Judaism of the diaspora was thought to have succumbed thoroughly to its influences.

Did you hear me? Judaism has succumbed thoroughly to Greek influence. Christianity arose almost completely within those Hellenistic confines and should be read against that background, as opposed to the original Hebrew faith. Brothers and sisters, I didn't write that. It's in Wikipedia. They admit that Christianity and Judaism have been so influenced by the Greek mindset, which is another word for Paganism, that they have left the original Hebrew faith.

In all of that I just read to you, what is the solution? Here comes Shaul. Here he comes. In the middle of all of that, no one was more qualified to confront the establishment than a man of the establishment. Many of you know that I grew up Pentecostal. I am a fourth generation Pentecostal. Many of you know my story, and you know when you hear me preach you will hear that Pentecost come out. That is the world I came from, and yet it is me that Yahweh chose to stand up against Pentecostalism. How does that work? I can preach just like them because I know them. When you hear me preach and it makes you a little uncomfortable, that's my calling.

Yahweh has called me to the Pentecostal people. Yahweh has called me to reach inside of their world and speak truth to them. But for them to hear me, it must come across in that delivery style that they are used to. They will not listen to some of you who do not know how to preach. The Pentecostals are used to great preaching, and therefore, when the Lord sent me to the AWCF (Apostolic World Christian Fellows) in Indiana to bring the end time message of Elijah, I couldn't have gone to the platform speaking monotone. I couldn't have been Baptist. They would not have received me. I had to go as my own brethren; as one of them.

You speak the language of where you came from. That's why many people will not listen to my message; because my preaching style is offensive to the way they grew up in church, and that's okay. However, Yahweh is raising you up, all of you, to speak the language of your world—where you came from. You know how a Baptist thinks, or a Catholic, or an Episcopalian. You bring this truth back to them in their language and in their style. This Bible study is a school for the prophets. We are raising up prophets here. Do you

know what a prophet is? They are not someone that tells you the future. They are someone who tells you the truth. You just learned more than most Pentecostals ever know. A prophet is not a future-teller. That's called a psychic. A prophet might tell the future, but they tell the truth in a world filled with lies. If you want to become an enemy in this world to the Church, like Shaul was, you've got to come against their lies.

This is what Shaul is doing. Yahweh raised him up among the people. He had a revelation of the Scriptures and this made him dangerous. He was mentored by Gamaliel, the most famous rabbi in history. Shaul, like John the Baptist and Yahshua, was the leading figure in defense of the ancient way written by the Prophets and the Messiah. It took me all of that to get to the book of Hebrews. HalleluYah! Now we will start our journey, but I wanted you to understand who Paul was, and I wanted you to understand where we stand.

I had to address something yesterday that somebody posted on Facebook. They aren't here today because they probably didn't like my response. They posted that in the last days, women were going to rise and take over leadership of God's Church. I literally had to put that spirit of Jezebel back in its place. They don't like me today because I told the truth. Yahweh is raising up the men of this hour. The prophets of Elijah are being raised up and their wives are standing *behind* their husbands, not in front of them. That's called disorder.

In this study, we are going to turn to Hebrews and read it verse by verse. We are going to go through it slowly, and cover the whole book of Hebrews. We are going to do a few verses every week.

Hebrews 1:1 Yahweh, Who at various times and in different ways spoke in times past to our fathers through the prophets,

2 Has in these last days spoken to us through *His* Son, Whom He has appointed heir of all things, for Whom He also made the world.

How many remember the sermon last week when I taught about why Yahweh created the world? How many remember when I taught you the scriptures: *on account of* and *because of*? There is your verse right there that proves why Yahweh created the world. Read it one more time, and everyone please listen most carefully.

Yahweh, Who at various times and in different ways spoke in times past to our fathers through the prophets, Has in these last days spoken to us through His Son, Whom He has appointed heir of all things, for Whom He also made the world.

FOR WHOM—Yahshua. Paul is opening the book of Hebrews to set straight to the Jewish people *Who* Yahshua (Jesus) was. There was a false teaching in those days that Yahshua was not really a man, but He was more like an angel; He was more like a theophany. He wasn't a real human. These teachings were infiltrating the Church and Shaul said, "Let me start out by setting the record straight about *Who* Yahshua was." Anyone start to feel the train tracks begin to roll? Yeah, we're about to get this party started. Shaul is speaking to the Jewish people because they were having a hard time accepting Yahshua.

Paul said, "In past times Yahweh spoke to us through angels, through a burning bush, through His prophets. He spoke to us through the stars, through nature. He spoke to us in various ways, but these days He is now speaking to us through His Son." Why is He speaking to us through His Son? Because Yahweh created the whole world *because of His Son, on the account of His Son.* Read Romans 8:29.

Romans 8:29 For whom He did foreknow, He also did foreordain to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brothers.

Now let me explain something about predestination. I don't know if any of you know what predestination means. Here is the deal brothers and sisters.

Predestination according to this verse does not mean you have been chosen to be saved. No, no, no. It means you have been chosen to be conformed or *transformed as a duplication of your Older Brother Yahshua*. People believe in predestination until you show them what predestination means.

Predestination doesn't mean you were chosen to be saved, but there is a group of people who were in the mind of Yahweh; who were the firstborn. They were predestined to be transformed into an army of duplications of Yahshua the Messiah (Jesus Christ). If you are here today, chances are you were in the mind of Yahweh before one star was ever created, and He had a plan for your life to transform you from Christopher Augon to a duplication of Yahshua Hamashiach; into another entity entirely that looks nothing like Christopher Augon, that looks nothing like your forefathers, that looks nothing like where you came from. You have been CALLED to be CHANGED!

You have been PREDESTINED to be RECONSTRUCTED in the FIRST HARVEST! HalleluYah! You have been called, not to salvation, but to TRANSFORMATION! According to that scripture, why is He transforming you? Read the last line of Romans 8:29. Why, why, WHY have you been predestined by Yahweh? ***That He might be the firstborn among many brothers.*** Here is what Shaul is saying: Yahshua was predestined. Where was He predestined? In the Plan, in the Logos! Where was the plan? In Yahweh's mind! Yahshua was in that plan from the Beginning. The Firstborn! What does that mean? Let me ask somebody a question.

Sister Jan Meadows, if I give you a dollar bill and I say to you, "Here is your first dollar," what am I saying to you without saying it? *It is the tithe.* Actually, that's true, but let's dig deeper. If I say, "This is your first dollar," I'm telling you without saying it that you are going to get a second dollar, a third dollar, and a fourth dollar because this is your *first* dollar. So when Yahshua was called the FIRST born, what is Yahweh telling us in the book of Hebrews? That He *never* intended for Yahshua to be the ONLY Son of God.

The problem is that the whole Church is fixated on the man Christ Jesus. I thank Yahweh for Him, but that is where Satan wants you fixated. For example, the whole Church has a hernia to have an Easter service to celebrate the resurrection of the firstborn Son of Yahweh. Right? Do you know that out of all the holy days, there is not one that celebrates the resurrection of Christ? Have you ever thought about this? Not one.

You've got one that celebrates His death. You've got one that celebrates His sanctification—Feast of Unleavened Bread. You've got one that celebrates His coming to us as the Holy Spirit. You've got one that celebrates His Second Coming. You've got one that celebrates His Coming Kingdom, but not one that celebrates His Resurrection. If you've ever wondered why, I'm going to tell you something now that would literally give your Christian friends hemorrhoids because it isn't a big deal to Yahweh. Why? Because Yahweh never wanted the resurrection of One Son. He wanted the resurrection of billions of sons that look just like the First Son.

Therefore, we have the Feast of Firstfruits. We don't have the Feast of the Resurrection. We have the Feast of Firstfruits. It is plural! The Feast of Firstfruits is a resurrection of the sons of Yahweh! The Christian Church does not celebrate the sons. They celebrate *The Son*. That's what Satan wants them to celebrate, because Satan doesn't want that nightmare to come to pass when that One Boy comes from the grave **multiplied by millions!!**

If Satan had known the plan, he would have let Yahshua die in a nursing home. He would never have allowed Him to be killed and put in the ground. Nobody knew that a year after the Trump stolen election that there would be patriots rising up *because of that* to run for offices. These are the roaches coming out of the dark. We're the roaches. We turned on the light, and here we come. Yahshua was the Firstborn among many brethren. Satan wants you focused on *that* resurrection. Why? Because when you celebrate the Firstfruits, here is what you do: You clap for it, you thank Yahweh for it, and you appreciate it. But then you turn your eyes to the future and here is what you say:

I hate to be crude. I hate to be rude, but you look back at that resurrection of One Son and say, “That’s really no big deal because what I see coming up out of the graves in the near future is that one plus one, plus one, plus one. Christ’s resurrection is really not that big of a deal. The big deal is yet to come.” That is why we still celebrate the Feast of Firstfruits. It is a shadow that has not yet been fulfilled. These firstborn sons are about to be birthed from the womb of the Church, from the womb of the House of Israel. Those who went down in water baptism are about to come out of their graves, pop up, and they will all be the EXACT IMAGE of Yahshua the Messiah! HalleluYah!

If you don’t get this, there is no need for you being here. I’m trying to tell you Who You Are! While the Church is focused on One man, Yahweh’s Word is focused on MANY men, and the Church is not telling you that you must be transformed into the Image! They are inviting you to be saved, but predestination is inviting you to be CHANGED! Let’s read Colossians 1:18.

Colossians 1:18 For He is the Head of the body, the called out ones, Who is the beginning of the firstborn from the dead, so that in all things He may have the pre-eminence.

Who is the Head of the Body? Yahshua. Listen carefully. He is the beginning of the FAMILY. Glory to Yahweh! Don’t you understand? He is just the beginning. I hate to say it so please don’t misunderstand me, but He is not the big deal, and yet He is. Don’t misunderstand me. He is the Beginning of a Plan that the Church has never taught you about. He is the Beginning of the Royal Family of The House of Israel that will soon rule the nations of this world, and govern from sea to shining sea. He is the beginning of *that* family. He is the Elder Brother. He will always have the double portion. He will always have the inheritance, but we are His brothers who share in that inheritance. Now let’s turn to Hebrews one, verse three.

Hebrews 1:3 Who, being the reflection of the perfection of Yahweh, and the representation of Yahweh's plan, by upholding all things concerning that which was spoken by Yahweh through the Law and the Prophets, when He had purged sins, sat down on the right hand of Yahweh on high,

Read that again, and listen carefully. I want to break this down for everybody. This is very important. This says who Yahshua is. Shaul is trying to teach the Jewish people Who Yahshua is. He tells the Jewish people that Yahshua is the expressed image of Whose Person? Yahweh's Person. This is where we get a lot of our Oneness theology from because it seems like we are being told that Yahshua is the image of the invisible God, and therefore He becomes that. If that is the case, we have a major problem, because you have been predestined to look just like Yahshua. Yahshua is the expressed image of Yahweh, so does that mean when you become the expressed image of Yahweh like your Brother, that you have become Yahweh?

I'll say it again so you will get it. Yahshua looks just like His Daddy. You are to become duplications of Yahshua. That means you are going to look just like Yahweh. Does that mean you *are* Yahweh? No! You better learn who you are. According to the scripture you just read, Yahshua is the expressed image of His Father, and you are also going to be the expressed image of your Father and you will look just like your Brother Who is the image of the Father. You are going to be a duplication of Yahshua the Messiah and therefore, you are being transformed into that image. Let's read quickly II Corinthians 4:4, and Genesis 1:27, and John 17:19.

II Corinthians 4:4 For the gods (elohim) of this world (led by Satan) have blinded the minds of those who do not believe, so that the light of the message of the glory of the Messiah, Who is the image of Yahweh, should not shine unto them.

Who is Yahshua according to that verse? He is the IMAGE of Yahweh. It is important that you get this. If you know of anyone who does not receive the gospel that we preach, it is not because they're bad people. It's not because

they are evil. It's because of what? Why can they not see what you see? Because they are blinded in their minds by the gods of this world. That is Satan. Beloved, listen to me carefully.

If you can see, you ought to be shouting! Why? Because by the Father's predestination, those blinders were jerked off your eyes by Yahweh!! NOTHING YOU DID! He chose you and He removed the blinds! What can you do for those who cannot hear this message? The Bible said when you pray to the Father in heaven, pray this prayer: *Father, remove their blindness I pray!*

QUIT TRYING TO CONVERT PEOPLE! I need to look at your faces and see how you are responding to that! I know you love this truth and you want to tell everybody about it. Big mistake! Hide it in your heart! David said, "Thy Word I have hidden in my heart." Why? Because when you pray, things happen!

Let me tell you something. Do you know that everybody's prayers don't work? When you ask somebody to pray for you, there are some you should ask not to. Do you know why? Because only the prayers of a *righteous man*, only the prayers of a *commandment keeper* availeth much. When you are a commandment keeper and you pray, things happen! Pray for your loved ones, Quit trying to convert them. Pray for them! Bring them to the Father and lay them at His feet and say, "Father, as you opened my eyes, I petition You to open theirs. Show them the mercy of the grace you showed me." When you get around them, don't try to do things on the slick to slip in your scriptures. No.

How do you know the Father is dealing with them? How do you know they're ready? The Bible said that the Father will lead them to you and they will ask you questions. When they start to question you about your faith, that is your moment to be ready to give an answer to every man about the hope that lies within you. Yahweh didn't call you to do His work. John 6:44 says no man can come to the Father. Nobody except the Spirit of God draws them. All you're going to do is make them mad.

Don't tell them to take down their Christmas trees. Just take yours down and let them ask you why. Don't be telling them what to eat and not eat. Let them look at your plate and ask you why. And don't say, "Ah, ah ah...my cult leader told me to." You better have your scriptures ready. You better have your reasoning ready. That's why you're in here. You're here training for reigning. Learn why you believe what you believe. Let's go to Genesis 1:27.

Genesis 1:27 So Yahweh created man in His *own* image. In the image of Yahweh He created the man. Then He created the woman from the man.

Yahweh created Adam in His image. Is Adam Yahweh? No. Are you picking up what I'm putting down? Somebody said that Jesus was the image of God. Who was Adam? The image of Yahweh. So are you going to make Adam God because he is the image of God? No. You better learn your Bible before you fall into idolatry. Listen carefully. Adam was the image of Yahweh before his fall. So was Yahshua. You must become that very image. How are you and I changed? Brother Morgan, what is the process by which Yahshua changes you from Morgan to Christ? The process is called the process of Sanctification. Every Christian you know of wants to be saved. None of them want to be sanctified. Here is what we read in John 17:19.

John 17:19 And on behalf of them, I sanctify Myself so that they also may be sanctified through the truth; *through every word of Yahweh.*

Wow. Yahshua said, "I had to be sanctified." Why did He have to be sanctified? *So that they, my brothers, can be sanctified.* But how are they sanctified? Through good church? Through somebody laying hands on you? Through somebody blowing on you? Through somebody giving you a word? Do you get sanctified by going to church? No! How are you and I going to be in that number? THROUGH TRUTH! You are not changed through your church. You are changed with Truth!

What is Truth? When Yahshua said: I am the way, the truth and the life, those three words are the description of Torah. Torah is the Way to walk in. Truth is Torah, and the Torah gave Life. Yahshua said, “I am the Torah. I am the Way.” Therefore, we are not sanctified by going to the latest feel good conference where Creflo Dollar and his brother Fifty-cents are going to be talking. I don’t need to go to a conference. I need a man of God to open this Torah and give me the Truth. If I find out I’ve got to be transformed, I’m going to start working on it. But if I am just going to be saved, nothing to work on. Do you get it? Any preacher that tells you it is done away with is Antichrist, do you hear me? They are antiTorah. They are antiLaw. Then they dare use Paul’s writings to defend their position. Shame on them!

Now I’m going to introduce you to an idea that is going to be a hard pill for some of you to swallow. There was a part of that verse we just read in John seventeen that I don’t think you saw. I don’t think you have ever contemplated what it means. I am about to break it down for you. I’m warning you, it’s a disclaimer before we get started. This is going to be a shocker for many of you. If you have not listened to my teaching on HisComingKingdom.com, please do so today. There is a video on there called *The Yearling Lamb*. You must watch my teaching on the yearling lamb. What I’m getting ready to teach you is contrary to everything you’ve ever learned. Go back and read John 17:19 again, the first line.

And on behalf of them, I sanctify Myself

Now hold on. Why does the Son of God need to sanctify Himself if He is God? What was there to sanctify? We’ve been taught that He was born perfect, He lived perfect. Oh my, my my. We’ve been taught that He was perfect from the moment of His birth; the immaculate conception. But according to His Own Words, He Himself had to be sanctified. The only thing that needs to be sanctified is something that was not sanctified previously. It gets better.

I'm going to prove to you today that Yahshua was the perfect example for you to follow. He did not overcome with any special power. He did not overcome because He was Superman. He was a simple man. He was born to a mama like you were. He was born like you were. The Bible said that He was tempted in every area as you were. Yes, probably even by Mary Magdalene. He was tempted like you were. But in your image of Yahshua, He was not capable of any sin. Do you know what that teaching leads to? A weak, powerless church. Do you know why? Because when somebody preaches to you to be like Christ, do you know what you say? But He was God. There is no way we can be like Him.

Do you know what Satan tells you in your mind when you hear this overcoming message and you say you've got to become like Jesus? Do you know what he tells you? *But He is God in the flesh. Of course He overcame, but you're not like Him.* I don't know if any of you have ever dealt with what I'm talking about. The Devil comes in here and says, "But He was born of a virgin birth! He was born without sin—sinless, so of course He overcame." We're about to knock this devil in the head! I hope you're ready. Listen to me carefully. God was inside of this man, but the outside of that man was a man. Do you hear me?

Do you see this green tea I'm drinking that is supposed to be healthier? I don't know how it can be healthier with 26 grams of sugar, but they say drink green tea. Do you see this can? Is this can aluminum or is it tea? Aluminum. What is inside of this aluminum? Is it aluminum or tea? Tea. Just because there is tea manifested in the can, does that mean the can is tea? No.

Beloved, Yahweh was manifested *in the flesh. Inside* the flesh, but don't you ever call Him flesh! Yahweh said He is Spirit; in other words, He is tea. The Bible said God is not a man, neither is He a Son of Man. Yahweh is Spirit. That Spirit is inside of that man, but don't get it twisted. When that Spirit left that man on Mount Calvary and He asked, "Where did You go," He poured out the tea, and now all you have is a can. That man needed help just like you do.

Sister Sandra Broliar, let me ask you a question. I'm going to assume that alcohol is not your forte. *Correct.* If I brought you a glass of alcohol right now, would that be a temptation for you? *No.* I don't know what your temptations might be or what proclivities you might have, but if I brought something to you that appealed to your proclivities, that would be a temptation. The Bible says Yahshua was tempted in every way that you are, and yet, the Bible also says that Yahweh cannot be tempted with sin. Yahshua was tempted. Here is my question to all of you. If it was not a real temptation that He could have given into, then it was all just a joke. That's why He's called the Second Adam. He could have made the same choice that the first Adam did.

Brothers and sisters, this idea that Yahshua was never truly tempted is a joke! We must know who Yahshua was. He was the Pattern Son. He was born like you. He was tempted like you, and yes, He could have fallen like you. I can prove it from the Word of Yahweh. Listen to me carefully. I want everyone of you right now to follow me up to the Mount of Temptation. Right after Yahshua was filled with the Holy Ghost at baptism, where does the Father lead Him to? Now that He's got His help—you can't do anything without the Holy Ghost—where does the Father lead Him to? The wilderness, the desert. That is the same place He will lead you, out of your church into the wilderness when you get the truth, the Holy Ghost.

He will lead you out to be TESTED. Truth that is not tested is not truth at all. So here goes Yahshua for forty days and forty nights. While He is in that wilderness, the Father said that all of a sudden a scene from four thousand years earlier repeats. It's called the Upward Journey. The more things change, the more they stay the same. What you are about to see four thousand years later is the exact same thing. The Bible says there is nothing new under the sun. You are about to see Adam number two created in the image of Yahweh. He is the Son of Yahweh. What did the Bible say about the first Adam? He was the son of Yahweh. Now the scene repeats itself and here comes Adam with His bride, Eve.

Oh, you don't see Eve in that picture, beloved? Oh yes, she is inside of Him. On Mount Calvary, they will pierce His ribcage where the first Adam's ribcage was pierced, and out will flow blood and water, which will be the new Bride! HalleluYah! There is the Bride! She was in there! Glory to God! You were in Christ back then, and now you are in Him again!! HalleluYah! Glory to God! Listen carefully. Yahweh put the first Adam to sleep and reached in his ribcage, and the second Adam was put to sleep and out of His ribcage came the second Eve, the second Bride, and she has been with Him representing Him ever since in the cult of the Nazarenes. HalleluYah.

Brothers and sisters, here He goes with Eve, up to that same snake. Here comes the same snake, that old serpent the Devil. Where does he come? He comes before the second Adam just like he did the first Adam. What does he offer the second Adam? The exact same thing he offered the first Adam—power without obedience! Do you know what Satan promised the first Eve, the first Adam? He said they would not die, and he went before the first Adam and promised them the garden without the guardian of the Torah.

So here comes Satan, that old snake. He's still crawling, and here is what he tells the second Adam. He says: *Yahshua, I know that your Father in heaven has promised You to be Lord of the Sabbath Day. I know He has promised You a Kingdom on earth. I know He has promised You that you will be King of the whole world. I know that, but He also said something else, Yahshua. He also said that You had to die to get all of that. Yahshua, He said that You had to give up Yourself and put Him first in order to be entrusted with that government.*

But Yahshua, hello. I have a better plan for you, and it's real simple. Do you see all this that He has promised to You? Guess what? It already belongs to me because He gave it to me back in the Garden of Eden. So what You are promised is already mine. Guess what, Yahshua? If You will doubt the Word of God. If You will turn against the suffering and the obedience, if You will not be a witness against me in my coming trial, if

You will rebel like I did, I will give You what He promised You because it is mine to give to You.

By the way, everything I just told you is in your Bible. Satan says, “Yahshua, what He’s promised has strings attached, called Commandments, Obedience, when what You want, I’ve already got, and I’ll be glad to be co-ruler with You, and we can rule together against the Father.” I want every one of you to hear your pastor today. **THAT SAME SNAKE WILL CRAWL IN YOUR HEAD EVERYDAY WITH THE SAME OFFER! Power without Prayer. Power without Obedience. That is called witchcraft and it’s all in God’s Church!**

I know when the voice of Yahweh is speaking. I need everyone of you to stand there with me on the Mount of Temptation where your Elder Brother Yahshua is standing, and I want you to see this man tired and exhausted from the enemy battling His mind everyday, and it’s not worth the suffering. Watch as he pounds His mind. As this little boy, Mary’s baby, is starving, trying to do the right thing, but oh how the offer is so tempting! Wasn’t it this boy that begged His Father to take away from Him, His suffering, and here is Satan offering to take the cup, the suffering, away from Him. Any Christian church that offers you a reward without a price is Antichrist. Any Christian message that offers you heaven without hell first, is Antichrist.

I need you to hear me. I have one question, and I’m going to ask a few people to answer the question. Sister Jill Sidok, unmute yourself. At that moment, could Yahshua have accepted Satan’s offer? *Yes, He could have.* Here is my next question. What if He had accepted it? *Then we wouldn’t be here right now.* Then the whole doctrine that He was the Father, falls apart. Brothers and sisters, if Yahshua would have accepted Satan’s offer, you would have been without hope.

Do you hear me? But I thank God that somewhere in those forty days of fasting, that Holy Ghost that He received in baptism was stronger than the lies of the enemy, was stronger than the temptation of the moment. He saw

the beauty in the suffering. He saw the beauty in obedience, and He said: *Get behind Me Satan! Take your offer back to Hell where it came from. Put Me on the Cross. No, I don't want to do it, but I understand that My Father has been waiting for one obedient son and I'm going to be that man right now.* HalleluYah! Glory be to God!

Yahshua could have chosen any path He wanted to choose because the Father is not looking for robots, He is looking for obedience. Being a robot is not being obedient. It's being programmed. Yahshua had totally free will. Of course the Father, knowing the end from the beginning, knew what Yahshua would do, but the beautiful part of it is that Yahshua could have done whatever He wanted, and then the Father would have had to look for a third Adam. We're going to read Hebrews 7:27, Hebrews 5:2, Colossians 2:12. I'm going to show you what had to happen to Yahshua—the same thing that will happen to you.

Hebrews 7:27 Who does not need daily, as those mortal High Priests, to offer up sacrifices, first for their own sins, and then for the people's; for this He did, once, for all, when He offered up Himself.

I need you to read it again and focus on that second line. This is where High Priest Yahshua is being compared to the High Priests. Notice whose sins the High Priests made atonement for. It's going to blow your mind. Read it.

Who does not need daily, as those mortal High Priests, to offer up sacrifices, first for their own sins,

Whoa, whoa! He offered up sacrifice first for what? His OWN sins. And Yahshua is now the High Priest! Okay. It's going to get real good now. Hebrews 5:2-4.

Hebrews 5:2-4 Who can have compassion on those who are ignorant and going astray, since he himself is also subject to weakness.

Now hold on! That is a powerful verse! What is sin? Weakness. I need everybody to focus. This is talking about Yahshua. It said He was subject to weakness. Do you know what that word is in Greek? *Sarki*, Strong's number 4561 means sinful flesh. Yahshua was subject to His flesh. I bet you won't hear that in your Christian church, but it's in your Bible. Brother Morgan just read where He had to offer sacrifices for Himself.

Don't go to that scripture that says no sin or guile was in His mouth. Watch my video on the Yearling Lamb. It will explain that. He only had to be sinless for three years of His life. That was from His baptism forward, and He was because what came out of the water was a New Man, just like when you come out of the water! My God from Mount Zion! You all better quit going to these churches that don't push water baptism. They don't understand the importance of it.

May I ask a question? Am I correct in assuming that Yahshua was not deceived by Satan?

Correct.

Yet we in world now have been sold a bill of goods in that those representing God have deceived the minds of those looking for the truth, and so we find ourselves in a different position than Yahshua. Can you speak to that?

Yes. He had the fullness of God because He was not deceived. He was born without that deception. Therefore, growing up He was able to make better choices than you and I were able to make, and He was guided by the Torah all of His life. However, according to this scripture, He had the ability to get into a fight with one of His brothers and sisters. He had the ability to disrespect His mother, which He did when He let them worry about him for three days when He was at the temple. That was very disrespectful. There were many things as a child that I would say would not have been

considered one hundred percent Torah. However, it is okay. When you read the Word of Yahweh and understand the Yearling Lamb.

Not only was Yahshua required to be a spotless Lamb, but He was required to be a Yearling Lamb, which means He could not be more than one year old. From His baptism until His death is when He had to be spotless, and He did it. He was without spot or blemish. Neither was any guile found in His mouth because at water baptism is when the Father said: *This is My beloved Son in Whom I am well pleased*. From this point forward, He will walk as the Yearling Lamb. You've got to understand these things. Yahshua had to be baptized for a reason. What does water baptism make you? A new creature in Christ. And what happens to your sins? They are gone. Do we believe that or do we not? Are you a new man at water baptism or are you not?

Yahshua had to be baptized. From the point of His baptism to His death, not one sin, no guile, because that was a New Man. That man that came out of water baptism was tested, tempted. He passed and there was no sin in His life whatsoever from that point of baptism forward. He was a Yearling Lamb; one year old. If Yahshua did not have the ability to sin, you and I can hang it up; it is all a joke. If He couldn't sin, how is He our example? He wouldn't be. If He has Superman strength, I don't, so that defies the very meaning of an example. Let's continue with reading Hebrews 5:3-4.

3 And for this reason, he has to offer sacrifices for his own sins,

What?! Do what?!! There is no way the Bible said what it just said, because my preacher would kick you out of the church if you said that.

as well as for the sins of the people.

4 And no man takes this honor upon himself, but he must be called by Yahweh, as *was* Aaron.

You all, I didn't write this. Do you understand? I'm reading it. Don't hate the messenger. I'm reading the Book. It's right there in your face. How many want your mind blown a little more? Can you take it? Let's do this. Let's go to Zechariah 3:1. This is a prophecy about Yahshua, the coming High Priest. This one is mind blowing! I promise that after you read this one you're going to be like, "What the what, the what, the what!"

By the way, lest anyone think I am lessening Jesus, perish the thought. I'm making Him greater because I am making Him more of an Overcomer than you've ever made Him. I'm making Him King of Kings because He fought for it and He won! I'm making Him the Victor instead of the victim.

He overcame because He was God.

How sad is that! OVERCOMER!! He is an Overcomer, and now after His death, He is not Who He was in His flesh. I'll get to that in a moment. Let's read Zechariah 3:1.

Zechariah 3:1 KJV And he shewed me Joshua

That word Joshua is a mistranslation. It should be Yahshua, as in The Book of Yahweh, below. Here is a vision that Zechariah is receiving of the High Priest. Read.

Zechariah 3:1 Then he showed me Yahshua the High Priest standing before the malak of Yahweh, with Satan standing at his right hand to oppose him.

Where was Yahshua just standing? The Mount of Temptation. Who was standing there to resist Him? Satan. Okay, read.

2 And Yahweh said to Satan: Yahweh rebukes you, O Satan! Yes, Yahweh Who has chosen Yerusalem rebukes you! Is not this a brand pulled from the fire?

What does that mean? Here is Satan standing by Yahshua the High Priest, resisting him, and Yahweh says: *I rebuke you Satan. Do you not see that this is a brand pulled from the fire, that this man has been in the desert for forty days and forty nights without water, without food? He is about to die in this desert, and you come to Him at this moment when He is like a brand plucked out of the fire!* Yahweh rebukes you for this, Satan. Keep reading.

3 Now Yahshua was clothed with filthy garments, and stood before the malak.

Now Yahshua has on a certain set of garments in this vision, and according to this scripture those garments were filthy. That represents His flesh body. He stood before the angel. Keep reading.

4 And He answered, and spoke to those who stood before Him, saying: Take away the filthy garments from him. Then to him, He said: Behold, I have taken your iniquity away from you, and I will clothe you with a change of raiment.

You have earned a new robe! You have earned a new status, Yahshua. Now take away those filthy garments, angels, and now He has won a great victory. Something is about to happen. Read the next verse.

5 And I said: Let them set the beautiful tsaniph; a headcovering consisting of a kippah, then wrapped with a turban, upon his head.

Do you know what that is? That is a CROWN! Now, take those filthy garments! Your sin is gone! Your past is gone! You've been baptized. It's like it never happened. You've been sanctified. Now give Him a crown on His head. Read.

So they set a beautiful tsaniph upon his head, and clothed him with garments, as the malak of Yahweh stood by.

6 Then the malak of Yahweh solemnly testified to Yahshua, saying:

7 This is what Yahweh of hosts says: If you will walk in My ways, and if you will keep My charge, then you will also rule My House and have charge of My courts; and I will give you places to walk among these who stand by.

From this day forward, Yahshua, as a Yearling Lamb, if You will walk in perfection, I will give You charge over the Family as the Elder Brother! I bet you never knew Yahshua had a filthy garment, did you? According to this prophecy, He is going to have the filthy garment put behind Him in the waters of baptism. From this day forward, You have one year. This is the Yearling Lamb. Now You must walk in perfection as the Yearling Lamb. You must not break the commandments going forward. You have stepped into Your ministry, Your calling for which You have been born! HalleluYah! My God from Mount Zion!

Brother Vaughn, I don't know if that is talking about Yahshua.

Then you better read verse eight through verse ten. We might as well read it.

8 Hear now, O Yahshua the High Priest, you and your companions who sit before you;

Those are your brothers! Read.

for they are men wondered at.

These men, your brothers, will be wondered about. They will be laughed at, but you have been set among your brothers! Do you hear me? You are *The Example* to the brothers. *I have set you as the Example!* You will be laughed at. You will be wondered at!

For behold, I will bring forth My servant the BRANCH.

If you do not believe this is Yahshua, who do you think the Branch is in the Word of Yahweh? The Branch has always been Yahshua the Messiah! Keep reading. If you don't know this is Yahshua, you are a fool. Read verse nine.

9 For behold, the stone that I have laid before Yahshua. Upon this stone complete knowledge and understanding is established. Behold, I will engrave its inscription, says Yahweh of hosts, and I will remove the iniquity of that land in one day.

In ONE DAY. Let's find out what day I am talking about in verse ten.

10 In that day, says Yahweh of hosts: every man will invite his brother under his *own* vine and fig tree.

On what day will every man have his own vine and his own fig tree? On the day of the Lord Jesus Christ, Yahshua Hamashiach! In ONE day, ALL sin will be gone from the whole world! In One Day! HalleluYah! My God from Mount Zion! You all thought you were just coming to a little Bible study today. Shame on you. HalleluYah! *In One Day I'm going to remove all His filthy garments; His iniquity!*

I didn't write that. That is what the Father said. *All of those thirty years of iniquity are behind You, and from this day forward You must be perfect before Me.* What is beautiful about this is how Yahshua did it. He did it with the same Holy Ghost that was given to you at water baptism! Did you know that? Did you know that there is no different Holy Ghost than the one your Elder Brother has? HalleluYah to God!

THAT SAME SPIRIT! For some reason you all think Jesus had a different Holy Ghost than you got. Why do you think Jesus had a different Holy Ghost than you got? It's that Same Spirit! That same Spirit that was in Him is also manifest in your flesh! I am hated for this message, but God raised me up for it, and He's raising you up to walk in it. Read Colossians 2:12.

Colossians 2:12 Buried with Him in baptism, in which you are also risen with *Him* through the faith, in the active power of Yahweh Who raised Him from the dead.

Read verse thirteen.

13 And you, being dead in your sins and in the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, having forgiven you all your sins—

Notice what it said in verse twelve: You've been buried with Yahshua where? On the confession of your sins? No! Accepting Christ in your heart? No! When were you buried with Christ? In WATER BAPTISM. And listen to what it says in verse thirteen. What happened when you were buried in water baptism? The same thing that happened to Christ. When you were DEAD in your SINS and in the weakness of your flesh, you were THEN made ALIVE with YAHSHUA! Yahweh forgave all of your sins like He did Yahshua's in the same waters of baptism. HalleluYah to God! Do you see it? Praise God! Praise God! Praise God!

I hate when people say He was baptized just to show us that we need to be baptized. No! He was baptized because He had to fulfill all righteousness in the Torah! For Him to be counted righteous, He had to be baptized and filled with the Holy Spirit, just like you! HalleluYah!

Yahshua was a source of Living Water, always? If you go to John 19:34, one of the soldiers pierced His side and blood and water came out. The Living Water came out even when He was crucified.

Now Nicole, you might also understand why the Bible said there are three that bear witness in heaven: The Water, the Blood, and the Spirit, because that's the Spirit, the Father and the Bride. They are the Blood and the Spirit. Amen. We were created from the water and the blood. What do you

always get when a child is born? Water and Blood. HalleluYah! Praise Yahweh!

If you have ever wondered why the Bible doesn't mention Yahshua's life before the age of thirty, it's because none of that life matters now. That is the old man. Do you get it? The New Man was thirty years old in the flesh. HalleluYah. We don't need to know about all those years. They are not even part of our story. Our story is of the New Man who overcame and won the victory!

I encourage everyone when you come into this truth, you should be re-baptized. It is almost like an initiation, if you will, into that next level in Yahweh. At the Feast of Tabernacles in October, we will again have a beautiful day of baptisms in the lake. You are invited to get on that list and we will get you baptised. Now let's do verses four and five of Hebrew chapter one. Finish verse three first, and then go into verse four.

Hebrews 1:3 Who, being the reflection of the perfection of Yahweh, and the representation of Yahweh's plan, by upholding all things concerning that which was spoken by Yahweh through the Law and the Prophets, when He had purged sins, sat down on the right hand of Yahweh on high,

Hold on. This is the resurrection when He sat down with the Majesty on high, correct? Yes. What happens after the resurrection? Read what it says in verse four.

4 Becoming so much better than the malakim,

Hold on now. He had to be MADE BETTER than the angels. In His flesh He was lower than the angels. So if He was Yahweh in the Flesh, how could He have been lower than the angels? See? But after His baptism and His resurrection, He is made better than the angels. He was not before. He had to earn that. Right now, you are a little lower than the angels, but just like your Elder Brother, very soon you are going to be made greater than the

angels! They will serve you in the Father's Kingdom. They will go where you bid them to go, but right now you are beneath them. Why? Because you are earning the reward of becoming greater than those angels.

He has by inheritance obtained a more excellent Name than they.

How is He Yahweh if He's giving Himself His Own inheritance? How did Yahshua become greater than the angels? Because that was part of His inheritance from Yahweh. Notice what it says in that verse. He OBTAINED a more excellent Name or position than they have. Notice what it doesn't say. It doesn't say it was given to Him *carte blanche*. What does it say? He OBTAINED it. I am looking up the Greek word for obtained right now because I want to know what it should say. It's the Greek word *kleronomeo* and it means: *obtain by inheritance*. In other words, this was not His to begin with. It had to be obtained.

Brothers and sisters, You are joint heirs with Christ. As you follow His example, you will obtain a better position than Michael and Gabriel have in the Father's Kingdom. Let's end with verse five.

5 For example, to which of the malakim did He ever say: You are My Son, I, today I have become your Father? And again: I Myself shall become His Father, and He Himself will become My Son?

Listen to me. To which of the angels were they ever baptized in water and heard these words: *You are My beloved Son in Whom I am well pleased?* None. Then, what did He say? *I have become Your Father*. In other words, *I was just Your Creator at Your Baptism, but at Your Baptism I have become Your Father*. He told that to whom? Yahshua. Read that last line again.

I Myself shall become His Father, and He Himself will become My Son?

I thought Yahshua was born and Yahweh was already His Father. No! *The moment I say I am well pleased with You, I will become Your Father.* This happens at WATER BAPTISM! Yahweh said there was a time in Yahshua's life when I told Him I will not become Your Father, and now You become My Son. Where? At the point of OBEDIENCE! When you were just saved and running wild, He wasn't your Father, and you weren't His son. But at the point of obedience, He told Yahshua, "I will become Your Father, and You will become My Son." Those are deep words. That's why I said Hebrew is the deepest book Paul ever wrote.

To which of the angels have I ever said, "This is My beloved Son of Whom I am well pleased, and now I'll become Your Father."? I thought He was born His Father. People love to focus on the fact that there was no guile in Yahshua. May I show you a scripture that is going to blow your mind? Turn to Revelation 14:5. This is talking about Justina Morgan. This is talking about every Overcomer in this life, and guess how it describes YOU? Read it.

Revelation 14:5 And in their mouth was found no guile; falsehood, for they are without fault before the throne of Yahweh.

According to that scripture, you have never had guile in your mouth, and you are completely blameless. You've never sinned. Do you know why? It's the same thing with Yahshua. People are picking up on the wrong thing today. Whether He sinned or not, I don't know. I wasn't there, but I do know the Bible said He was able to, that He could have. I know the Bible says the High Priest gives sacrifice for Your own sin first.

I know this: From the point of His baptism forward, He had no sin and no guile was found in His mouth. You are going to have that same testimony from the point of your baptism as you've walked in Torah. Even though you've made mistakes, and even though you've failed, in the eyes of God, you will be perfect and have no fault before the throne of God. That applies to you just as it does to Yahshua. You will have no desire to sin. A mistake and a failure is not a sin.

Sin is a MINDSET. Sin is transgression against the Law of Yahweh. Sin is when you have no regard for the Law of God, and therefore you fall short and could care less, and you keep walking in transgression. That is sin. For those who fall short of the Glory of God, which is the Law, we repent like David did, as quickly as we fall, and we are still honoring the Law of God. It is still directing our life, therefore, we are not transgressors and are perfect before Yahweh.

David, after he committed murder and broke the Law of God, the Bible said he went and sat in sackcloth and ashes because the Law meant so much to him. That love for the Law was counted as righteousness for him, even when he broke the Law. Is anyone hearing me? If you don't love the Law, you will break it without repentance. What makes you perfect before Yahweh is not the fact that you've never broken the Law. It is the fact that you have repented for breaking the Law, and breaking that Law has broken your heart. If there is anyone here who has gossiped at all, if you have broken your tithe by one penny, you have broken the Law.

Let's keep this thing straight. Whether Yahshua has broken the Law or not, when as a little boy, His mama and daddy said, "Be here at three o'clock today. We're all leaving," and He wasn't there, did He break the commandment to honor your father and mother? I don't know. What I am saying is before water baptism whatever He did doesn't even matter because that man is dead.

What matters is from the point of baptism forward. That is a NEW MAN in Christ Yahshua and from that moment forward. Everything before is washed away. Only what happens at the point that the Father accepted Him as His Son and told Him: *From this point forward, if You will keep My commandments and not break My statutes in any way, I will give you charge over My house.*

Go ahead, Sister Justina.

I was a little confused about that. I was reading in II Corinthians 5:21 where Yahweh made Him Who knew no sin to become a sin offering for us that we may become the righteousness of Yahweh through Him, so I got a little bit confused with the carnal way of thinking about what you were teaching.

If you'll give me just a moment, I'm going to show you what *knew no sin* means. I'm pulling up an old teaching on that because it's not quite the way it's written, unfortunately. Remember, what I just read a few minutes ago. According to Revelation 14:5, Justina Morgan has known no sin either. We need to read that again. I don't think we got that. I need everybody to go back and read that.

Revelation 14:5 And in their mouth was found no guile; falsehood, for they are without fault before the throne of Yahweh.

So they knew no sin. Who is *they*? Us. Justina Morgan. Us. They are without sin. They are perfect. They are blameless. Their testimony is that they knew no sin; they are without guile. It's the same testimony that Yahshua had. He is without guile. One day somebody is going to hear what I'm saying. It doesn't matter *before* water baptism. THAT MAN IS DEAD! All that matters is from that moment forward. Did Jesus Yahshua sin is not an important question. It doesn't matter if He did, because He is now dead. What is water baptism all about? Is it just to get wet? No. The old man has died!

He Who knew no sin—We all fall into that same category. We knew no sin from the moment we were baptized. Yahweh doesn't even recognize that old man. All things become NEW. Therefore, if the old man is dead, Yahshua's Old Man is dead and now He is NEW. So are we. The problem is that very few watching me believe that is true. All things become brand new! The Bible says the old man doesn't exist anymore. The point of baptism is as far back as Yahweh is looking in your life. According to Yahweh concerning Yahshua, He knew no sin. That's where being free comes in because you are not that old man anymore. You have been set

free. If you mess up, repent quickly. You have not sinned; you are blameless because YOU LOVE THE LAW OF YAHWEH, not because you are perfect.

Do you know how I know my wife loves me? Not the fact that she never makes me mad or does things that she knows I don't like. Do you really think we don't break each other's laws? She doesn't like the lid left up on the toilet. Do you think I never leave the lip up on the toilet? Do you think she never angers me? But do you know what happens the moment we have a quarrel? Tears begin to fill her eyes. Why? Because she loves my law and she wants to be a good wife and please me. The fact that she broke my law hurts her. I am not saying I have a law; but I have a way of doing things, and to see those tears, to me she has done nothing wrong. Why? She loves my law. HalleluYah. So according to me she has no sin. What if she came back with, "I don't care what you like."? She's still got sin in my eyes. Do you understand? HalleluYah.

You brought something out of me that I want to share. When I was six years old I was burned in a fire, very badly. Both my legs were thirty percent burned and I was in the hospital for seven weeks. When I was in the hospital I know that Yahshua spoke to me and said everything would be okay. I don't know how that message came. Yesterday when Brother Nash gave his message about scars and he spoke about how they show the battle we have been through, I began to realize that for years when I had to speak about my legs when any child would ask what that was on my legs, I would get frustrated at having to tell the story over and over again because the story was one of me being sinful because I lit the fire and that's how I was burned. So it was almost as if I was reliving the pain as a child of having been led to the fire to be destroyed. I really mean that. I know Satan was trying to destroy me as a child because there was a calling on my life.

Now I have revelation to understand why those scars exist, and I just want to praise Yahweh! I'm sad I don't wear shorts anymore and don't get asked the questions. After we read that verse in Zechariah that said: Is not Yahshua a brand pulled from the fire, that just blessed my heart. That is my Brother Yahshua.
